

1. FEASIBLE (ADJECTIVE): व्यवहार्य

Pronunciation: fee·zuh·bl Meaning: practicable.

Synonyms: possible, doable

Antonyms: impossible, implausible

Sentence: This seems to be a feasible solution.

2. SUBVERSIVE (ADJECTIVE): विनाशक

Pronunciation: suhb·vuhs·uhv

Meaning: disruptive.

Synonyms: inflammatory, insurgent

Antonyms: loyal

Sentence: He was seen as a potentially subversive man within the party.

3. CAPTIVATE (VERB): मोह लेना

Pronunciation: kap·tuhv·ayt

Meaning: enthrall.

Synonyms: charm, enchant

Antonyms: repel

Sentence: He was captivated by her beauty.

4. ABANDONED (ADJECTIVE): असंयत

Pronunciation: uh·ban·dnd

Meaning: uninhibited.

Synonyms: reckless, unrestrained

Antonyms: restrained

Sentence: He performed a wild, abandoned dance.

5. BUTTRESS (VERB): समर्थन देना

Pronunciation: buh truhs Meaning: strengthen.

Synonyms: reinforce, fortify

Antonyms: weaken

6. ENLIVEN (VERB): हर्षित करना

Pronunciation: uhn·live·uhn

Meaning: cheer up.

Synonyms: raise someone's spirits, uplift

Antonyms: subdue

Sentence: My visit to my mother had quite clearly enlivened her.

7. DETENTION (NOUN): क़ैद

Pronunciation: duh·ten·shn

Meaning: custody.

Synonyms: imprisonment, confinement

Antonyms: relinquishment

Sentence: The fifteen people arrested were still in police detention.

8. ALLIANCE (NOUN): संबंध

Pronunciation: uh·lai·uhns

Meaning: relationship.

Synonyms: affinity, association

Antonyms: distance

Sentence: A balanced alliance between traditions and modernity avoids chaos.

9. ACQUITTAL (NOUN): दोषमुक्ति

Pronunciation: uh-kvit-uhl

Meaning: a formal declaration in a court of law that someone who has been accused

of a crime is innocent.

Synonyms: clearing, exoneration

Antonyms: conviction

Sentence: Any charge ever brought against him resulted in an acquittal.

10. RENUNCIATION (NOUN): निवृत्ति

Pronunciation: ruh·nuhn·see·ay·shn

Meaning: abandonment.


Synonyms: resignation, abdication

Antonyms: assertion

Sentence: The talks were dependent on a renunciation of terrorism.
