- **Collegium Decision**: The Supreme Court Collegium, headed by Chief Justice Sanjiv Khanna, approved the proposal for the appointment of the two judges as permanent judges in its meeting held on February 5, 2025.
- **Appointment Process**: The appointment of judges to the High Court is made by the President under Article 217 of the Constitution, based on the recommendation of the Supreme Court Collegium.

- **Surpassing Bravo**: Dwayne Bravo, the previous record holder, had taken 631 wickets in 582 matches during his 18-year T20 career.
