





1. Neeraj Gambhir appointed as Executive Director of Axis Bank

• **Appointment Term**: Neeraj Gambhir has been appointed as Executive Director of Axis Bank for a period of three years, effective August 4, 2025, or from the date of approval by the Reserve Bank of India, whichever is later.



- **Background**: Gambhir, 52, is a seasoned industry veteran with over 30 years of experience in the financial sector, having held leadership positions at Nomura, Lehman Brothers, and ICICI Bank.

5. Bihar Won U18 Boys' Title at Junior National Rugby 7s Championship 2025


