1. CHURLISH (adjective) – अशिष्ट

Pronunciation: chuh-lish Meaning: unfriendly, bad-tempered, or impolite Synonyms: rude, ill-mannered, discourteous, impolite, ungracious Antonym: polite Usage: It would be churlish to refuse such a generous offer.

2. TUBBY (adjective) - गोलमटोल

Pronunciation: tuh-bi **Meaning**: short and fat **Synonyms**: chubby, plump, stout, roly-poly, dumpy, chunky **Antonyms**: thin, slender, skinny **Usage**: The chef was a tubby man.

3. BOOTLEG (adjective, verb) – अवैध

Pronunciation: boot-leg **Meaning**: (of alcoholic drink or a recording) made, distributed, or sold illegally **Synonyms**: illegal, illicit, unlawful, unauthorized, unsanctioned, unlicensed **Usage**:

- I would suggest that you do not purchase bootleg liquor. (adjective)
- If you bootleg a movie, you are a criminal. (verb)

4. GUTLESS (adjective) – कायर, ब्ज़दिल

Pronunciation: gut-lus
 Meaning: lacking courage or determination
 Synonyms: cowardly, faint-hearted, lily-livered, chicken-hearted, pigeon-hearted, spiritless, spineless, timid
 Antonyms: brave, courageous
 Usage: This government is too gutless to take on the big long-term problems such as pollution.

5. UNDULATE (verb, adjective) – लहराता हुआ, लहरदार होना

Pronunciation: un-dyu-leit, un-dyu-lut **Meaning**: move or go with a smooth up-and-down motion; (especially of a leaf) having a wavy surface or edge **Synonyms**: surge, wave, billow **Usage**:

- On the cruise, I watched several sea animals undulate in the ocean. (verb)
- These leaves have undulate edges. (adjective)

6. PHLEGMATIC (adjective) – आवेगहीन

Pronunciation: fleg-matik

Meaning: a person who does not usually get emotional or excited about things

Synonyms: calm, cool, composed, cool-headed, controlled, serene, tranquil, placid, impassive, self-possessed **Antonyms**: excitable, quick-tempered

Usage: The minister of my church is a phlegmatic man who never seems to get upset about anything.

7. DAUNTLESS (adjective) – निडर, बेबाक़

Pronunciation: dont-lus
Meaning: showing fearlessness and determination
Synonyms: fearless, determined, resolute, indomitable, intrepid, doughty, plucky, spirited
Usage: The dauntless entrepreneurs let their imagination fly in all directions.

8. BLITHESOME (adjective) – प्रफुल्ल, ख़ुशदिल

Pronunciation: blaith-sum **Meaning**: (of a person) having a cheerful attitude; filled with pleasure, or causing pleasure **Synonyms**: cheerful, cheery, happy, merry, jolly, joyful, gleeful, glad **Antonyms**: depressed, serious, sedate **Usage**: She has a blithesome nature.

9. SADDLE (verb) - जिम्मेदारी डालना

Pronunciation: sad(u)l **Meaning**: give someone a burdensome responsibility or task **Synonyms**: burden, encumber, lumber, hamper **Usage**: Don't try to saddle your work on me!

10. SALIENT (adjective) – मुख्य, प्रमुख

Pronunciation: seili-unt Meaning: most noticeable or important Synonyms: main, principal, major, chief, primary, notable Antonyms: unimportant, inconspicuous Usage: She began to summarize the salient points of the proposal.
