


1.FATIGUE(NOUN) : थकान

Pronunciation:fuh·teeg

Meaning: the feeling of being extremely tired.

Synonyms : Drowsiness , Weariness, tiredness

Antonyms : Vigorous, rest, relax

Sentence:She continued to have severe stomach cramps, aches, fatigue, and depression.

2.BOLSTERED(VERB) : बल मिला

Pronunciation:bole·stuhd

Meaning: To support or encourage somebody/something

Synonyms : Strengthened , Boost, fortify

Antonyms : Opposed , Discourage, undercut

Sentence:The IAF said that there was a need for India to bolster its "technological asymmetry."

3.TENABLE(ADJECTIVE) : लायक

Pronunciation:teh·nuh·bl

Meaning: (used about a theory, opinion, etc.) able to be defended against attack or criticism.

Synonyms: Justifiable , Plausible, arguable

Antonyms : Irrational, liable, vulnerable

Sentence: His theory is no longer tenable in the light of the recent discoveries.

4.COMPLACENCY(NOUN) : शालीनता

Pronunciation:kuhm·play·suhns·ee

Meaning: Self-satisfaction especially when accompanied by unawareness of actual dangers or deficiencies.

Synonyms: Comfort , Ease

Antonyms : Humility , Diffidence

Sentence:This boundless complacency was due to policy, not weakness.

5.DEFT(ADJECTIVE) : चतुर

Pronunciation:deft

Meaning: (used especially about movements) skilful and quick.

Synonyms: Adept , Adroit, nimble

Antonyms : Crude , Clumsy, rude

Sentence: She answered the journalist's questions with a deft touch.

6.SPARSE(Adjective) : विरल

Pronunciation:spaas

Meaning: Small in number or amount and spread out over an area.

Synonyms: Meagre , Scanty, infrequent

Antonyms : Abundant , Plentiful, sufficient

Sentence: Many slopes are rock fields with sparse vegetation.

7.CONVERGENCE(NOUN) : अभिसरण

Pronunciation:kuhn·vuh·jns

Meaning: the act of converging and especially moving toward union or uniformity.

Synonyms : Assemble , Confluence, join

Antonyms : Divergent, disperse, disband

Sentence: Economic forces converged to bring the country out of a recession.

8.VANGUARDS(NOUN) : मोहरा

Pronunciation:vang·gaad

Meaning: the leaders of a movement in society, for example in politics, art, industry, etc.

Synonyms: Avant-garde, van, precursor

Antonyms : old guards , establishment

Sentence: The company is proud to be in the vanguard of scientific progress.

9.BUOYANCY(NOUN) : उछाल

Pronunciation: boy·uhns·ee

Meaning: the tendency of a body to float or to rise when submerged in a fluid.

Synonyms : Ebullience , Vivacity

Antonyms : Inadequacy , Helplessness

Sentence:She was in a buoyant mood and they were looking forward to their new life.

10.FERVOR(NOUN) : जोश

Pronunciation:fuh·vuh

Meaning: Very strong feeling or belief

Synonyms : Ardor , Passion, heat

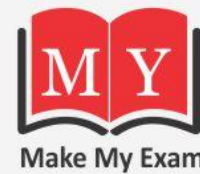
Antonyms : Apathy , Dullness, dryness

Sentence: They were concerned only with their own religious fervor.

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
