




# DAILY VOCAB DOSE

#### 1.DECADENCE (noun): पतन

Pronunciation: deh•kuh•dns

Meaning: moral or cultural decline as characterized by excessive indulgence in pleasure or

luxury.

**Synonyms:** dissipation, dissoluteness, degeneracy

**Antonyms:** ascent, rise, morality

**Sentence:** The <u>decadence</u> of morals is bad for a nation.

# 2.UNSCATHED (adj.) : पूरा हुआ

Pronunciation: uhn•skaydhd

**Meaning:** without suffering any injury, damage, or harm.

Synonyms: unharmed, unhurt, uninjured

Antonyms: damaged, harmed, hurt

**Sentence:** He escaped <u>unscathed</u> from the accident.

## 3.ASSORTMENT (noun) : वर्गीकरण

Pronunciation: uh sawt muhnt

Meaning: a miscellaneous collection of things or people.

Synonyms: mixture, variety, array

Antonyms: likeness, sameness, similarity

**Sentence:** The room was filled with an <u>assortment</u> of clothes.

#### 4.UNEQUALED (adj.): अप्रतिम

Pronunciation: uhn•ee•kvld

Meaning: superior to all others in performance or extent.

Synonyms: unbeaten, unmatched, matchless

**Antonyms:** inferior, lesser, common

Sentence: His power as a popular street-corner orator was probably <u>unequaled</u> in that

generation

# 5.RELINQUISHED (verb): त्याग कर दिया

Pronunciation: ruh•ling•kvuhsht

Meaning: voluntarily cease to keep or claim; give up.

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**Synonyms:** renounce, give up, part with **Antonyms:** kept, retained, withheld

**Sentence:** He <u>relinquished</u> his managerial role to become chief executive.

### 6.CONFLATE (verb) : मिलाना

Pronunciation: kuhn•flayt

**Meaning:** combine (two or more texts, ideas, etc.) into one.

Synonyms: add, admix, combine

Antonyms: break down, separate, unmix

**Sentence:** The results of the two experiments were <u>conflated</u>.

#### 7.INIQUITOUS (adj.) : अन्यायी

Pronunciation: uh•ni•kvuh•tuhs

**Meaning:** grossly unfair and morally wrong.

**Synonyms:** wicked, sinful, evil **Antonyms:** decent, ethical, good

**Sentence:** Have you seen this bill? It's <u>iniquitous!</u>

#### 8.SCURRILOUS (adj.): मिथ्या

Pronunciation: skuh•ruh•luhs

Meaning: making or spreading scandalous claims about someone with the intention of

damaging their reputation.

**Synonyms:** abusive, vituperative, derogatory

Antonyms: respectful, polite, gracious

**Sentence:** He wrote a <u>scurrilous</u> piece about me in the local press.

#### 9.PUTREFY (verb) : सड़ना

Pronunciation: pyoo•truh•fai

**Meaning:** (of a body or other organic matter) decay or rot and produce a fetid smell.

**Synonyms:** decay, rot, decompose **Antonyms:** develop, grow, mature

**Sentence:** The body was beginning to putrefy.

#### 10.UNFLINCHING (adj.) : बेहिचक

Pronunciation: uhn•flinch•uhng


Meaning: not showing fear or hesitation in the face of danger or difficulty.

**Synonyms:** resolute, determined, single-minded **Antonyms:** slackening, impotent, invertebrate

Sentence: He has shown <u>unflinching</u> determination throughout the campaign.

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
