Monica Kezia Sembiring won talent finale at Miss World 2025

Monica Kezia Sembiring of Indonesia has won the Miss World 2025 Talent Final, held on May 22 at the Shilpakala Vedika in Hyderabad, Telangana. Her captivating piano performance earned her the top spot among 24 finalists selected from nearly 100 contestants worldwide. As the Talent Challenge winner, Monica secured a fast-track placement into the Top 10 of the Asia and Oceania continental group, significantly enhancing her prospects in the overall competition . Cameroon's Issie Princesse and Italy's Chiara Esposito were named first and second runners-up, respectively .

Foot notes:

- Winner of Talent Finale: Monica Kezia Sembiring, representing Indonesia, won the gold medal in the talent competition at Miss World 2025, securing one of the 10 spots allocated for delegates from Asia and Oceania in the quarterfinals.
- Piano Performance: She delivered a spectacular piano performance that blended Indian and Indonesian music, impressing the audience and judges at the Shilpakala Vedika in Hyderabad.
- Competition Highlights: The talent finale featured 24 finalists from different countries, showcasing diverse performances such as singing, dancing, and spoken word, highlighting various cultures.
- Ranking: Monica Kezia Sembiring took the top spot, followed by Issie Princesse from Cameroon in second place and Chiara Esposito from Italy in third place.

Rashtrapati Bhavan Hosts Artists-in-Residence Programme to Promote Folk Art

In a significant cultural initiative, Rashtrapati Bhavan hosted the "Artists-in-Residence" programme from May 20 to 27, 2025, as part of the Kala Utsav, to promote and preserve India's rich folk and tribal art traditions. This edition spotlighted two of the country's most celebrated art forms: Madhubani from Bihar and Gond from Madhya Pradesh. Renowned artists such as Shanti Devi, Ambika Devi, and Manisha Jha represented Madhubani art, while Durgabai Vyam, Subhash Vyam, and Japani Shyam Dhurwey showcased Gond art. During their week-long residency, these artists created and exhibited their works within the historic premises of Rashtrapati Bhavan.

- Participating Artists: Nine Madhubani artists, including Shanti Devi, Ambika Devi, and Manisha Jha, and eight Gond artists, including Durgabai Vyam, Subhash Vyam, and Nankusia Shyam, showcased their traditional art forms.
- President's Interaction: President Droupadi Murmu interacted with the artists on May 26, 2025, and witnessed the artworks created during their stay. She appreciated their contribution to India's traditional art forms and wished them success in their future endeavors.



- Objectives: The programme aims to preserve and promote India's traditional, tribal, and folk art forms, give national recognition to local artists, and foster artistic exchange and awareness among audiences.
- Art Forms: Madhubani art, characterized by intricate patterns and mythological themes, and Gond art, known for depicting nature and folklore using dots and lines, were showcased during the programme.

India's first gene-edited sheep developed by Kashmir university researchers

In a groundbreaking achievement, researchers at Sher-e-Kashmir University of Agricultural Sciences and Technology (SKUAST-Kashmir) have developed India's first gene-edited sheep. Using CRISPR-Cas9 technology, the team targeted the myostatin gene, which regulates muscle growth, resulting in a lamb with approximately 30% more muscle mass than typical Indian breeds . This advancement, achieved after four years of dedicated research, signifies a major milestone in India's animal biotechnology sector .

Foot notes:

- Gene Editing Technology: Researchers at Sher-e-Kashmir University of Agricultural Sciences and Technology (SKUAST-Kashmir) used CRISPR-Cas9 technology to edit the myostatin gene, a regulator of muscle growth, resulting in a 30% increase in muscle mass.
- Breakthrough Achievement: This achievement marks a significant milestone in animal biotechnology, placing India among a select group of nations with advanced genome editing capabilities.
- Research Team: The research team, led by Dr. Riyaz A Shah, worked on the project for around four years. Shah's team had previously cloned India's first Pashmina goat, "Noori," in 2012.
- Potential Applications: SKUAST-Kashmir aims to build India's most advanced reproductive biotechnology centre.

Aizawl Becomes 4th Northeast Capital Linked to National Railway Network

Aizawl, the capital of Mizoram, has been connected to India's national railway network through the completion of the Bairabi–Sairang railway line. This 51.38 km broad-gauge line extends from Bairabi, Mizoram's previous railhead near the Assam border, to Sairang, a town approximately 20 km from Aizawl . With this development, Aizawl becomes the fourth northeastern state capital to gain railway connectivity, following Guwahati (Assam), Agartala (Tripura), and Itanagar (Arunachal Pradesh) . The Sairang railway station, serving as the terminus of this line, is equipped with modern amenities, including a computerized reservation system, waiting rooms, and food stalls .

Foot notes:

• Railway Connection: Aizawl, the capital of Mizoram, has been officially connected to the national railway network through the Bairabi-Sairang New Line, marking a significant



- milestone in India's efforts to enhance regional integration and transportation connectivity.
- Project Details: The 51.38 km railway project connects Bairabi to Sairang, a satellite town 20 km from Aizawl, and features 48 tunnels, 55 major bridges, 87 minor bridges, 5 Road Over Bridges, and 6 Road Under Bridges.
- Progress and Timeline: The trial run was successfully conducted on May 1, 2025, and the formal inauguration is expected after June 17, pending inspection by the Commission of Railway Safety.
- Impact on Region: This development is expected to catalyze commercial, tourism, and logistic activity, giving a significant push to the local economy and reducing road dependency in a state known for its rugged terrain.

Sumariwalla earns Asian Athletics leadership award in South Korea

Adille J. Sumariwalla, Vice President of World Athletics and former President of the Athletics Federation of India, was honored with the Asian Athletics Leadership Gold Pin during the Asian Athletics Association Congress held in Gumi, South Korea, on May 25, 2025. General Dahlan Al Hamad, President of the Asian Athletics Association, presented the award to Sumariwalla, recognizing his significant contributions to the sport of athletics in Asia. This accolade highlights Sumariwalla's impactful leadership and dedication to advancing athletics across the continent. As a former Olympian and seasoned sports administrator, Sumariwalla continues to play a pivotal role in shaping the future of athletics in Asia.

UN Declares 25th May as World Football Day

The United Nations has officially declared 25th May as World Football Day, recognizing the global impact and unifying power of the sport. The decision honors football's role in promoting peace, inclusion, and cultural dialogue worldwide. It also acknowledges the historical significance of the first international football tournament held on 25th May 1924 during the Summer Olympics in Paris. The day aims to celebrate football's contribution to social development and global cooperation. Member states are encouraged to use this occasion to support grassroots football and inclusive sporting initiatives. The declaration has been welcomed by football fans, players, and organizations across the globe.

- UN Resolution: The United Nations General Assembly adopted a resolution declaring May 25 as World Football Day, recognizing football's global popularity and its power to unite people across cultures and borders.
- Date Significance: May 25 commemorates the 100th anniversary of the first-ever international football tournament, the 1924 Summer Olympics football match between Uruguay and Switzerland, held in Paris.
- Global Celebration: World Football Day aims to promote football's values, such as teamwork, solidarity, and fair play, and to celebrate the sport's ability to bridge cultural divides and foster global understanding.



- Football's Impact: Football is played by over 250 million people in more than 200 countries, making it the world's most popular sport, with a massive following and significant economic and social impact.
- UN's Goals: By declaring World Football Day, the UN seeks to leverage football's global reach to promote peace, development, and social cohesion, aligning with its Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

World largest aerospace-grade titanium unit inaugurated in Lucknow

On May 12, 2025, Defence Minister Rajnath Singh and Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath inaugurated the world's largest aerospace-grade titanium and superalloy materials manufacturing plant in Lucknow. Operated by Aerolloy Technologies Limited, a subsidiary of PTC Industries, this state-of-the-art facility features a German-engineered Vacuum Arc Remelting (VAR) furnace with an annual capacity of 1,500 metric tons, capable of producing titanium alloy ingots up to 1,000 mm in diameter. This development positions India among an elite group of nations—such as the United States, Russia, China, France, and the United Kingdom—that possess the capability to produce high-grade titanium alloys for aerospace applications.

Foot notes:

- Advanced Technologies: The plant utilizes cutting-edge technologies like Vacuum Arc Remelting (VAR), Electron Beam (EB), Plasma Arc Melting (PAM), and Vacuum Induction Melting (VIM) to produce high-grade materials critical for aerospace and defense sectors.
- Reducing Import Dependence: The facility aims to reduce India's reliance on costly imports, which are projected to reach 35,000 crore by 2026. By manufacturing aerospacegrade materials domestically, India can minimize its dependence on foreign suppliers.
- \Aerospace Precision Castings Plant: for single crystal castings vital for jet engine manufacturing
- Aerospace Forge Shop and Mill Products Plant: to eliminate imports of billets, bars, and plates for aerospace applications
- Aerospace Precision Machining Shop: for exporting ultra-precision CNC machined components

Algeria Becomes New Member of BRICS' New Development Bank

Algeria has officially joined the BRICS New Development Bank (NDB), marking a significant milestone in its integration into the global financial system. The announcement was made by NDB President Dilma Rousseff during the bank's ninth annual meeting held on August 31, 2024, in Cape Town, South Africa. This inclusion positions Algeria as the ninth member of the NDB, alongside founding nations Brazil, Russia, India, China, and South Africa, as well as newer members such as Bangladesh, Egypt, the United Arab Emirates, and Uruguay. This strategic move also reflects Algeria's broader ambition to diversify its international partnerships



and reduce reliance on Western-dominated financial institutions like the International Monetary Fund and the World Bank.

Foot notes:

- Membership Approval: Algeria deposited its instrument of accession on May 19, 2025, officially becoming the newest member of the NDB, a multilateral development bank established by BRICS nations (Brazil, Russia, India, China, and South Africa).
- Strategic Partnership: NDB President Dilma Rousseff welcomed Algeria's membership, highlighting the country's significant role in Northern Africa's economy and its potential to enhance NDB's global financial presence. Algeria's dynamic economy, rich natural resources, and strategic geographic position make it an attractive partner.
- Development Goals: The NDB aims to support Algeria's sustainable development agenda through infrastructure and development projects. The bank will work with Algeria to finance impactful initiatives that drive progress and improve lives.
- Global Significance: Algeria's membership marks a significant step in its integration into the global financial system. The NDB provides an alternative to traditional international financial institutions like the World Bank and IMF, offering innovative solutions for growth and resilience.

India Surpasses Japan to Become the World's 4th Largest Economy

India has officially surpassed Japan to become the world's fourth-largest economy, with its nominal GDP reaching \$4.187 trillion in 2025, slightly ahead of Japan's \$4.186 trillion, according to the International Monetary Fund (IMF) . This milestone was confirmed by NITI Aayog CEO B.V.R. Subrahmanyam during the 10th Governing Council meeting, highlighting India's rapid economic ascent . The achievement has been widely celebrated across the nation, with prominent figures like industrialist Anand Mahindra expressing pride and optimism about India's economic future .

Foot notes:

- India's Economic Ranking: India now ranks fourth in the global economy, behind the United States, China, and Germany.
- GDP Projections: The IMF projects India's nominal GDP to reach \$4.187 trillion in FY2026, slightly surpassing Japan's \$4.186 trillion.
- Growth Prospects: India is expected to be the fastest-growing major economy globally over the next two years, with GDP growth rates of 6.2% in 2025 and 6.3% in 2026.
- Overtaking Germany: NITI Aayog CEO BVR Subrahmanyam believes India can become the third-largest economy in 2.5-3 years, overtaking Germany.

Nicusor Dan assumes office as President of Romania

Nicusor Dan has officially assumed office as the President of Romania, marking a significant shift in the country's political landscape. Known for his background in mathematics and civic activism, Dan rose to prominence as a reformist voice advocating transparency and good



governance. His presidential campaign focused on anti-corruption, infrastructure development, and improving public services. Dan's election reflects growing public demand for change and accountability in Romanian politics. He previously served as the Mayor of Bucharest, where he gained recognition for his urban development initiatives. As President, Dan is expected to bring a pragmatic and reform-oriented approach to Romania's national and international affairs.

- Election Victory: Dan won the presidential runoff election on May 18, 2025, securing 53.6% of the votes and defeating George Simion, leader of the Alliance for the Union of Romanians.
- Agenda for Change: In his inaugural address, Dan emphasized the need for "fundamental change" within the framework of the rule of law, urging citizens to maintain "positive pressure" on state institutions to drive reform.
- Pro-EU Stance: As a pro-European centrist, Dan has vowed to keep Romania on its "pro-Western" path, supporting Ukraine and defending democracy and citizens' rights.
- Challenges Ahead: Dan faces significant challenges, including economic issues such as a deficit problem and political strife, and has called for the formation of a majority government to assume fiscal reforms and ensure financial stability.

Uttar Pradesh govt launches India's 1st Vistadome jungle safari train

Uttar Pradesh has launched India's first Vistadome jungle safari train, offering tourists a unique and immersive wildlife experience through the Dudhwa Tiger Reserve and Katarniaghat Wildlife Sanctuary. The 107-kilometer journey, lasting approximately 4 hours and 25 minutes, features specially designed Vistadome coaches equipped with large glass windows and transparent roofs, allowing panoramic views of the lush forest landscape. Initially operating on weekends, the service is set to expand to daily operations to enhance eco-tourism and provide greater accessibility to visitors.

Foot notes:

- Route and Duration: The Vistadome train connects Katarniaghat Wildlife Sanctuary in Bahraich district to Dudhwa Tiger Reserve in Pilibhit, covering 107 kilometers in approximately 4 hours and 25 minutes.
- Special Features: The train features specially designed coaches with large glass windows and transparent roofs, providing tourists with breathtaking views of the jungle's natural landscapes, biodiversity, and wildlife.
- Operational Schedule: Currently, the train operates on weekends (Saturdays and Sundays), but plans are underway to expand it to daily operations, making it accessible to more visitors throughout the year.
- Ticket Price and Package: The ticket costs 275 per person for this route. The Uttar Pradesh Eco Tourism Development Board is also working on a package to transport tourists from Lucknow to Katarniaghat, which may include government subsidies to enhance affordability.

'Mysore Pak' renamed 'Mysore Shree'

The iconic South Indian sweet, 'Mysore Pak', has been officially renamed 'Mysore Shree'. This change was introduced to give the traditional delicacy a more culturally resonant and respectful identity. 'Mysore Shree' is seen as a tribute to the royal heritage of Mysuru, where the sweet originated during the reign of the Wodeyar dynasty. The renaming aims to enhance its appeal in modern markets while preserving its historical roots. Culinary experts and local residents have expressed mixed reactions, with some embracing the change and others preferring the original name. Despite the new title, the recipe and taste of the beloved sweet remain unchanged.



- The term "Pak" in Mysore Pak actually comes from the Kannada word "paaka," referring to the process of cooking food by heating or the sticky sugar syrup used in the sweet, and not from Pakistan.
- Several iconic sweet shops in Jaipur, including Tyohaar Sweets and Bombay Misthan Bhandar, have undertaken this rebranding initiative, replacing "Pak" with alternatives like "Shree" or "Bharat".

Hyderabad is widely recognized as the Pharma Capital of India, a title earned through its substantial contributions to pharmaceutical manufacturing, research, and exports. The city accounts for approximately 30% of India's pharmaceutical production and nearly 20% of its exports, solidifying its status as a global pharmaceutical hub . Hyderabad is also dubbed the "Vaccine Capital of the World", producing a significant share of global vaccines. Companies like Bharat Biotech, Biological E, and Shantha Biotechnics have been instrumental in producing affordable vaccines for diseases like polio, hepatitis, and COVID-19 .

Tata-Airbus to Build India's First Private Helicopter Assembly Line in Karnataka

Tata Advanced Systems Limited (TASL) and Airbus are set to establish India's first privately operated helicopter final assembly line (FAL) in Kolar, Karnataka. This facility will focus on assembling the Airbus H125 helicopter, a versatile single-engine aircraft widely used in civil and law enforcement operations. Located in the Vemagal Industrial Area, the plant will span 740,000 square feet and encompass manufacturing, assembly, and maintenance, repair, and overhaul (MRO) operations. The project aligns with India's 'Make in India' initiative, aiming to boost indigenous aerospace manufacturing capabilities.



Foot notes:

- Helicopter Model: The facility will assemble Airbus' H125 helicopters, a globally popular light helicopter model known for its versatility and performance in high-altitude and hot conditions.
- Production Capacity: Initially, the plant will have a production capacity of 10 H125 helicopters per year, with plans to scale up based on future demand and export opportunities.
- Strategic Importance: This collaboration symbolizes the increasing role of the private sector in India's defence and aerospace space, boosting indigenous manufacturing of critical aerospace components, generating high-skilled employment opportunities, and enhancing India's export competitiveness.

IIT Kharagpur & Singapore's IME Sign MoU to Boost Semiconductor Innovation

IIT Kharagpur has entered into a strategic partnership with Singapore's Institute of Microelectronics (IME), a part of A*STAR, to advance semiconductor innovation. The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU), signed during SEMICON Southeast Asia 2025, focuses on collaborative research in areas such as advanced CMOS technologies, AI hardware accelerators, quantum devices, and chip packaging. This alliance also includes exchange programs, specialized training, and joint workshops aimed at nurturing talent in the semiconductor sector. This partnership positions both institutions at the forefront of global semiconductor research and development.

- Strategic Importance: This partnership is seen as a transformative step in expanding IIT Kharagpur's global engagement in semiconductor research, contributing to India's ambitions in the semiconductor domain, and building a resilient and competitive technology ecosystem.
- Global Implications: The collaboration is expected to accelerate innovation, build skilled talent pipelines, and address common industry challenges, ultimately strengthening the positions of India and Singapore in the global semiconductor landscape.
- IIT Kharagpur and IME, a core research entity under Singapore's Agency for Science, Technology and Research (A*STAR), have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to foster collaborative research and human capital development in semiconductor technologies.





India has made significant contributions to the 2025 Breakthrough Prize in Fundamental Physics, awarded to the four major Large Hadron Collider (LHC) collaborations: ATLAS, ALICE, CMS, and LHCb for their pioneering work in particle physics. Indian scientists played crucial roles in these collaborations, particularly in the CMS and ALICE experiments. Notable Indian physicists such as Dipanwita Dutta from the Bhabha Atomic Research Centre, Gagan Mohanty of the Tata Institute of Fundamental Research, and J.B. Singh from Panjab University have been instrumental in advancing our understanding of the Higgs boson and exploring the properties of quark-gluon plasma .

- Indian Contributions: Indian scientists and researchers played a significant role in the international collaboration for the ALICE and CMS experiments, contributing to detector development, data analysis, and other areas.
- Research Institutions: Several Indian institutions, including the Tata Institute of Fundamental Research (TIFR), Indian Institute of Science (IISc) Bengaluru, and various IITs, were part of the ALICE and CMS collaborations.
- Key Achievements: Indian scientists designed and constructed critical components, such as the Photon Multiplicity Detector and Muon Spectrometer for ALICE, and contributed to Higgs boson searches and supersymmetry studies in CMS.
- Computing and Storage: India played a vital role in the Worldwide LHC Computing Grid (WLCG), providing computing and storage resources through Tier-2 centers at TIFR Mumbai and VECC Kolkata.

Indian Army officer Major Rohit Kadian shines in World Masters Games

Major Rohit Kadian of the Indian Army delivered an exceptional performance at the 11th World Masters Games in Taiwan, securing four medals across various track events. Competing in the 40–45 age category, he clinched a gold medal in the 1500m race, earning the title of world champion. Additionally, he won silver medals in the 800m and 5000m events, and a bronze in the 400m race. His achievements underscore not only his personal dedication and athletic prowess but also the resilience and discipline emblematic of the Indian Army.

- Gold Medal: He won the gold medal in the 1500m race (40-45 age category) with a time of 4:31.72, earning the title of World Champion.
- Silver Medals: Major Kadian secured two silver medals in the 800m and 5000m races, finishing second in both events with times of 2:13.82 and 17:18.01, respectively.
- Bronze Medal: He also won a bronze medal in the 400m race, clocking 58.65 seconds in the final.
- Competition: Major Kadian competed against elite international athletes and former Olympians, showcasing his grit, determination, and world-class athleticism.



Indian Javelin Thrower Neeraj Chopra Clinches Silver Medal At Janusz Kusocinski Memorial Meet

Competing under challenging cold and wet conditions at the Silesian Stadium, Chopra delivered his best throw of 84.14 meters in his sixth and final attempt, moving from third to second place in the competition. Germany's Julian Weber clinched the gold with a throw of 86.12 meters, while Grenada's Anderson Peters took bronze with 83.24 meters.

Under the leadership of Luciano Spalletti, Napoli displayed consistent brilliance throughout the season. Key players like Victor Osimhen and Khvicha Kvaratskhelia played pivotal roles in their title run. This triumph marks Napoli's first Serie A crown since the era of Diego Maradona in 1990.

- Final Match Result: Napoli secured the Serie A title with a 2-0 victory over Cagliari in the final round, thanks to goals from Scott McTominay's stunning bicycle kick and Romelu Lukaku's solo effort.
- Title Race: Napoli edged out Inter Milan by a single point, despite Inter winning their final match 2-0 against Como. Napoli's victory ensured they didn't need to rely on Inter dropping points.
- Antonio Conte's Achievement: Coach Antonio Conte made history by becoming the first manager to win Serie A titles with three different clubs: Juventus, Inter Milan, and Napoli. This marks his fifth Scudetto win.



• Napoli's Dominance: The win marks Napoli's fourth Serie A title, with previous wins in 1986-87, 1989-90, and 2022-23. They have now secured their second title in three years, showcasing sustained performance.

Sri Lankan all-rounder Angelo Mathews retires from Test cricket

Sri Lankan cricket stalwart Angelo Mathews has announced his retirement from Test cricket, with his final appearance set for the first Test against Bangladesh in Galle on June 17, 2025. At 37, Mathews cited his decision as a move to "make way for young players". Over a distinguished 16-year career, he played 118 Tests, amassing 8,167 runs at an average of 44.62, including 16 centuries, and captained Sri Lanka in 34 matches. His retirement comes amid concerns over Sri Lanka's limited Test schedule, with only four matches slated for 2025.

- Career Highlights: Mathews played 118 Tests for Sri Lanka, scoring 8,167 runs at an average of 44.62, with 16 centuries and 45 half-centuries. He also took 33 wickets and captained the team in 34 Test matches.

Indian shooter Shambhavi clinched the gold medal in the Women's 10m Air Rifle event at the ISSF Junior World Cup, showcasing exceptional skill and composure. Competing against top young shooters from around the world, she delivered a stellar performance to secure the top podium spot. Her victory adds to India's growing dominance in junior shooting competitions. This achievement not only highlights Shambhavi's rising talent but also reflects the effectiveness of India's grassroots sports development programs.

- Gold Medal in Women's 10m Air Rifle: Shambhavi won the gold medal in this event at the ISSF Junior World Cup 2025.

Star tennis player, Novak Djokovic scripted history by clinching 100th ATP singles title

Novak Djokovic achieved a historic milestone by securing his 100th ATP singles title at the 2025 Geneva Open. In a grueling final, he overcame Poland's Hubert Hurkacz with a scoreline of 5–7, 7–6(2), 7–6(2), marking a significant comeback after previous final losses. At 38 years old, Djokovic became only the third man in the Open Era to reach this century mark, joining legends Jimmy Connors (109 titles) and Roger Federer (103 titles). This victory also extended his remarkable streak of winning at least one ATP title in 20 consecutive seasons, a testament to his enduring excellence. As he prepares for the upcoming French Open, Djokovic continues to solidify his legacy as one of tennis's all-time greats.

Foot notes:

- Comeback Victory: Djokovic trailed 4-2 in the deciding set but managed to pull a break back in the eighth game, converting one of five break points.

India equalized in the 21st minute with a penalty corner goal from Sonam, but Uruguay regained the lead shortly after with Agustina Mari's goal in the 24th minute. In the final quarter, Kanika Siwach turned the game around for India by scoring twice—first from a penalty corner in the 46th minute and then a decisive field goal in the 50th minute—securing the win for her team.

Alina Nestsiarovich, competing as an Individual Neutral Athlete, earned the silver with 29 hits, while Hungary's Miriam Jako took bronze with 23 hits. Tejaswini's consistent shooting throughout the competition showcased her skill and determination. This achievement not only marks a significant milestone in her career but also underscores India's growing prominence in the international shooting arena.

His earlier throws measured 56.11m and 55.51m, followed by subsequent throws of 58.54m, 57.25m, and 58.07m. The F42 classification is designated for athletes with moderate movement impairment in one leg. Gurjar's achievement not only secured him the gold medal in his category but also highlighted India's growing prominence in para-athletics.

Arsenal Triumphs Over Barcelona to Won Women's Champions League 2025

Arsenal Women clinched their second UEFA Women's Champions League title with a stunning 1-0 victory over defending champions Barcelona on May 24, 2025, at Lisbon's Estadio José Alvalade. The decisive moment came in the 74th minute when substitute Stina Blackstenius netted the winning goal, converting a precise pass from Beth Mead just seven minutes after both entered the match .The victory sparked jubilant celebrations among Arsenal fans and players alike, with over 10,000 supporters gathering in North London to welcome the team home .

- Tactical Brilliance: Arsenal employed a 4-4-2 mid-block, applying pressure to Barcelona's players and disrupting their flow. This strategy limited Barcelona to just 0.87 expected goals.
- Defensive Heroics: Arsenal's defense was solid, with players like Steph Catley and Caitlin Foord making crucial interventions to block Barcelona's attacks. The team's defenders didn't commit a single foul during the match.
- Substitutions: Coach Renee Slegers' tactical substitutions played a significant role, with Beth Mead and Stina Blackstenius bringing fresh energy and a new dynamic that Barcelona struggled to counter.
- Historical Significance: This win marks Arsenal's first European title in 18 years, making them the only English club to have won the Champions League trophy. The victory has been likened to Emma Raducanu's US Open win in 2021, a momentous achievement for British women's sports.



Indian cricketer Priyank Panchal announced his retirement from all forms of cricket on May 26, 2025, concluding a distinguished 17-year career in domestic cricket .Panchal's retirement marks the end of an era for Gujarat cricket. His dedication, leadership, and contributions to domestic cricket have left an indelible mark, inspiring future generations of cricketers.

In his acceptance speech, he urged national unity and emphasized freedom of expression in Iran.

Rajesh's career spanned several decades, during which he portrayed a wide range of characters, from lead roles to strong supporting parts. He was also recognized for his contributions to theater and literature. In 2014, he was honored with the Dr. Rajkumar Cultural Endowment Award by the Kannada Sahitya Parishat. Rajesh is survived by his daughter Aasha Rani, who is married to actor Arjun Sarja. His passing was mourned by fans and the film industry alike, marking the end of an era in Kannada cinema.


