



1. Anmol Kharb won her first Senior International Title in Women's Singles at the Belgian International 2024

India's rising badminton star Anmol Kharb clinched her first senior international title by winning the women's singles event at the Belgian International 2024 in Leuven. In a remarkable performance, the 17-year-old triumphed over Denmark's Amalie Schulz with scores of 24-22, 12-21, 21-10 in the final.



Foot notes:

- Anmol's achievement is particularly remarkable as she entered the main draw through the qualifiers and was unseeded. Her journey to the title underscores her resilience and talent, marking a significant milestone in her emerging career.
- Anmol Kharb played a key role in the Indian women's team winning gold at the 2024 Badminton Asia Team Championships.
- She defeated Japan's world No. 29 Natsuki Nidaira and Thailand's world No. 45 Pornpicha Choeikeewong in straight games.

2. Oscar Piastri Secures First Victory at the Azerbaijan Grand Prix

Oscar Piastri secured victory as he started behind pole-sitter Charles Leclerc, the Australian executed a bold move to overtake him. Piastri noted that the timing of his maneuver was crucial, even though it required him to disregard instructions from his race engineer, Tom





Stallard. On the twentieth lap, Piastri seized his chance and surpassed race leader Charles Leclerc.

Foot notes:

- Oscar Piastri's victory and Lando Norris' fourth-place finish boosted McLaren to the top of the constructors' standings.
- McLaren now holds a 20-point lead over Red Bull.
- The top five finishers in the Azerbaijan Grand Prix were Oscar Piastri from McLaren in first place, followed by Charles Leclerc from Ferrari in second, George Russell from Mercedes in third, Lando Norris from McLaren in fourth, and Max Verstappen from Red Bull in fifth.

3. September 16th is celebrated as World Ozone Day

World Ozone Day marks the signing of the Montreal Protocol in 1987. It was Established by the United Nations General Assembly in 1994 as it raises awareness about ozone layer depletion and encourages efforts to protect it. In 1994, the United Nations General Assembly decided to organize World Ozone Day on the 16th of September.



Foot notes:

- In 1913, the French Physicists, Charles Fabry and Henri Buisson discovered the Ozone Layer.
- In 1985, the Vienna Convention for the Protection of the Ozone Layer was adopted and signed by 28 countries.
- Theme of 2024: Montreal Protocol: Advancing Climate Action.
- **Significance**: The ozone layer, a delicate gas shield in the Earth's stratosphere, absorbs the majority of the sun's harmful ultraviolet (UV) radiation. It is vital for safeguarding life on Earth by blocking excessive UV radiation from reaching the surface, which can cause increased skin cancer rates and damage to ecosystems.
- The Montreal Protocol has phased out 99% of ozone-depleting substances in refrigerators, air-conditioners, and other products.
- These efforts have also helped combat climate change, preventing an estimated 135 billion tonnes of carbon dioxide equivalent emissions from 1990 to 2010.

4. Aishwarya Rai wins Best Actress at SIIMA 2024

Aishwarya Rai Bachchan and daughter Aaradhya Bachchan turned up in blingy outfits at South Indian International Movie Awards (SIIMA) 2024. She won the Best Actress in a Leading Role (Critics) for her performance in director Mani Ratnam's Ponniyin Selvan: Part 2.

- Aishwarya highlighted the personal significance of the film and credited the award to the collective efforts of the team.
- She received the SIIMA 2024 award from filmmaker Kabir Khan.
- She expressed heartfelt gratitude, thanking SIIMA and acknowledging the entire team of *Ponniyin Selvan*.
