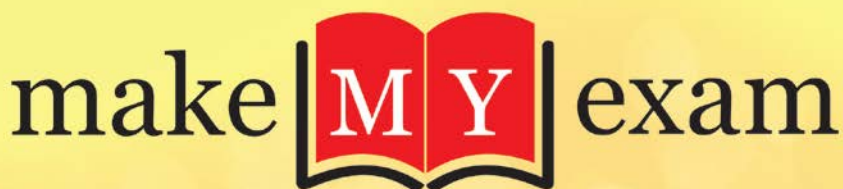


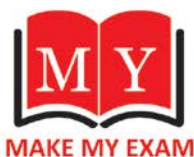

Ans1: (B) GREAT = 8\$9

G = 7 in alphabet + 2 = 9

T = 7 in reverse order + 1 = 8

Five letter word = \$

Ans2: (B) Error = 10\$7

E = 5 in alphabet + 2 = 7

R = 9 in reverse order + 1 = 10

Five letter word = \$

Ans3: (C) Burst = 8\$4

B = 2 in alphabet + 2 = 4

T = 7 in reverse order + 1 = 8

Five letter word = \$

Ans4: (B) Person = 14\*18

P = 16 in alphabet + 2 = 18

N = 13 in reverse order + 1 = 14

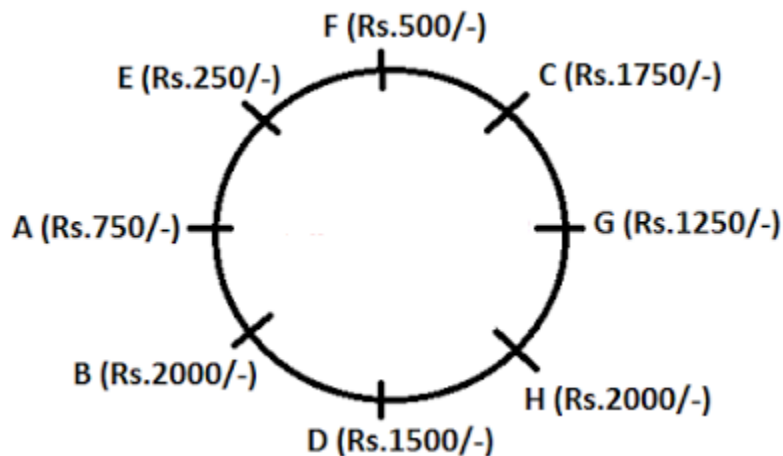
Six letter word = \*

Ans 23: (A) Clearly, for better economic gain, losses should be reduced and income increased. So, only course I follows

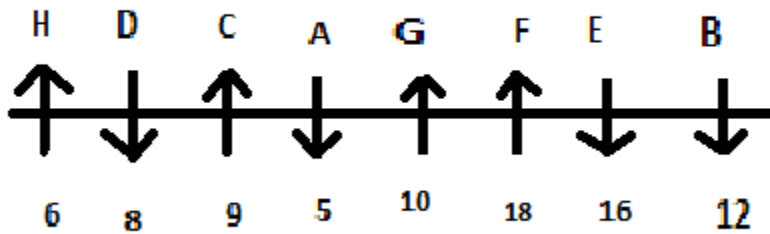

Ans 41: (B) when prices are reduced, the motive is to attract customers. Hence I is not implicit but II is.

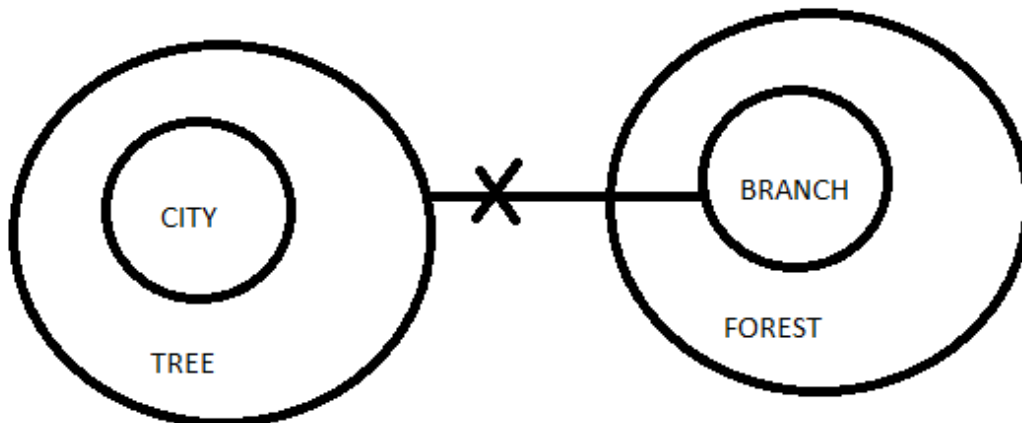
Ans 42: (E) Both have been assumed by the railway authority while putting the revised timing on the website.

Ans 44: (E) I is implicit in the deadline given. II is implicit in the notice given to the residents to move out.

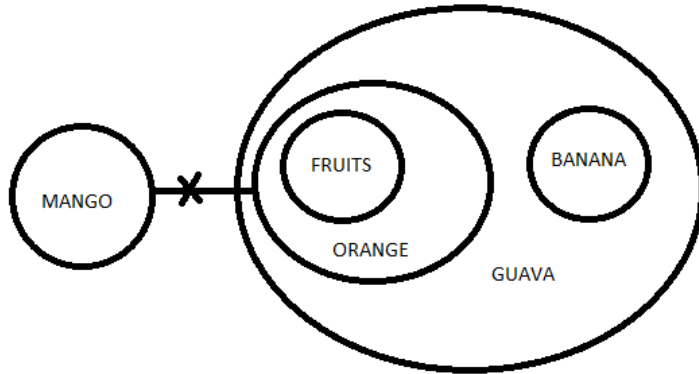
Ans 45: (A) I is implicit; otherwise more players would have been selected. II is not implicit because even without the captain, there will be sufficient number of players.

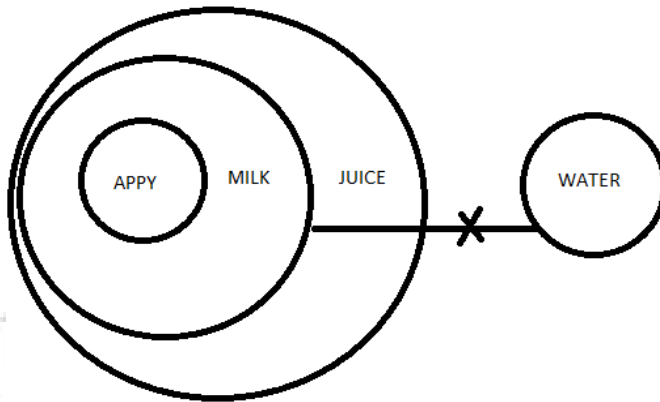

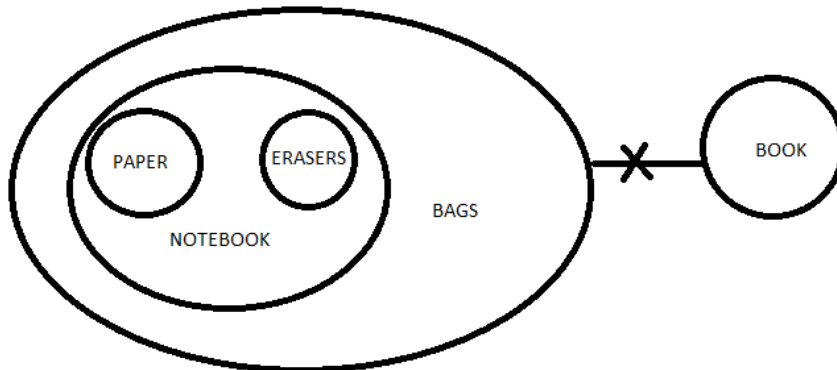
