1. Simone Biles wins Laureus Sportswoman of the year award 2025

Simone Biles has been honored with the 2025 Laureus World Sportswoman of the Year award, marking her fourth win in this category. This achievement ties her with tennis legend Serena Williams for the most Laureus titles. Biles' recognition comes after a remarkable comeback at the 2024 Paris Olympics, where she secured three gold medals and one silver, including victories



in the team, all-around, and vault competitions. Her performance featured the Yurchenko double pike, a move she pioneered in competition. With a total of 11 Olympic medals and 30 World Championship medals, Biles remains the most decorated gymnast in history.

- Fourth Time Winner: Simone Biles has won the Laureus World Sportswoman of the Year award for the fourth time, following her record-breaking performance at the Paris 2024 Olympic Games.
- **Record-Breaking Performance**: Biles won four medals at the Paris 2024 Olympics, including three gold, becoming the most decorated artistic gymnast of all time with a total of 11 Olympic medals and 30 world championship medals.
- **Previous Wins**: Biles previously won the award in 2017, 2019, and 2020, solidifying her position as one of the greatest gymnasts in history.



• Nominees: Other notable nominees for the award included Aitana Bonmati, Aryna Sabalenka, Sydney McLaughlin-Levrone, Sifan Hassan, and Faith Kipyegon.

2.Indian Navy concluded Maiden AIKEYME Exercise in Tanzania

The Indian Navy successfully concluded its inaugural multilateral naval exercise, AIKEYME (Africa-India Key Maritime Engagement), in Dar-es-Salaam, Tanzania, from April 13 to 18, 2025. The harbour phase featured tabletop and command-post exercises focusing on anti-piracy operations, information sharing,




and training in seamanship and Visit, Board, Search, and Seizure (VBSS) procedures. The subsequent sea phase included drills in search and rescue, small arms firing, and helicopter operations, fostering interoperability among the participating navies. Additionally, the exercise underscored India's commitment to its MAHASAGAR initiative, promoting mutual and holistic advancement for security and growth across regions.

- **Participating Nations**: The exercise involved 10 countries, including India, Comoros, Djibouti, Kenya, Madagascar, Mauritius, Mozambique, Seychelles, South Africa, and Tanzania.
- **Objective**: AIKEYME aims to develop collaborative solutions to regional maritime challenges and enhance interoperability among maritime forces of partner nations, aligning with Prime Minister Narendra Modi's MAHASAGAR vision.
- Indian Navy's Participation: Three Indian naval ships participated in the exercise: INS Chennai, INS Kesari, and Indian Ocean Ship (IOS) Sagar.
- **Significance**: AIKEYME represents a significant evolution in international naval cooperation, fostering trust, building partnerships, and addressing common security concerns among Indian Ocean countries.

3. Jemimah Rodrigues honored with prestigious Shiv Chhatrapati State Sports award

Indian cricketer Jemimah Rodrigues has been conferred with the prestigious Shiv Chhatrapati State Sports Award by the Government of Maharashtra. This esteemed recognition is presented annually to individuals from Maharashtra who have demonstrated exceptional achievements in sports. The award ceremony took place at the Shiv Chhatrapati Sports Complex in Balewadi, Pune, and was graced by dignitaries including Governor Ramesh Bais and Chief Minister Eknath Shinde. The Shiv Chhatrapati Award comprises a cash prize of ₹3 lakh, a memento featuring a headgear of Shiv Chhatrapati, and a lifetime free travel pass on Maharashtra State Road Transport Corporation (MSRTC) buses. 4.Simranpreet Kaur wins maiden senior international medal with silver in 25m pistol

Simranpreet Kaur Brar has clinched her maiden senior international medal, securing silver in the women's 25m pistol event at the ISSF World Cup in Lima, Peru. The 20-year-old shooter achieved a score of 33 hits over 10 rapid-fire series, narrowly missing the gold to China's Sun Yujie, who finished with 34 hits. Another Chinese athlete, Yao Qianxun, earned the



bronze with 29 hits. This accomplishment adds to India's medal tally at the World Cup, which includes two golds and one bronze. Notably, Paris Olympics double medallist Manu Bhaker finished fourth in the same event. Simranpreet's performance underscores her growing prominence in international shooting sports.







- Maiden Senior International Medal: Simranpreet Kaur Brar clinched her first senior international medal, a silver, in the women's 25m pistol event at the ISSF World Cup 2025 in Lima, Peru.
- **Competition Performance**: Simranpreet shot 33 hits in the 10-series of five rapid-fire shots final, finishing one hit behind China's Sun Yujie, who won the gold medal.
- **Indian Trio's Performance**: Simranpreet, along with Manu Bhaker and Esha Singh, ensured all three Indians made the finals. Manu finished fourth with 22 hits, while Esha finished sixth with 17 hits.
- **Qualifying Round**: In the qualifying round, Manu Bhaker scored 585 points to rank second, Simranpreet scored 580 points to rank fifth, and Esha Singh scored 575 points to rank eighth.
- **Medal Standings**: India's Simranpreet Kaur won silver, while China's Sun Yujie took gold, and Yao Qianxun secured bronze with 29 hits.

5.Indian Boxers Shine at Asian U-15 & U-17 Championships with Three Dominant Wins on Day 2

On Day 2 of the Asian U-15 & U-17 Boxing Championships in Amman, Jordan, Indian boxers delivered a stellar performance, securing three dominant victories. In the U-15 boys' 43kg category, Hardik Dahiya showcased his prowess by defeating Kyrgyzstan's Kubanychbek Bolushov with a unanimous 5-0 decision. Rudraksh Singh followed suit in the 46kg division,



overpowering Mongolia's Ibrakhim Maral, also with a 5-0 scoreline. These victories highlight the emerging talent in India's boxing contingent. The championships serve as a platform for young athletes to gain international experience and further their careers in the sport. With such promising performances, India's future in boxing looks bright on the Asian stage.

- **Three Dominant Wins**: Indian boxers secured three victories on Day 2 of the championships, showcasing their dominance in the tournament.
- **Tikam Singh's Win**: Tikam Singh (52kg) won his bout against Ali Almesmari of UAE through a Referee Stopped Contest (RSC) in the third round, building on his gold medal win at the School Games Federation of India (SGFI) 2024.

- Udham Singh's Victory: Udham Singh (54kg) outboxed Mohammadparsa Motevalianastanehsari of Iran, winning 5-0 and demonstrating his skill and strategy in the ring.
- **Rahul Gariya's Success**: Rahul Gariya (57kg) overwhelmed Li Shou-Xun from Chinese Taipei, securing a win through RSC in the first round and showcasing his impressive boxing skills.
- **Strong Indian Performance**: The wins on Day 2 follow India's strong start to the tournament, with Hardik Dahiya (43kg) and Rudraksh Singh (46kg) securing commanding wins on Day 1

6.PoshanTracker Wins Prime Minister's Award for Excellence in Innovation

The Poshan Tracker initiative, developed by the Ministry of Women and Child Development, has been honored with the National Award for e-Governance 2024 (Gold) for its innovative approach to child nutrition monitoring. This ICT-based system is a key component of Mission Poshan 2.0, aiming to enhance the health and well-being of children aged 0-6 years. By utilizing



Growth Measuring Devices (GMD) at Anganwadi Centers, the tracker enables realtime monitoring of children's growth parameters, such as height and weight, against WHO growth standards.

- Award Recognition: The Poshan Tracker application received the Prime Minister's Award for Excellence in Public Administration 2024 under the Innovation category (Centre) on the 17th Civil Services Day.
- **Innovation Impact**: The award recognizes the remarkable leap in technology to improve the lives of millions of women and children across India through the Poshan Tracker app.
- **App Functionality**: The Poshan Tracker is a mobile-based application designed for Anganwadi workers, enabling real-time data collection and monitoring to ensure essential services reach beneficiaries efficiently.
- **Mission Poshan 2.0**: The Poshan Tracker initiative is part of Mission Poshan 2.0, focusing on ensuring the health and well-being of children aged 0-6 years through real-time monitoring of nutritional growth.
- **Coverage and Impact**: The program has achieved significant milestones, covering 8.9 crore children, with 8.57 crore measured in one month, and providing nutritional services to 101 million beneficiaries.





7.Dr. Mangi Lal Jat Appointed as Secretary of DARE and DG of ICAR

Dr. Mangi Lal Jat, a distinguished agronomist and Fellow of the National Academy of Agricultural Sciences (NAAS), has been appointed as the Secretary of the Department of Agricultural Research and Education (DARE) and Director General (DG) of the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR). Dr. Jat's appointment is expected to steer ICAR towards innovative research and development, focusing on enhancing agricultural productivity and sustainability.

seasoned officer, brings extensive experience to the role,

ensuring the Commission's readiness for upcoming electoral processes.
