4. PERFIDIOUS (ADJECTIVE): धोखेबाज़

Pronunciation: puh·fi·dee·uhs

Meaning: deceitful and untrustworthy. Synonyms: Treacherous, deceptive, disloyal Antonyms: Loyal, honest, true Sentence: She described the new criminal bill as a perfidious attack on democracy.

5. CONTRAVENE (VERB): उल्लंघन करना

9. THRESHOLD(NOUN): चौखट

Pronunciation: thresh-holed

Meaning: the ground at the entrance to a room or building. Synonyms: Commencement, Baseline, Onset Antonyms: Conclusion, Closure, ending Sentence: You know when you cross that threshold, there's no going back.

10. UPEND (VERB): समाप्त कर देना
