

1. INALIENABLE (adjective) – अविच्छेद्य, अपरिहार्य

Pronunciation: in-ei-li-un-ub(u)I

Meaning: not subject to being taken away from or given away by the possessor Synonyms: inviolable, absolute, sacrosanct, unchallengeable, unassailable

Antonyms: negotiable, alienable, transferrable

Usage: Because women wanted the same inalienable rights that men had, they protested in large numbers.

2. UNIMPEACHABLE (adjective) – अनिधक्षेप्य, अधिक्षेपातीत

Pronunciation: un-im-peechub(u)I

Meaning: not able to be doubted, questioned, or criticized; entirely trustworthy **Synonyms**: trustworthy, reliable, dependable, unquestionable, unassailable

Antonyms: dubious, unreliable

Usage: Their actions are selfless and unimpeachable.

3. RECRIMINATE (verb) – आरोप लगाना

Pronunciation: rikrimineit

Meaning: make counter accusations Synonyms: accusation, blame, reaction

Antonyms: pep talk, absolution

Usage: It's natural to recriminate against someone who has tried to put the blame on you.

4. TRIUMPHALISM (noun) – आत्मप्रशंसा, शेखी बघारना

Pronunciation: trai-umph(u)lizm

Meaning: an attitude or feeling of victory or superiority; an unpleasant show of one's success or achievements

Synonyms: high horse, flag-waving Antonyms: humility, modesty

Usage: Her acceptance speech at the award ceremony was free from triumphalism.

5. RESTIVE (adjective) – बेचैन, बेसब्र

Pronunciation: res-tiv

Meaning: (of a person) unable to remain still, silent, or submissive, especially because of boredom or

dissatisfaction

Synonyms: restless, fidgety, edgy, on edge, tense, uneasy, ill at ease

Antonyms: calm, biddable, peaceable

Usage: The crowd had been waiting for hours and many were becoming restive.

6. CHAUVINISTIC (adjective) – अंधराष्ट्रीय, देश-प्रेमपूर्ण

Pronunciation: sho-vinis-tik

Meaning: feeling or displaying aggressive or exaggerated patriotism

Synonyms: nationalistic, xenophobic, jingo **Antonyms**: multicultural, tolerant, non-biased **Usage**: Your <u>chauvinistic</u> behaviour has troubled us.

7. VOCIFEROUSLY (adverb) – चीखते हुए

Pronunciation: vosi-f(u)rusli

Meaning: in a loud and forceful manner

Synonyms: noisily, loudly

Antonyms: gently, peacefully, mutely, noiselessly

Usage: They are arguing vociferously over who should pay the bill.

8. OVERBLOWN (adjective) – अतिशयोक्तिपूर्ण

Pronunciation: ovuh-blo-n

Meaning: made to seem more impressive or important than is the case **Synonyms**: exaggerated, pretentious, overwritten, florid, grandiose, pompous

Antonyms: simple, plain

Usage: News outlets are calling the illness outbreak an overblown epidemic, but doctors swear that the danger isn't

exaggerated.

9. EERILY (adjective) - भयपूर्वक

Pronunciation: ee-ur-ili

Meaning: in a strange and frightening manner **Synonyms**: spookily, uncannily, creepily **Antonyms**: harmoniously, agreeably

Usage: Her voice was eerily similar to her dead grandmother's.

10. TRUMP (verb) — बेहतर होना, बेहतर प्रदर्शन करना

Pronunciation: trump

Meaning: be better than something by saying or doing something better **Synonyms**: outshine, outclass, upstage, surpass, outdo, outperform

Usage: Using his years of experience to <u>trump</u> his partner, the attorney insisted that he should be the first chair on

the case.
