5. DISSENT (noun) – मतभेद

Meaning: the expression or holding of opinions at variance with those previously, commonly, or officially held.

Synonyms: disagreement, lack of agreement, dispute



Antonyms: accord, agreement, concord **Sentence:** In those days, religious dissent was not tolerated.

9. PROPULSION (noun) - संचालक शक्ति
