1.INCLINE (VERB): इच्छा

Pronunciation:incline

Meaning : to want to behave in a particular way or make a particular choice

Synonyms: minded, willing, ready

Antonyms: disinclined, fall, dip

Sentence:He was inclined to accept the offer.

2.INCURSION (NOUN): आक्रमण

Pronunciation:uhng.kuh.shn

Meaning : a sudden attack by foreign armies etc., usually across international borders

Synonyms: assault on, raid on, storming of

Antonyms: retreat

Sentence:Government forces were able to halt the rebel incursion.

3.FERVENT (ADJECTIVE): उत्कट

Pronunciation:fuh.vnt

Meaning : having or showing very strong feelings about something.

Synonyms: passionate,intense,ardent

Antonyms: apathetic, impersonal, unemotional

Sentence:I am a fervent supporter of the revolution.

4. UNDERPIN (VERB): टेक लगाना

Pronunciation:uhn.duh.pin

Meaning: support, justify, or form the basis for.

Synonyms: nurture, encourage, develop

Antonyms: hinder

Sentence: The theme of honor underpinning the two books.

5.FAIRLY (ADVERB): अच्छी तरह से

Pronunciation:feuh.lee

Meaning: in an acceptable way; in a way that treats people equally or according to the law, rules, etc.

Synonyms: passably, satisfactorily, pretty

Antonyms: insufficiently, very, highly

Sentence: I was fairly certain she had nothing to do with the affair.

6. MAGNITUDE (NOUN): परिमाण

Pronunciation: mag.nuh.chood

Meaning: the great size or importance of something

Synonyms: import, significance, gravity

Antonyms: triviality, littleness, infamy

Sentence: History has a lot of events of tragic magnitude.

7. EXPEDITIOUS (ADJECTIVE): शीघ्र

Pronunciation: ek.spuh.di.shuhs

Meaning : done with speed and efficiency.

Synonyms: swift, quick, rapid

Antonyms: slow, lazy, tardy

Sentence: The murder investigation needs to get expeditious.

8. REPRESSIVE (ADJECTIVE): दमन का

Pronunciation: ruh.pres.uhv

Meaning : that limits people's freedom.

Synonyms: authoritarian, despotic, unimpressive

Antonyms: democratic, poignant, impressive

Sentence: It was clear that he could not continue the repressive tactics of his predecessor.

9. PROSCRIBE (VERB): देश से निकालना

Pronunciation: pruh.scribe

Meaning : forbid, especially by law.

Synonyms: prohibit, ban, veto

Antonyms: permit, let, allow

Sentence: Strikes remained proscribed in the armed forces.

10. ACCEDE (VERB): स्वीकार कर लिया

Pronunciation: uhk.seed.uhd

Meaning: to agree to a request, demand, etc.

Synonyms: endorse, go along with, allow

Antonyms: refuse, dissent, spurn

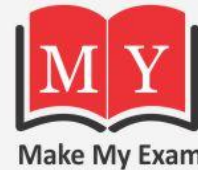
Sentence: He did not accede to his child's demands.

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
