# 1. Lt Gen M. Subramanian appointed Force Commander of UN Mission in South Sudan

- UN Secretary-General, António Guterres has appointed India's Lt Gen Mohan Subramanian as Force Commander of the United Nations Mission in South Sudan (UNMISS).
- He succeeds Lt Gen Shailesh Tinaikar (India).
- Presently, he is serving as the Commandant of Defence Services Staff College, Wellington.
- Indian Army is active in UN Missions in Congo, Lebanon, South Sudan, Golan Heights, Syria, Western Sahara, Abyei and Cyprus.


2. World Kiswahili Language Day: 7th July

- World Kiswahili Language Day is observed 7th July annually, following a declaration by UNESCO member states.
- Kiswahili is one of the most widely spoken languages in Africa and the most widely spoken in sub-Saharan Africa.
- This is also the only African language that is an official language of the African Union.
- On 7 July, 1954, the Tanganyika African National Union, led by Julius Nyerere has declared Swahili as unifying language for independence struggles.



#### 3. Suranjan Das appointed as president of Association of Indian Universities

- Vice-Chancellor of Jadavpur University, Suranjan Das is appointed as the president of the Association of Indian Universities (AIU).
- His one year tenure has come into effect from July 1.
- Earlier, he was a Professor of History at the University of Calcutta and served the Vice Chancellor at University of Calcutta for the period between 2008 and 2015.
- He was a recipient of the USIS International Visitorship Programme.

#### 6. IRDAI permits tech-enabled add-ons to motor cover

- IRDAI has permitted the general insurance provider to introduce technology-enabled add-ons to motor own damage (OD) insurance cover.
- Add-ons are: Pay-as-you-drive, pay-how-you-drive and floater policy for vehicles belonging to the same individual owner for two wheelers and private cars.
- Objective: It will make motor insurance more affordable, especially for customers who primarily opt for only third-party (TP) insurance and overlook the benefits of OD covers.
