



### 1. Shashvat Kumar appointed as Commandant (SP level) in SSB

- **Appointment**: Shashvat Kumar, an IPS officer from the 2016 batch of Tripura cadre, has been appointed as Commandant (SP level) in Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB).
- Current Role: Before this appointment, Kumar was serving as Additional SP (Urban) in West Tripura district and had previously held positions such as SDPO, Sadar with additional charge of Dy. SP (CAW), West Tripura.



- **Seniority**: Kumar was promoted to the IPS Senior Time Scale in the Pay Matrix Level-11, as per a notification from the Tripura government.

### 2. China's former Vice Finance Minister appointed AIIB prez





### 4. Khelo India University Games to be held in Jaipur in November

• Event Details: The fifth edition of the Khelo India University Games will take place in Jaipur, Rajasthan, in November 2025,

featuring over 4,000 athletes from more than 200 universities across India.

- **Host Universities**: Poornima University and Rajasthan University will jointly host the event, which will include competitions in at least 20 disciplines.
- **Age Group**: The Games are designed for under-25 athletes, providing a national platform for young athletes to showcase their talent and attract attention from scouts and sports federations.
- **Previous Edition**: The 2024 edition of the Khelo India University Games was co-hosted by seven Northeastern states, with Chandigarh University emerging as the overall champion, followed by Lovely Professional University and Guru Nanak Dev University.
- **Expectations**: Sports Minister Mansukh Mandaviya expects high-quality performances from the athletes, stating that university students dominate multisport events worldwide, and Rajasthan will likely see some outstanding performances.

# 5. Indian Junior Men's Hockey Team Defeats Australia 2-1 at Nations Tournament

- Match Outcome: The Indian junior men's hockey team defeated Australia 2-1 in the battle for third place at the 4 Nations Tournament held in Berlin, Germany.
- Goalscorers: Rohit scored the equalizer for India in the 45th minute following a penalty corner, while Ajeet Yadav sealed the win with a fourth-quarter goal in the 52nd minute. Toby



- Mallon had given Australia the lead with a field goal in the 40th minute.
- **Game Dynamics**: The first half saw a tense battle with neither team managing to score in the opening two quarters. Strong defensive structures and disciplined play kept the scores level heading into the third quarter.
- **Tournament Performance**: This win concludes India's campaign in the 4 Nations Tournament. Earlier, India had a 1-7 loss to hosts Germany, a 3-1 victory against Australia, and a 1-5 defeat against Spain in the pool stage.
