

1.COMPLY (VERB) : अनुपालन करना

Pronunciation:kuhm·plai

Meaning: act in accordance with a wish or command. Synonyms: consent, defer, accede Antonyms: disagree, differ, dissent Sentence: The man was arrested because he refused to <u>comply</u> with the airline's no smoking policy.

2. INDICT (VERB) : अभियोग लगाना

Pronunciation:uhn·dite

Meaning: formally accuse of or charge with a crime. Synonyms: accuse, prosecute, incriminate Antonyms: acquit, exonerate, vindicate

Sentence: The district attorney decided to <u>indict</u> the suspect for the murder, charging him only after his bloody fingerprints were found at the crime scene.

3. EMPATHY (NOUN) : सहानुभूति

Pronunciation:em·puh·thee
Meaning: the ability to understand and share the feelings of another.
Synonyms: sympathy, pity, compassion
Antonyms: ruthlessness, mercilessness, apathy
Sentence: Doctors should develop <u>empathy</u> between themselves and patients.

4. RELINQUISH (VERB) : त्यागना

Pronunciation:ruh·ling·kvuhsh

Meaning: voluntarily cease to keep or claim; give up.

Synonyms: surrender, render, abandon

Antonyms: retain, keep, withhold

Sentence: When you <u>relinquish</u> the desire to control your future, you can have more happiness.

5. VOUCH (VERB) : ज़मानत देना

Pronunciation:vawch





Meaning: assert or confirm as a result of one's own experience that something is true. **Synonyms:** certify, attest, ensure

Antonyms: undermine, weaken, enfeeble

Sentence: The bank believed the woman but would double check the woman's financial background even though the woman did <u>vouch</u> that she earned \$40,000 a year.

6. DISCRETION (NOUN) : विवेक

Pronunciation:duh·skreh·shn

Meaning: the freedom to decide what should be done in a particular situation; speaking to avoid revealing confidential information.

Synonyms: prudence, wisdom, sense

Antonyms: indiscretion, imprudence, idiocy

Sentence: Because my daughter spends money recklessly, I have to give out her allowance at my <u>discretion</u>.

7. DISPARITY (NOUN): असमानता

Pronunciation:duh·spae·ruh·tee

Meaning: a difference in level or treatment, especially one that is seen as unfair.

Synonyms: contrast, distinction, dissimilarity

Antonyms: similarity, likeness, analogy

Sentence: Therefore, separate churches only add to the <u>disparity</u> between the races.

8.PERFUNCTORY (ADJECTIVE): असावधान

Pronunciation:puh·fuhngk·tuh·ree

Meaning: (used about an action) done quickly as a duty without any interest or feeling. Synonyms: desultory, quick, hasty Antonyms: careful, sensitive, warm Sentence:He gave a <u>perfunctory</u> nod.

9.BICKER (VERB): झगड़ना

Pronunciation:bi·kuh

Meaning: to argue about unimportant things. Synonyms: argue, quarrel, spar Antonyms: agree, accept, assent Sentence:Couples who bicker over who gets what from the divorce.

10. ICONOCLAST (NOUN) : मूर्तिपूजा का विरोध करने वाला

Pronunciation: ai.kaw.nuh.klast



Meaning: a person who does not believe in and is opposed to accepted ideas, traditions, etc.

Synonyms: maverick, freak, loner

Antonyms: adherent, supporter, sheep

Sentence: The *iconoclasts*, led by a local innkeeper, entered the church in mid-sermon.
