

## **National News**

# 1. Jammu and Kashmir government appointed RK Chibber as interim chief of J&K Bank

- → Jammu and Kashmir government removed Jammu and Kashmir (J&K) Bank Chairman Parvez Ahmad. They decided to take long term measures to improve the functioning of the bank so that it becomes an example of a well managed government-owned bank.
- ♣ They appointed R K Chibber as interim chairman of the lender.
- 4 Ahmad was appointed in 2016 as the chairman of the bank. The Vigilance Organisation made 1,200 appointments during the previous PDP-BJP dispensation in the state during Ahmad's tenure as chairman of the bank.
- → Jammu and Kashmir Bank decided to take long term measures to improve the functioning of the bank and it becomes a shining example of a well managed government-owned bank.
- Last year the Governor-led State Administrative Council (SAC) approved the proposal for treating Jammu and Kashmir Bank Limited as a public sector undertaking (PSU) and to make it to the state legislature from its employees. The government will re-examine the issue of accountability.

# 2.Union Cabinet has approved the Brucellosis control program to improve the health of animals Union:

- ♣ •Union Cabinet has approved the Brucellosis control program, a new scheme, to control Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) and Brucellosis to support the livestock rearing farmers and improve the health of animals.
- ♣ •This initiative aims to fully control these diseases amongst livestock in the country in the next five years and subsequently eradicate these diseases.
- ◆ Cabinet has approved a total outlay of Rs.13,343 crores for the scheme and entire cost will be now borne by Central Government. Earlier the cost was shared by both Central and State Governments. It is very common amongst the livestock, cow-bulls, buffaloes, sheep, goats, pigs, etc.



## 3. India's first Dinosaur Museum inaugurated in Gujarat:

- Gujarat Chief Minister Vijay Rupani on Saturday inaugurated India's first dinosaur museum and fossil park at Raiyoli village near Balasinor town of Mahisagar district.
- ♣ •According to government officials, Raiyoli is globally known to be the third largest fossil site and the second largest dinosaur hatchery from where about 10,000 dinosaur eggs have been found.
- ♣ •This is the first such park in the country and also the world's third park which exhibits remains of various dinosaurs and fossil records.3D projection, 360 degrees virtual reality presentations, interactive kiosks, gaming consoles are the facilities equipped with the museum.

## 5. Sharad Kumar named interim CVC:

- ◆ •Prime Minister Narendra Modi headed selection panel has been named Sharad Kumar as interim Central Vigilance Commissioner (CVC) for a term of four years or till he attains the age of 65.
- ◆ The move comes after the Central Vigilance Commissioner (CVC) KV Chowdary completed his tenure at anti-graft body.



♣ •Mr. Sharad Kumar was a former head of the National investigation agency(NIA). He was appointed as the Central Vigilance Commissioner on June 2018 and his tenure will end on October 2020.

# 6.Centre has extended the Rs 1.6 Billion aid to Nepal for Rebuilding Earthquake-hit Houses:

- ◆ Indian government has extended the financial aid of 1.6 billion Nepalese rupees to Nepal for the rebuilding of houses in Nuwakot and Gorkha districts, which were damaged in the devastating earthquake in 2015. The cheque for the same was handed over by India's ambassador to Nepal Manjeev Singh Puri to Finance Secretary of Nepal Rajan Khanal.
- ▶ •India is maintaining its commitment regarding the completion of postearthquake reconstruction projects in the Himalayan nation. As of now, India has granted Nepal a total of 4.5 billion Nepalese rupees under the housing reconstruction projects.
- ◆ •India has also partnered with United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and United Nations Office for Project Services (UNOPS) for providing socio-technical facilitation to the house owners to ensure that they rebuild their homes as per Nepal government's earthquake resilient norms.

# 1. Sri Lankan Airlines named world's most punctual air service for second consecutive time

- ♣ SriLankan Airlines named as the 'World's Most Punctual Airline' for the second consecutive time with over 90 percent of its flights in May. This status was achieved for the second time in less than 12 months. They achieved a punctuality rating of 91.37 percent reports Xinhua news agency. In a may month they achieved a punctuality rating of 90.75 percent.
- ♣ Flightstats analyzed 41 carriers data from Europe, North America, Asia, the Middle East, and South America and includes most of the world's most prestigious airlines
- ♣ The punctuality rating of 90.75% by SriLankan Airlines in May 2019 facing challenges caused by heightened security at airline's hub at Bandaranaike International Airport (in Sri Lankan capital Colombo).

## 3. World's Highest Weather Stations Installed Atop Mount Everest

- ♣ A team of Tribhuvan University and National Geographic Society scientists and researchers have installed the world's highest, fully automated weather stations atop Mount Everest.
- ♣ Scientists announced that they successfully installed five automated stations, including the highest weather station in world, on Mount Everest's flank.
- ♣ Total five weather stations, including one at a record height of 27,657 feet, were installed on the Earth's highest mountain above sea level.

## 4.Global Peace Index 2019: India Ranks 141st, Iceland Tops

- India's rank has slipped five places to 141 among 163 countries on the Global Peace Index 2019, while Iceland remains the most peaceful country and Afghanistan the least peaceful nation, as per the report by Australian think tank Institute for Economics & Peace.
- ☐ In South Asia, Bhutan topped the index with 15th rank, followed by Sri Lanka 72, Nepal 76 and Bangladesh 101. The neighboring country Pakistan has been ranked 153rd on the index.

# 5.India Designated As Guest Country at Guadalajara International Book Fair In Mexico

- ♣ India designated as the Guest of Honour at the 33rd Feria Internacional del Libro de Guadalajara (Guadalajara International Book Fair) in Mexico, the National Book Trust.
- → The book fair organized from November 30 December 8, India pavilion at the fair will showcase over 35 Indian authors and artists, along with 15 publishing houses.
- ♣ India displays a wide array of its rich and composite literary and cultural heritage through literary and academic activities comprising conferences.
- 4 Ancient and rare manuscripts including "Mahabharata" and "Ramayana" will be put on exhibition, along with photo books, handicrafts, and paintings.
- ♣ The exhibition will run parallel to the book fair in the pavilion. They will feature art by 40 renowned Indian women artists including Arpana Caur, Paula Sengupta, and Seema Kohli.
- ♣ The "Festival of India" will showcase folk, classical and contemporary cultural programmes.

# 1. Paytm Payments Bank ahead of major banks in digital transaction target with 501.16 crore digital transactions

- ♣ Paytm Payments Bank with 501.16 crore digital transactions for the financial year 2019-20 was ahead of major banks including HDFC Bank, Industrial Credit and Investment Corporation of India (ICICI) Bank and Punjab National Bank in digital transaction target set by the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY). It is only behind the State Bank of India (SBI) which has the highest target for digital transactions.
- ♣ Only 5 banks have received a target of more than 100 crore transactions. They are HDFC Bank, ICICI Bank, Axis Bank, Punjab National Bank and Union Bank of India.
- ♣ In FY 2018-19, Paytm payments bank had crossed the target of 354 crore transactions and recorded 393 crore digital transfers. It has a market share of 19% and 32% respectively in terms of mobile banking and Unified Payments Interface (UPI)transactions.
- Lit processes over Rs 3 lakh crore worth of digital transactions on an annual basis. In terms of deposits, it has more than Rs 500 crore deposits in savings accounts as of April 2019. It is largest among the payments bank in India.

## 2. SBI cuts interest rate on CC/OD, introduces repo linked home loan product

- ♣ On June 7, 2019, State Bank of India (SBI) announced to introduce repo-linked home loan product from July 1, 2019. It has become the first bank to offer this facility.
- The home loans up to Rs 75 lakh will be priced at 2.65% over the repo rate of 5.75% resulting in the interest rate of 8.40%. At present, it offers home loanslinked to its marginal cost of funds at 8.55%.SBI also reduced the interest rate on Cash Credit Account (CC) and Overdraft (OD) customers with limits above Rs 1 lakh, after the RBI reduced the repo rate by 25 basis points to 5.75%.
- ♣ At present, the effective Repo-Linked Lending Rate (RLLR) for CC/ OD customers is 8% whereas for savings deposits above Rs 1 lakh the new rate is be 3%.
- ♣ iv. In March, SBI had linked all CC accounts and ODs with limits above Rs 1 lakh to the repo rate plus a spread of 2.25%. For above Rs 1 lakh, it had set its savings deposit rates to 2.75% below the repo rate.

- ♣ According to the Sebi circular, rating companies will now create a uniform probability of default benchmark for each rating category on their website, for one-year, two-year and three-year cumulative default rates, both for the short term and long term.

## 10. Govt. Plans To Raise USD 84 Billion From Airwayes Auction In 2019

♣ Prime Minister Narendra Modi-led NDA Government hopes to increase around \$83.8 billion (Rs 5.83 trillion rupees) from its latest round of airwaves auction in 2019.



- ♣ The Central government is planning to sell 8,600 megahertz of telecom airwaves across multiple frequency bands. Rs 65,789 crore was raised in the airwaves auction held by the government in 2016-17.
- Recently, Telecom Minister Ravi Shankar Prasad announced the debut auction of fifth-generation (5G) spectrum this year along with trials within 100 days.

## 11. Recent Reports Says The Global Internet Users Have Touched 3.8 Billion

- According to the Mary Meeker's 2019 Internet Trends Report that the global internet users have touched 3.8 billion which is more than half of the world's population.
- ♣ China was found to have the largest internet user base at 21%. The internet users in India are 12%, and the United States are 8%.
- ♣ The report said Asia Pacific region was found to be leading in terms of both the number of users and potential internet users with 53% of users coming from this part of the world.
- 4 Global internet users making 51% of the world's population is a considerable growth as compared to 29% of the world's population using the internet in 2009. The report noted a slowdown in the year-on-year growth in the volume of global internet users.

## 12. UNCTAD World Investment Report 2019

- According to the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD) World Investment Report 2019, India received foreign direct investments (FDI) worth USD 42 billion in 2018.
- ♣ India attracted over 77% of the total foreign direct investments that came to the South Asian region.
- ♣ India's rank as a source country for FDI dropped one place to the 10th position as it was overtaken by Spain.

- ♣ He was recognised as the elected president by the Central Election Commission (CEC) and will take an oath of office June 12. Earlier, on 20th March 2019, Tokayev took office as the Interim President of Kazakhstan & succeeded Nursultan Nazarbayev who served as the President from the country's independence in 1992 until his resignation.
- → The President of the Republic of Kazakhstan is the head of state, commander-in-chief and holder of the highest office within the Republic of Kazakhstan.

## 1.India successfully launched new Technology Demonstrator Missile in Odisha

♣ On June 12, 2019, India successfully launched new Hypersonic Technology Demonstrator Vehicle (HSTDV) off the coast of Odisha. Defence Research and



Development Organisation (DRDO) had carried out the trials from Dr Abdul Kalam Island in the Bay of Bengal. HSTDV will help DRDO to develop technologies for futuristic missions.

- The test was conducted by the Premier Defence Research Agency in the presence of Defence Minister Rajnath Singh and Secretary (Defence Production) Ajay Kumar at the test firing range in Balasore, Odisha.HSTDV, developed by DRDO with help from Israel and the UK, will be mounted on a solid rocket motor to take it to the required altitude. After the required altitude is reached and the Mach is achieved, the cruise vehicle will be ejected out of the launch vehicle.
- ♣ It is a dual-use technology Project with civilian applications. It has a flight duration of 20 seconds at an altitude of 31 km.

## 4. India to have its own space station: ISRO

- 4 Dr. K. Sivan, Chairman of the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) announce that India plans to have its own space station, and modalities for it will be worked out after the first manned mission, Gaganyaan, scheduled for August 2022,
- → Dr. Sivan said the proposed space station is envisaged to weigh 20 tonnes and serve as a facility where astronauts can stay for 15-20 days, and it would be placed in an orbit 400 km above earth.
- **↓** The time frame for launch is 5-7 years after Gaganyaan, he added.
- ♣ The ISRO would also join the international space community for a manned mission to moon and beyond.

## 5. 2nd Moon Mission Chandrayaan-2: Two Scientists Ritu Kridhal And Vanitha

- ♣ For the first time, Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has appointed two women scientists Ritu Karidhal (as mission director) and Muthayya Vanitha (as project director) to head the India's second Moon mission Chandrayaan-2.
- ISRO Chairman K Sivan announced that close to 30 percent of the ISRO team working on Chandrayaan 2 are women.
- ♣ Ritu Karidhal was referred as the 'Rocket Woman of India'. She became famous with the launch of the Mars Orbiter Mission where she was the deputy operations director.
- ♣ Muthayya Vanitha received the Best Woman Scientist award in 2006 by the Astronomical Society of India.

## 1. World Day against Child Labour 2019 celebrated on June 12

- World Day Against Child Labour (WDACL) was observed on June 12, 2019. It was introduced to focus on the extent of child labour worldwide and the efforts required to eliminate it.

It is accompanied by a number of vision defects including nystagmus, amblyopia and photophobia.
