



1. Govt appoints Vaibhav Chaturvedi as RBI representative

The Central Government has appointed Vaibhav Chaturvedi, Chief General Manager of the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), as the exofficio member of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India (IBBI) to represent the RBI.
