### 1. SENSITIZING (verb) : संवेदनशील

**Meaning:** Making someone aware of a situation or attitude

**Pronunciation:** Sensitizing

**Synonyms:** alerting, acquainting

**Antonyms:** desensitizing, deadening

**Sentence:** The workshop aimed at sensitizing the participants about environmental conservation.

### 2. VENTURING (verb) : उद्यम

**Meaning:** Daring to do something or go somewhere that may be dangerous or unpleasant

**Pronunciation:** ven·chuh·ruhng

**Synonyms:** risking, daring

**Antonyms:** avoiding, shunning

**Sentence:** He hesitated before venturing into the dark forest.

### 3. OVERSTRETCHED (adj) : बढ़ा हुआ

**Meaning:** Extended to the limit

**Pronunciation:** oh·vuh·strecht

**Synonyms:** overextended, strained

**Antonyms:** relaxed, eased

**Sentence:** The overstretched resources were not able to support the growing population.

### 4. SABOTAGE (noun) : तोड़फोड़

**Meaning:** The act of intentionally preventing the success of a plan or action

**Pronunciation:** sa·buh·taazh

**Synonyms:** destruction, disruption

**Antonyms:** Assistance, support

**Sentence:** The team suspected sabotage when their equipment stopped working suddenly.

### 5. VOWED (verb) : कसम खाई

**Meaning:** to make a serious promise or decision

**Pronunciation:** vawd

**Synonyms:** promised, sworn

**Antonyms:** renounced, retracted

**Sentence:** The minister vowed to fight corruption in all its forms.

### **6. STRIVING (verb) : प्रयास**

**Meaning:** to try very hard to achieve something

**Pronunciation:** strai·ving

**Synonyms:** endeavoring, trying

**Antonyms:** surrendering, giving up

**Sentence:** We are striving to improve our performance.

### **7. CURTAIL (verb) : कमी करना**

**Meaning:** to reduce or limit something

**Pronunciation:** curtail

**Synonyms:** reduce, cut back

**Antonyms:** extend, increase

**Sentence:** We had to curtail our vacation due to unforeseen circumstances.

### **8. PERCOLATED (verb) : सूझ-बूझ फैलना**

**Meaning:** to spread gradually or filter through

**Pronunciation:** puh·kuh·layt·uhd

**Synonyms:** filtered, seeped

**Antonyms:** stopped, collected

**Sentence:** The information slowly percolated through to the general public.

### **9. DISTINCT (adj) : अलग**

**Meaning:** clearly different or of a different kind

**Pronunciation:** duh·stingkt

**Synonyms:** different, separate

**Antonyms:** similar, indistinguishable

**Sentence:** Each language has its distinct characteristics.

### **10. EROSION (noun) : अपरदन**

**Meaning:** the gradual destruction or reduction of something

**Pronunciation:** i·roh·zhn

**Synonyms:** decay, degradation

**Antonyms:** construction, buildup

**Sentence:** The erosion of public trust in the government is a major concern.
