#### 1. CONTINUANCE (noun) – निरंतरता, नित्यता

Pronunciation: kun-ti-nyu-uns

Meaning: the state of remaining in existence or operation; the time for which a situation or action lasts Synonyms: continuation, carrying on, prolongation, protraction, maintenance, preservation; duration, period Usage:

- We can no longer support the President's <u>continuance</u> in office.
- Can we hope for a <u>continuance</u> of this fine weather?

#### 2. INELUCTABLE (adjective) - अपरिहार्य, अवश्यंभावी

Pronunciation: ini-luk-tub(u)I

Meaning: unable to be avoided or resisted

Synonyms: inescapable, unavoidable, inevitable, ineliminable, inexorable

Antonym: avoidable

Usage: So many women try to fight the ineluctable aging process by having cosmetic surgery.

#### 3. DARBIES (noun) – हथकड़ी

Pronunciation: daa-biz

Meaning: a pair of lockable linked metal rings for securing a prisoner's wrists

Synonyms: handcuffs, manacles, fetters, shackles, cuffs, gyve

Usage: She was taken to the police station in darbies.

#### 4. BOLSTER (verb) – सहारा देना; मज़बूत करना

Pronunciation: bol-stuh

Meaning: support or strengthen Synonyms: reinforce, boost, fortify

Antonym: undermine

Usage: You should avoid any drink which claims to bolster your energy level.

#### 5. SUBSISTENCE (noun) - जीवन निर्वाह

Pronunciation: sub-sis-tuns

Meaning: the state of having what you need in order to stay alive Synonyms: maintenance, keep, upkeep, support, livelihood, living

Usage: Their main mode of subsistence is hunting

#### 6. MANGLE (verb) – क्षति पह्ंचाना

Pronunciation: mang(u)l

Meaning: destroy or severely damage by tearing or crushing; ruin or spoil (a text, piece of music, etc.)

Synonyms: mutilate, maim, disfigure, damage, injure; spoil, ruin, mar

Usage: The babysitter helplessly watched as the child began to mangle and crush the beautiful roses on display at

the flower shop.

#### 7. AMICABLE (adjective) – सौहार्दपूर्ण, मित्रतापूर्ण

Pronunciation: ami-kub(u)I

Meaning: characterized by friendliness

Synonyms: friendly, good-natured, cordial, civil, courteous, polite

Antonyms: unfriendly, hostile

Usage: The two nations reached an <u>amicable</u> agreement.

#### 8. AVOWEDLY (adverb) - खुले तौर पर

Pronunciation: uvo-idli

Meaning: in a way that is asserted, admitted, or stated publicly

Synonyms: openly, admittedly, explicitly

Antonyms: implicitly, dishonestly

Usage: The article is <u>avowedly</u> a historical analysis.

#### 9. COW (verb) - धमकाना

Pronunciation: kau

Meaning: to frighten with threats, violence, etc. Synonyms: intimidate, daunt, browbeat, bully, badger Usage: He cowed the boy into doing illegal things.

#### 10. REPRIEVE (verb, noun) – दंड-निलंबन, दंड-स्थगन

Pronunciation: ri-preev

Meaning: cancel or postpone the punishment of (someone, especially someone condemned to death); a

cancellation or postponement of a punishment Synonyms: pardon, spare, acquit, amnesty, respite

Antonyms: charge, punish

Usage:

- Prisoners under sentence of death were reprieved. (verb)
- She was thankful for the reprieve. (noun)


