1. Venu Srinivasan Honoured with CII Quality Ratna Award 2025

• Leadership in Quality Management: Venu Srinivasan has been recognized for his decades-long commitment to quality excellence, which has driven India's manufacturing growth story.



- **Pioneering TQM in India**: Under his leadership, TVS Motor became the first non-Japanese two-wheeler firm to win the Deming Prize in 2002, setting a benchmark for Indian manufacturing.
- Customer-Centric Approach: Srinivasan emphasizes that designs should be led by customer needs, and employee trust is essential for long-term success.
- Contribution to India's Manufacturing Ambition: His recognition aligns with India's goal to increase its global manufacturing share from 3% to 25% and create 100 million jobs.
- Awards and Recognition: The CII Quality Ratna Award is one of India's highest industrial recognitions, honoring individuals who demonstrate sustained commitment to quality, operational excellence, and leadership.

2. India's First Commercial PSLV Set to Launch

• **First Commercial PSLV**: The rocket is built entirely by the private sector, marking a significant shift in India's space program.

• Oceansat Satellite Launch: The PSLV will carry the Oceansat satellite, used for ocean and atmospheric studies, into orbit.

- **HAL-L&T Consortium**: The rocket is manufactured by a consortium of Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) and Larsen & Toubro (L&T), showcasing India's private sector capabilities.
- **ISRO's New Role**: This launch reflects ISRO's strategy to focus on advanced research and upcoming missions, while private industry handles commercial launch operations.
- **Boost to India's Space Economy**: The launch is expected to strengthen India's position in the global commercial space sector, with growing interest from domestic and international customer.

3. Neeraj Agrawal appointed as the next Ambassador of India to the Islamic Republic of Mauritania

- **Appointment and Experience**: Neeraj Agrawal, a 2009 batch IFS officer, is currently posted in the Ministry of External Affairs and is expected to take up his new assignment shortly.
- India-Mauritania Relations: India and Mauritania enjoy cordial and friendly relations, with India opening its Embassy in Nouakchott in June 2021.



- **Development Cooperation**: India provides substantial developmental, human resource development, and infrastructural aid to Mauritania, including a Line of Credit (LOC) of US\$21.8 million for agro-industrial and drinking water projects.
- Strategic Partnership: The appointment aims to strengthen cooperation in trade, cultural exchanges, and foreign office consultations between India and Mauritania.
- India's Africa Outreach: Agrawal's appointment reflects India's broader strategy to deepen its footprint in Africa, emphasizing economic ties, soft diplomacy, and cultural engagement.

4. M Salman Baseer elected as Chairman of Karnataka Planters Association

• New Leadership: Baseer has taken over as Chairman, with M C Kariappa as Vice-Chairman, at the 67th Annual General Meeting of KPA held in Chikmagaluru.

- **Coffee Industry Impact**: The new leadership aims to tackle challenges in the coffee industry, ensuring the sector's growth and sustainability.


