

1. INEXORABLE (adj) : कठोर

Pronunciation: uhn.ek.suh.ruh.bl

Meaning : impossible to stop or prevent.

Synonyms: relentless , unstoppable , unending

Antonyms: improbable , uncertain , unsure

Sentence : the seemingly inexorable march of new technology.

2. INDEFATIGABLE (adj) : अथक

Pronunciation: in.duh.fa.tuh.guh.bl

Meaning : never giving up or getting tired of doing something.

Synonyms: tireless, unflagging, dynamic

Antonyms: idle , feeble , lazy

Sentence: He was indefatigable in his industry and sense of curiosity.

3. BELLICOSE (adj) : लड़ाकू

Pronunciation: beh.luh.kose

Meaning: demonstrating aggression and willingness to fight.

Synonyms: hostile , aggressive , threatening

Antonyms: peaceful , peaceable , pacific

Sentence : At the time, the government was very bellicose about a military campaign.

4. INDOLENT (adj) : अकर्मण्य

Pronunciation: in.duh.luhnt

Meaning: not wanting to work; lazy.

Synonyms : idle , loafing , torpid

Antonyms: diligent , active , ambitious

Sentence: cats are indolent creatures.

5. COPACETIC (adj) : बहुत संतोषजनक"

Pronunciation: koh.puh.seh.tik

Meaning: in excellent order.

Synonyms: perfect , satisfactory , great

Antonyms: bad , poor , inferior


Sentence: he said to tell you everything is copacetic.

6. ANIMUS (noun) : विरोधपूर्ण भावना**Pronunciation:** a.nuh.muhs**Meaning:** hostility or ill feeling.**Synonyms:** hostility , bitterness , hatred**Antonyms :** amity , civility , sympathy**Sentence :** Shiva, rather than Brahma, is the animus behind Fight Club.**7. DISSIPATE (verb) : नष्ट करना****Pronunciation:** di.suh.payt**Meaning:** to slowly become less until it disappears; to make something weaker until it disappears**Synonyms:** vanish , melt away , dispel**Antonyms:** collect , cluster , unite**Sentence :** he made an attempt to dissipate the tension in the room.**8. ASSENT (noun) : अनुमति****Pronunciation:** uh.sent**Meaning:** official agreement to something**Synonyms :** agree to, say yes to , sanction**Antonyms:** dissent , deny , refuse**Sentence :** the parents had to give their assent in writing.**9. AVERSION (noun) : घृणा****Pronunciation:** uh.vuh.zhn**Meaning:** a strong feeling of not liking somebody/something.**Synonyms:** hatred , loathing , revulsion**Antonyms:** love . liking ; favor**Sentence :** Most people have an aversion to spiders.**10. LATENT (adj) : गुप्त****Pronunciation:** lay.tnt**Meaning:** existing, but not yet very noticeable, active or well developed.**Synonyms:** dormant , unused , hidden**Antonyms:** on,active , alive**Sentence :** there is a lot of latent talent in the school.

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
