

1.TRANSIENT(ADJECTIVE) : क्षणिक

Pronunciation:tran·zee·uhnt

Meaning: Lasting for only a short time; temporary

Synonyms: Ephemeral , Short –term, brief **Antonyms:** Permanent , Constant, perpetual

Sentence: The snow is <u>transient</u> and will melt as soon as the sun appears.

2.DEFER(VERB): आस्थगित करें

Pronunciation:di-fuh

Meaning: to leave something until a later time.

Synonyms: postpone, delay, wait **Antonyms:** do, act, deal(with)

Sentence:He was not a man to <u>defer</u> this kind of pressure.

3.DISRUPT(VERB): विघ्न डालना

Pronunciation: duhs.ruhpt

Meaning: to stop something happening as or when it should.

Synonyms: destroy, shatter, bust **Antonyms:** Organize, fix, repair

Sentence: Alcohol can <u>disrupt</u> the chromosomes of an unfertilized egg.

4.GLORIFY (VERB): महिमामंडन

Pronunciation:glaw·ruh·fai

Meaning: to make somebody/something appear better or more important than he/she/it really is.

Synonyms: Exalt, Elevate, worship **Antonyms:** Dishonor, humble, decry

Sentence: A football video went viral glorifying violence.

5.FASCINATING (ADJECTIVE): आकर्षक

Pronunciation: fa·suh·nay·ting Meaning: extremely interesting.

Synonyms: Captivating, Absorbing, interesting

Antonyms: Boring, dull, revolting

Sentence:He was also the most <u>fascinating</u> person she'd ever spoken to.

6.OVERSTATED(VERB): अतिरंजित

Pronunciation:oh·vuh·stayt·uhd

Meaning: To state something too strongly **Synonyms:** Emphasize, Exaggerate, overdo **Antonyms:** Understated, reasonable, realistic

Sentence: The prospect of a trade war is vastly <u>overstated</u>.

7.DELIMITATION(NOUN): परिसीमन

Pronunciation:duh·li·muht·ay·shn

Meaning: Method of fixing the limits or boundaries of something.

Synonyms: Demarcate, define, limit

Antonyms: Liberation, let go

Sentence: The delimitation of the sea is the most pressing security issue affecting the

region.

8.MARSHALLED(VERB): ठीक करना

Pronunciation:maa·shld

Meaning: To bring together or organize people or things in order to achieve a particular

aim.

Synonyms: Mobilized , Organized, arrranged **Antonyms:** Disorder, dismissed, disrupted

Sentence: The company <u>marshalled</u> itself in the sad remains of the village.

9.SPAT(NOUN) : झगड़ा

Pronunciation:spat

Meaning: A short argument usually about something that is not important.

Synonyms: Altercation, dispute, bicker **Antonyms:** Harmony, accept, agree

Sentence: She was having a <u>spat</u> with her brother about who should do the washing up.

10. Stratagem (Noun) : युक्ति

Pronunciation: stra.tuh.jm

Meaning: a trick or plan for deceiving an enemy.


Synonyms: ruse, scheme, trick

Antonyms: frankness, honesty, honor

Sentence: a cunning <u>stratagem</u> completely misled the opposition.
