

1.BULWARK (noun): बांध

Pronunciation: bul•vuhk
Meaning: a defensive wall.
Synonyms: wall, rampart, fortification
Antonyms: harm, hurt, injury
Sentence: Our people's support is a <u>bulwark</u> against the enemy.

2.LANGUISHED (verb) : दुर्बल होना

Pronunciation: lang•gvuhsht
Meaning: (of a person or other living thing) lose or lack vitality; grow weak or feeble.
Synonyms: weaken, grow weak, deteriorate
Antonyms: recovered, recuperated, thrive, flourish
Sentence: He languished in poverty for years.

3.DISMAL (adj.) : निराशाजनक

Pronunciation: diz•muhl Meaning: depressing; dreary. Synonyms: dingy, dim, dark Antonyms: cheering, cheery, glad Sentence: Christmas will be <u>dismal</u> without the children.

4.EXPLICABLE (adj.) : समझाने के योग्य

Pronunciation: uhk•spli•kuh•bl **Meaning:** able to be accounted for or understood. **Synonyms:** explainable, interpretable, definable **Antonyms:** inexplicable, insoluble, insolvable **Sentence:** The sudden increase in sales is easily <u>explicable</u>.

5.GIST (noun) : सार

Pronunciation: jist **Meaning:** the substance or essence of a speech or text. **Synonyms:** essence, substance, quintessence **Antonyms:** exterior, exteriority, insignificance **Sentence:** she noted the <u>gist</u> of each message

6.DECIMATION (noun) : बर्बादी



Pronunciation: deh•suh•may•shn
Meaning: the state or fact of being rendered non-existent.
Synonyms: annihilation, demolishment, demolition
Antonyms: building, construction, protection
Sentence: The virtual <u>decimation</u> of the coastal town was caused by the hurricane.

7.ASCENDANCY (noun) : प्रभुत्व

Pronunciation: uh•send•uhns•ee
Meaning: occupation of a position of dominant power or influence.
Synonyms: dominance, domination, supremacy
Antonyms: impotence, impotency, powerlessness
Sentence: He slowly gained <u>ascendancy</u> in the group.

8.VACATE (verb) : खाली

Pronunciation: vuh•kayt
Meaning: leave (a place that one previously occupied).
Synonyms: leave, get out of, move out of
Antonyms: fill, load
Sentence: Rooms must be vacated by noon on the last day of your vacation.

9.GRAPPLE (verb) : मुठभेड

Pronunciation: gra•pl
Meaning: engage in a close fight or struggle without weapons; wrestle.
Synonyms: wrestle, struggle, tussle
Antonyms: concord, harmony, peace
Sentence: Two sumo wrestlers were grappling like a pair of mammoth bears.

10.RABID (adj.) : विक्षिप्त

Pronunciation: ra•buhd
Meaning: having or proceeding from extreme or fanatical support of or belief in something.
Synonyms: extreme, fanatical, overzealous
Antonyms: moderate, liberal, halfhearted
Sentence: Even the survey's most <u>rabid critics</u> acknowledge the utility of this kind of data.
