1. BREACH (Noun) : उल्लंघन

Pronunciation: breech

Meaning: A break or violation, often of trust, law, or relations.

Synonyms: Violation, offence, sin

Antonyms: observance, upholding, respecting

Sentence: they heard the waters pour through the breach in the sea wall.

2. INCITED (Verb) : उकसाना

Pronunciation: uhn.site.uhd

Meaning: To stir up or provoke to action, often negatively.

Synonyms: Provoked, spurred, instigated.

Antonyms: Calmed, restrained, discouraged.

Sentence: any priests refused to collaborate with the authorities, and some incited disobedience.

3. REBUKE (Verb) : निन्दा करना

Pronunciation: ruh.byookt

Meaning: to speak angrily to somebody because he/she has done something wrong.

Synonyms: Reprimand, scold, censure

Antonym: citation, tribute, honor

Sentence: she had rebuked him for drinking too much.

4. RAMPANT (ADJECTIVE): अनियंत्रित

Pronunciation: ram.pnt

Meaning: (used about something bad) existing or spreading everywhere in a way that is very difficult to control.

Synonyms: unrestrained, unchecked, uncontrolled

Antonyms: controlled, hampered, hindered

Sentence: a rich soil soon becomes home to rampant weeds.

5. IMMEDIATE (ADJECTIVE): तत्काल

Pronunciation: i.mee.dee.uht

Meaning: existing now and needing urgent attention.

Synonyms: instant, swift, speedy

Antonyms: distant, slow, tardy

Sentence: Roads in the immediate vicinity of the port.

6. INCUMBENT (ADJECTIVE): पदधारी

Pronunciation: uhng.kuhm.bnt

Meaning: a person who is currently in an official position.

Synonyms: obligatory, mandatory, binding

Antonyms: optional, applicant, hopeful

Sentence: the present incumbent will soon be retiring.

7. AGITATION (NOUN): व्याकुलता

Pronunciation: a.juh.tay.shn

Meaning: a state of excitement, disturbance, or worry.

Synonyms: perturbation, disquiet, distress

Antonyms: calmness, still, peace

Sentence: She was wringing her hands in agitation.

8. ADJOURNMENT (NOUN): स्थगन

Pronunciation: uh.juhn.muht

Meaning: a pause or rest during a formal meeting or trial.

Synonyms: lull, pause, rest

Antonyms: continuation, run, stretch

Sentence: she sought an adjournment of the trial.

9. CASTIGATE (VERB): आलोचना करना

Pronunciation: ka.stuh.gayt

Meaning: to criticize, strongly oppose or punish somebody/something severely.

Synonyms: berate, rag, lambast

Antonyms: praise, approve, laud

Sentence: She was castigated for not setting a good example.

10. RESUMPTION (NOUN): पुनरारंभ

Pronunciation: ruh.zuhmp.shn

Meaning: beginning again or continuing after a pause or interruption.

Synonyms: restarting, reopening

Antonyms: suspension, abandonment

Sentence: with peace came the resumption of foreign imports.
