

Meaning: alliance.

**Synonyms:** association, partnership **Antonyms:** disunion, separation

**Sentence:** With the collaboration, he undertook the preparation of an inventory.

# 3. VITAL (ADJECTIVE): महत्वपूर्ण

Pronunciation: vai·tl Meaning: essential.

**Synonyms:** crucial, necessary **Antonyms:** optional, secondary

Sentence: States are a vital part of the grand coalition between the two countries.

# 4. GRAVITATE (VERB): केंद्र की ओर झ्कना

Pronunciation: gra·vuh·tayt

Meaning: drift.

Synonyms: incline, tend Antonyms: ascend, increase

**Sentence:** They gravitate to these areas.

### 5. STAGGER (VERB): लड़खड़ाकर चलना

Pronunciation: sta·guh
Meaning: move unsteadily.
Synonyms: careen, lurch
Antonyms: continue, stay

Pronunciation: faw·tuh·fai

Meaning: invigorate.

Synonyms: Strengthen, Energize

**Antonyms:** Sedate

**Sentence:** She is fortified by her religious faith.

# 9. PRECISION (NOUN): शुद्धता

**Pronunciation:** pruh·si·zhn

Meaning: exactness.

Synonyms: Accuracy, Correctness

Antonyms: Inaccuracy

**Sentence:** The deal was planned and executed with military precision.

# 10. RETREAT (VERB): पीछे हटना

Pronunciation: ri-treet


Meaning: go out.

**Synonyms:** Ebb, Recede **Antonyms:** Come in
