

1. TRADUCE (VERB): बदनाम करना

Pronunciation: truh·dyoos

Meaning: speak badly of or tell lies about (someone) so as to damage their reputation.

Synonyms: defame, slander, speak ill of

Antonyms: honor, exalt, applaud

Sentence: The crooked politician paid a newspaper editor to traduce his rivals.

2. ENGENDER (VERB): उत्पन्न होना

Pronunciation: uhn·jen·duh

Meaning: cause or give rise to (a feeling, situation, or condition).

Synonyms: create, generate, cause **Antonyms:** impede, restrict, quash

Sentence: It helps engender a sense of common humanity.

3. MERCENARY(ADJECTIVE): लालच

Pronunciation: muh·suh·nuh·ree

Meaning: having or marked by an eager and often selfish desire especially for material

possessions.

Synonyms: greedy, avaricious, acquisitive **Antonyms:** altruistic, charitable, liberal

Sentence: She's interested in him for purely mercenary reasons.

4. TACITURN (ADJECTIVE): अल्पभाषी

Pronunciation: ta·suh·tuhn

Meaning: reserved or uncommunicative in speech; tending not to speak much.

Synonyms: untalkative, uncommunicative, reticent

Antonyms: blabby, chatty, talkative

Sentence: My shy brother is taciturn and rarely speaks in public.

5. RENEGE (VERB): वादा कर के मुकर जाना

Pronunciation: ruh·nayg

Meaning: to go back on a promise, commitment, or agreement; to fail to fulfill an obligation.

Synonyms: backtrack, retract, back out

Antonyms: fulfil, keep, uphold

Sentence: He promised to help me with the project but reneged on his commitment.

6. PESTILENT (ADJECTIVE): ज़हरीला

Pronunciation: peh·stuh·luhnt

Meaning: causing or capable of causing disease; harmful, destructive, or deadly.

Synonyms: harmful, dangerous, toxic

Antonyms: beneficial, harmless, innocuous

Sentence: The city was plagued by a pestilent epidemic, resulting in numerous

7. POACHING (VERB): अवैध शिकार

Pronunciation: poche·uhng

Meaning: to hunt animals illegally.

Synonyms: illicit capturing, wildlife trafficking **Antonyms:** conservation, protection, preservation

Sentence: Poaching has had a devastating impact on the tiger population in this region.

8. CONSTERNATION (NOUN): व्याकुलता

Pronunciation: kawn·stuh·nay·shn

Meaning: a feeling of anxiety, shock, or dismay, typically caused by something

unexpected or unsettling.

Synonyms: dismay, shock, alarm

Antonyms: calmness, composure, serenity

Sentence: The sudden announcement of the company's closure caused consternation

among its employees.

9. SUCCOUR (VERB): सहायता करना

Pronunciation: suk-ar

Meaning: to help someone, especially someone who is suffering or in need.

Synonyms: aid, assistance, relief, **Antonyms:** hinder, obstruct, impede

Sentence: The organization provided succour to the victims of natural disaster by

supplying food and shelter.

10. GELID (ADJECTIVE): ਠੱਤਾ

Pronunciation: gel·

Meaning: extremely cold.

Synonyms: frigid, freezing, chilly

Antonyms: warm, hot, heated

Sentence: We bundled up in warm coats and hats to protect ourselves from the gelid temperatures outside his insatiable desire for food.
