**Meaning:** violent or unsteady movement of air or water, or of some other fluid.

**Synonyms:** Instability, Turmoil

**Antonyms:** Calm, Peace

**Sentence:** The era was characterized by political and cultural turbulence.

#### 2. ASSASSINATION (NOUN): छलघात

Pronunciation: uh·sa·suh·nay·shn

**Meaning:** the action of assassinating someone.

**Synonyms:** Killing, Neutralize **Antonyms:** Revive, Resurrect

**Sentence:** They discovered a secret plot to assassinate the governor.

#### 3. SHATTERED (Verb): परेशान

Pronunciation: sha·tuhd Meaning: extremely upset.

Synonyms: Exhausted, Crippled

Antonyms: Unbroken

**Sentence:** The force of the explosion shattered the windows.

#### 4. STRONGHOLDS (NOUN): কলা

Pronunciation: strawng·holedz

**Meaning:** a well-fortified place; fortress.

**Synonyms:** Garrison, Tower

**Antonyms:** Movable

**Sentence:** The area is a Republican stronghold.

# 5. WREST(VERB) : मुश्किल से प्राप्त करना

**Pronunciation: rest** 

**Meaning:** get something with effort or difficulty.

Synonyms: Snatch, Grab

**Antonyms:** give

### 6. IMPEACHED (VERB): दोषी ठहराना

Pronunciation: im·peecht

Meaning: formally accuse public official of serious crime.

**Synonyms:** Accuse, Indict **Antonyms:** Praise, Flatter

**Sentence:** Each of the chambers has the right to impeach the ministers.

#### 7. GLORIOUS (ADJECTIVE): यशस्वी

Pronunciation: glaw·ree·uhs

**Meaning:** having or deserving fame or success.

**Synonyms:** Renowned, Eminent **Antonyms:** Gloomy, Inferior

**Sentence:** She thought it was a grand and glorious country.

#### 8. ALLURE (NOUN): भरमाना

Pronunciation: uh·lyoh

**Meaning:** the quality of being attractive and exciting.

**Synonyms:** Temptation, Persuasion

**Antonyms:** Repulsion

**Sentence:** The allure of the stage drew him back to acting.

## 9. SQUAD (NOUN): सैनिकों का छोटा सम्दाय

**Pronunciation: skvawd** 

Meaning: a small organized group of military personnel.

Synonyms: Crew, Gang

Antonyms: Participant, Individual

**Sentence:** The club is under investigation by the fraud squad.

#### 10. COVETED (VERB): लोभ करना

Pronunciation: kuh·vuht·uhd


Meaning: to want to have something very much

**Synonyms:** Crave, Desire **Antonyms:** Hate, Dislike

**Sentence:** She always coveted power but never quite achieved it.
