

1. APPOSITE (adjective) – उचित

Pronunciation: a · puh · zuht

Meaning: apt in the circumstances or in relation to something

Synonyms: appropriate, suitable, fitting, apt, befitting, relevant, pertinent

Antonyms: inappropriate, malapropos

Usage: Her remarks are extremely <u>apposite</u> to the present discussion.

2. KNACK (noun) – कौशल

Pronunciation: nak

Meaning: an acquired or natural skill at doing something

Synonyms: gift, talent, flair, genius, instinct, faculty, ability, capability

Antonyms: inability, incapacity

Usage: She has a <u>knack</u> for handling horses.

3. ABOLISH (verb) - समाप्त करना

Pronunciation: uh·bo·luhsh **Meaning**: formally put an end to

Synonyms: scrap, end, stop, terminate, eradicate, eliminate, exterminate

Antonyms: retain, create

Usage: We will abolish museum charges for school parties.

4. REPUDIATE (verb) – अस्वीकार करना

Pronunciation: ruh·pyoo·dee·eit **Meaning**: refuse to accept; reject

Synonyms: reject, renounce, abandon, forswear, deny, disavow, recant

Antonyms: embrace, confirm, acknowledge

Usage: He used his position to <u>repudiate</u> the charge.

5. DOCTRINAIRE (adjective) – কহ্ব



Pronunciation: dok·truh·neuh

Meaning: seeking to impose a doctrine in all circumstances without regard to practical

considerations

Synonyms: dogmatic, rigid, inflexible, uncompromising, unyielding, adamant, insistent

Antonyms: liberal, flexible

Usage: Don't be so doctrinaire about things.

6. INFRINGE (verb) – उल्लंघन करना

Pronunciation: uhn · frinj

Meaning: actively break the terms of a law, agreement, etc.

Synonyms: contravene, violate, transgress, break, breach, disobey, defy

Antonym: obey, uphold

Usage: These restrictions infringe upon basic human rights.

7. NETHER (adjective) – निचला

Pronunciation: neh·thuh **Meaning**: lower in position

Synonyms: lower, low, lower-level, bottom, bottommost, under, underground, basement

Antonym: upper, higher

Usage: The nether region of the vessel was much more crowded than the front.

8. MONOTONOUS (adjective) – नीरस

Pronunciation: muh·no·tuh·nuhs



Meaning: dull, tedious, and repetitious; lacking in variety and interest **Synonyms**: tedious, boring, dull, uninteresting, unexciting, tiresome

Antonyms: varied, interesting, exciting

Usage: The music became monotonous after a while.

9. COUNTERFEIT (adjective) – नक़ली

Pronunciation: kawn·tuh·fuht

Meaning: made in exact imitation of something valuable with the intention to deceive or

defraud

Synonyms: fake, faked, copied, forged, feigned, simulated, sham

Antonyms: genuine, authentic

Usage: This ten dollar bill is a counterfeit.

10. TRANNY (noun) - अत्याचार

Pronunciation: ti·ruh·nee

Meaning: cruel and oppressive government or rule

Synonyms: despotism, absolutism, autocracy, dictatorship, oppression, suppression,

repression

Antonym: democracy, liberality

Usage: The emperor's tyranny was responsible for the deaths of thousands of innocent

people.
