#### 1. INSOLENT (adjective) - असभ्य, अविनीत

Pronunciation: ins(u)l(u)nt

**Meaning**: showing a rude and arrogant lack of respect **Synonyms**: impertinent, impudent, cheeky, ill-mannered

Antonym: polite

**Usage**: The band is known for its insolent attitude.

#### 2. ASTRAY (adverb) - पश्रभष्ट

Pronunciation: us-trei

Meaning: away from the correct path or direction; into error or morally questionable behaviour

Synonyms: off target, awry, off course, off track, adrift

Usage:

It's better to ask the way than go <u>astray</u>.

This novel is likely to lead teenagers <u>astray</u>.

#### 3. STRAITENED (adjective) - दरिद्र

Pronunciation: strei-tnd

Meaning: characterized by poverty

**Synonyms**: impoverished, poverty-stricken, poor, destitute, penniless **Usage**: The family of eight was living in <u>straitened</u> circumstances.

#### 4. CALUMNIATE (verb) - बदनाम करना

Pronunciation: kulum-ni-eit

**Meaning**: make false and defamatory statements about someone

**Synonyms**: defame, slander, traduce **Usage**: Do not <u>calumniate</u> good people.

#### 5. BAULK (verb) - हिचहिचाना, अनिच्छुक

Pronunciation: bolk

Meaning: hesitate or be unwilling to accept an idea

**Synonyms**: eschew, resist

Antonym: accept

**Usage**: New parents baulk at hiring a babysitter if there is a grandparent readily available.

#### 6. DESPERADO (noun) – दुष्ट, बदमाश

Pronunciation: despuh-raado

Meaning: a person who is willing to do criminal things that involve risk or danger

**Synonyms**: bandit, criminal, outlaw, renegade, marauder, raider, robber

**Usage**: It was a shock for me to know that the clergyman's son was a <u>desperado</u>.

#### 7. MOGUL (NOUN) - प्रसिद्ध व्यक्ति

Pronunciation: mo-gl

**Meaning**: an important or powerful person, especially in the film or media industry

**Synonyms**: magnate, tycoon, VIP, biggie, bigwig

#### 8. SMITHEREENS (noun) – छोटो-छोटे ट्कड़े

Pronunciation: smi-thuh-reenz

Meaning: small pieces

Synonyms: bits, fragments, shreds, pieces, particles

Antonyms: whole, chunk

**Usage**: The car was bombed to smithereens on the bridge.

#### 9. FUSSY (adjective) – न्कताचीन, नख़रेबाज़

**Pronunciation**: fuh-si

Meaning: hard to please; showing excessive or anxious concern about detail; full of unnecessary detail or

decoration

Synonyms: finicky, over-particular, fastidious, selective, dainty, punctilious; over-elaborate, over-embellished,

overdecorated, over-ornate, overdone, overworked

Antonyms: indiscriminate, understated

Usage: The children's fussy dietary habits stopped them from eating anything besides hamburgers and pizzas.

#### 10. HIDEBOUND (adjective) - रुढ़िवादी, कहर, परम्परावादी

Pronunciation: haid-baund

**Meaning**: unwilling or unable to change because of tradition

Synonyms: conservative, reactionary, conventional, orthodox, fundamentalist, hard-line, diehard

Antonyms: liberal, broad-minded

Usage: Because my grandmother is hidebound, she does not believe in intercaste marriage.


