## 1. Punjab's Sift Kaur Samra won gold in 50m shooting in 38th National Games

India's bowlers delivered an exceptional performance, with Gongadi Trisha taking 3 wickets for 15 runs, Parunika Sisodia claiming 2 for 6, and Aayushi Shukla contributing 2 for 9. In response, India chased down the target comfortably, reaching 84 for 1 in just 11.3 overs. Gongadi Trisha led the batting with an unbeaten 44 runs, while Soumya Chalke supported with 26 not out.

## 6. Jonathan Gavin Antony clinched Gold medal in Men's 10-metre Air Pistol event

At the 38th National Games held in Dehradun, 15-year-old Jonathan Gavin Antony from Karnataka clinched the gold medal in the men's 10-meter air pistol event, becoming the youngest champion in this category. He delivered an impressive final score of 240.7, surpassing seasoned shooters including Paris Olympics bronze medalist Sarabjot Singh, who finished fourth. Ravinder Singh of Services secured the silver medal with a score of 240.3, while Gurpreet Singh took bronze with 220.1. Jonathan's journey into shooting began in 2022, inspired by his



mother, Ancy, a former college-level rifle shooter. Balancing his passion for shooting with academic commitments, Jonathan aims to represent India in future international competitions, including the 2028 Olympics.
