1. BELEAGUERED (ADJECTIVE): पीड़ित, परेशान

Pronunciation: buh·lee·guh

Meaning: in a very difficult situation.

Synonyms: Troubled, harassed

Antonyms: Assisted, supported

Sentence: The beleaguered company struggled to stay afloat amidst financial difficulties.

2. NEGOTIATOR (NOUN): समझौताकर्ता

Pronunciation: neh·goh·shee·ay·tuh

Meaning: a person who conducts negotiations.

Synonyms: Mediator, Arbiter

Antonyms: Agitator, Provoker

Sentence: The negotiator was able to facilitate a peaceful resolution to the conflict.

3. FATAL (ADJECTIVE): घातक

Pronunciation: fayt·uhl

Meaning: causing death.

Synonyms: Deadly, Lethal

Antonyms: fortuitous, lucky, fortunate

Sentence: The accident resulted in fatal injuries, and unfortunately, the driver did not survive.

4. HAZARDS (NOUN): आपदाएं, खतरे

Pronunciation: ha·zuhdz

Meaning: a danger or risk.

Synonyms: Dangers, Risks

Antonyms: Protections, Security

Sentences: It is important to be aware of the hazards associated with working in a construction site.

5. ERODE (VERB): खत्म करना

Pronunciation: ee·rode

Meaning: to diminish or destroy by degrees.

Synonyms: Corrode, Ruining

Antonyms: Restoring, Reviving

Sentence: Wind and rain have eroded the statues into shapeless lumps of stone.

6. ENTAILED (VERB): आवश्यक बना देना

Pronunciation: uhn·tayld

Meaning: involve (something) as a necessary or inevitable part or consequence.

Synonyms: Necessitate

Antonyms: Preclude

Sentence: Such a large investment inevitably entails some risk.

7. INTRUSIVE (ADJECTIVE): दखल देने वाला

Pronunciation: uhn·troos·uhv

Meaning: causing disruption or annoyance through being unwelcome or uninvited.

Synonyms: Intruding, Invasive

Antonyms: Uninvolved

Sentence: Intrusive reporters disturbed their privacy.

8. HEAPED (VERB): ढेरल गाना

Pronunciation: heept

Meaning: (of a spoon or other receptacle) having its contents piled above the brim or edge.

Synonyms: Bundle, Stack

Antonyms: Part, Individual

Sentence: I'm going to heap all the leaves up over there.

9. RUINOUS (ADJECTIVE): विनाशकारी

Pronunciation: roo·uhn·uhs

Meaning: disastrous or destructive.

Synonyms: Catastrophic, Disastrous

Antonyms: Fortunate, Beneficial

Sentence: The bank had capital to spare, which they lost in a series of ruinous takeovers.

10. ANTICIPATE (VERB): पूर्वानुमान करना

Pronunciation: an·ti·suh·payt

Meaning: regard as probable; expect or predict.

Synonyms: Foresee, Predict

Antonyms: Surprised

Sentence: The author anticipated objections to his theory.



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
