

- The two satellites, SDX01 and SDX02, were launched on December 30 and were initially at a distance of 475 kilometers from each other.
- ISRO scientists brought the satellites closer, first to 15 meters and then to 3 meters, in a trial attempt to test the docking process.
- Although the docking process was postponed due to some issues with the proximity and docking sensor, the satellites were safely moved back to a safer distance.
- The SpaDex mission aims to demonstrate in-space docking using small spacecraft, which is a crucial technology for future missions like the Bharatiya Antariksh Station and landing an astronaut on the moon.
- ISRO will analyze the data further before attempting the docking process again, and the success of this mission will make India the fourth nation to master the complex technologies required for in-space docking.
- The mission has already generated a lot of excitement, and if successful, it will be a significant achievement for ISRO and a major step forward for India's space program.

3. Ira Jadhav becomes highest individual scorer in Women's U19 ODI
