Pronunciation: kaws Meaning: small or meager Synonyms: filthy, foul Antonyms: refined, decent Usage: We should avoid coarse words especially for females.

2. VANISH (verb) – गायब होना

Pronunciation: va·nuhsh Meaning: disappear Synonyms: dissolve, fade Antonyms: appear, arrive Usage: The cold weather conditions have <u>vanished</u> nowadays.

3. SPURIOUS (adj) – जाली

Pronunciation: spyoo.ree.uhs
Meaning: fake
Synonyms: counterfeit, artificial
Antonyms: authentic, genuine
Usage: Beware of <u>spurious</u> things for sale in the market because they can harm you.

4. MALICE (noun) – क्रोध

Pronunciation: ma·luhs
Meaning: hate
Synonyms: antipathy, grudge
Antonyms: benevolence, kindness
Usage: Avoid the feelings of malice in your heart because they bring you pain.

5. GENIAL (adj) - मिलनसार

Pronunciation: ge.nalMeaning: friendly.Synonyms: cheerful, fruitfulAntonyms: hostile, unfriendly



Usage: It is always great to work in a genial environment.

6. BARE (adj) – बहुत कम

Pronunciation: 'ber Meaning: small amount Synonyms: minimal, less Antonyms: plenty, lot Usage: We ate the <u>bare</u> food that you provided us but we are still hungry.

7. AFFABLE (adj) – मैत्री

Pronunciation: af fa ble
Meaning: sociable
Synonyms: friendly, courteous
Antonyms: harsh, enemy
Usage: We must try to be <u>affable</u> in our lives so that we can earn a good image in the society.

8. ALLOCATION (noun) – आवंटन

Pronunciation: al·lo·cation
Meaning: allotment
Synonyms: supply, provision
Antonyms: deletion, removal.
Usage: They will take care of the <u>allocation</u> for the resources, don't worry.

9. FRAGMENTED (verb) – खंडित

Pronunciation: frag ment ed Meaning: divided Synonyms: broken, partitioned Antonyms: colluded, joined Usage: Use the <u>fragmented</u> drawers to keep the tools given to you.

10. IGNORANT (adj) – अज्ञानी

Pronunciation: ig·no·rant Meaning: illiterate Synonyms: ill-mannered, crude Antonyms: well-off, refined Usage: The people who are <u>ignorant</u> of others, are bound to be treated badly.
