1. CAPACIOUS (ADJECTIVE): विशाल

Pronunciation: kuh·pay·shuhs

Meaning: a space or container that is able to hold or accommodate a significant amount.

Synonyms: Spacious, Roomy, Ample

Antonyms: Compact, Cramped, Narrow

Sentence: She was known for her capricious behavior, often changing her mind without reason.

2. PRANCE (VERB): उछल-कूद

Pronunciation: praans

Meaning: to move with high spirits or lively steps, especially in a playful or proud manner.

Synonyms: Dance, Skip, Strut, Caper, Frolic

Antonyms: Stumble, Trudge, Plod, Lumber

Sentence: The horse can prance elegantly, lifting its hooves high in a display of controlled energy.

3. VEILED (ADJECTIVE): घूँघट में

Pronunciation: vayld

Meaning: concealed or hidden.

Synonyms: Covered, Masked, Obscured

Antonyms: Revealed, Exposed, Clear

Sentence: The politician's speech contained veiled criticism of the opposing party.

4. VANDALISED (VERB): तोड़-फोड़

Pronunciation: van·dal·ized

Meaning: to intentionally damage, destroy, or deface property or public belongings.

Synonyms: Defaced, Desecrated

Antonyms: Restored, Repaired, Preserved

Sentence: The teenagers were caught vandalizing the bus stop with spray paint.

5. SWARMED (VERB): झुण्ड

Pronunciation: svawmd

Meaning: to gather or move in a large number or group, often in a rapid and overwhelming manner.

Synonyms: Teemed, Crowded, Inundated

Antonyms: Dispersed, Scattered, Isolated

Sentence: The fans swarmed the stage after the concert.

6. ABETMENT (NOUN): सहयोग

Pronunciation: abet-ment

Meaning: act of encouraging, aiding, or assisting someone in committing a crime or wrongdoing.

Synonyms: Assistance, Support, Encouragement

Antonyms: Hindrance, Deterrence, Opposition

Sentence: The court found him guilty of abetment in the robbery.

7. INTRIGUED (ADJECTIVE): उत्सुक, आकर्षित

Pronunciation: uhn·treegd

Meaning: to make somebody very interested and wanting to know more.

Synonyms: Fascinated, Captivated, Engrossed

Antonyms: Indifferent, Uninterested, Bored

Sentence: She was intrigued by the strange symbols on the ancient artifact.

8. SHACKLES (NOUN): हथकड़ी

Pronunciation: sha·klz

Meaning: metal restraints or chains used to confine or restrain a person's wrists or ankles.

Synonyms: Handcuffs, Manacles, Fetters

Antonyms: Freedom, Liberation

Sentence: The prisoner's wrists were bound tightly with cold, steel shackles, preventing any chance of escape from the maximum-security prison.

9. SKIDDED (VERB): फिसलन

Pronunciation: skid·uhd

Meaning: to suddenly slide forwards or sideways without any Control.

Synonyms: Glided, Skated, Careened

Antonyms: Stopped, Halted, Stayed

Sentence: The car skidded on the icy road, causing the driver to lose control and collide with a nearby lamppost.

10. ORCHESTRATE (VERB): योजना बनाना


Pronunciation: aw·kuh·strayt

Meaning: to plan, organize, or arrange events, actions, or elements in a deliberate and coordinated manner.

Synonyms: Coordinate

Antonyms: Disrupt, Dismantle, Disperse

Sentence: The opposition party orchestrated a protest against the new bill.
