

1. APPURTENANT (adjective) – संबंधित, आन्षंगिक

Pronunciation: upuh-ti-n(u)nt

Meaning: belonging

Synonyms: pertinent, relevant, related, relating, connected, appertaining

Antonym: unconnected

Usage: Although he borrowed them when he liked, the appurtenant machinery belonged to his father's estate.

2. TESTY (adjective) – क्रोधी, चिड़चिड़ा

Pronunciation: testi

Meaning: easily irritated; impatient and somewhat bad-tempered

Synonyms: grumpy, ill-tempered, ill-natured, ill, humoured, dyspeptic, irritable, tetchy

Antonym: good-humoured

Usage: Ben is getting a little testy in his old age.

3. REGURGITATE (verb) – उल्टी करना, दृहराना; बार-बार कहना

Pronunciation: ri-guh-ji-teit

Meaning: bring (swallowed food) up again to the mouth; repeat (information) without analysing or comprehending

it

Synonyms: vomit, bring up, disgorge, regorge; repeat, restate, recapitulate, iterate, reiterate

Usage

Some birds and animals regurgitate food to feed their young ones.

Don't <u>regurgitate</u> the stuff given in the textbook.

4. BRAINCHILD (noun) – कल्पना; आविष्कार

Pronunciation: brein-cha-ild

Meaning: an idea or invention which is considered to be a particular person's creation

Synonyms: invention, creation

Usage: The project was the <u>brainchild</u> of one of the students.

5. IMPONDERABLE (noun, adjective) – अतिसूक्ष्म

Pronunciation: impond(u)rub(u)l

Meaning: a factor that is difficult or impossible to estimate or assess; difficult or impossible to estimate or assess

Synonyms: elusive, impalpable, impeceptible

Antonyms: assessable

Usage:


There are too many imponderables for an overall prediction. (noun)

The effect of his new method is imponderable. (adjective)

6. ANATHEMA (noun) – घृणित; नागवार

Pronunciation: un-athum-uh

Meaning: something or someone that one vehemently dislikes

Synonyms: abhorrent, hateful, odious, repugnant, repellent, offensive

Antonyms: blessing, benediction

Usage: For older employees, the new system is an anathema.

7. PRAGMATISM (noun) – उपयोगितावाद, यथातथ्यवाद

Pronunciation: prag-mut-izm

Meaning: an approach that evaluates theories or beliefs in terms of the success of their practical application

Synonyms: realism, prudence

Antonyms: foolishness, impracticality

Usage: She had a reputation for clear thinking and pragmatism.

8. COMPLICITY (noun) – सहापराध

Pronunciation: kum-plisiti

Meaning: the fact or condition of being involved with others in an activity that is unlawful or morally wrong

Synonyms: collusion, involvement, collaboration, connivance

Antonym: ignorance

Usage: He is accused of complicity in the murder.

9. EQUITABLE (adjective) – न्यायपूर्ण

Pronunciation: ekwi-tub(u)l **Meaning**: fair and impartial

Synonyms: just, even-handed, fair-minded, unbiased, unprejudiced

Antonyms: inequitable, unfair

Usage: Both sides agreed to try to find an equitable compromise that would please everyone.

10. CONTORT (verb) – मरोड़ना, ऐंठना, विकृत करना

Pronunciation: kun-toh-t

Meaning: twist or bend out of the normal shape **Synonyms:** screw up, distort, quirk, misshape

Usage: His little face would contort in pain every time he coughed or sneezed.


