

1.OPTIMISM (NOUN): आशावाद

Pronunciation:awp·tuh·mi·zm
Meaning: the feeling that the future will be good or successful.
Synonyms: Confidence, Buoyancy, cheer
Antonyms: Pessimism, concern, despair
Sentence: The talks had been amicable and there were grounds for optimism.

2.EVADE (VERB): बचना

Pronunciation:uh·vayd Meaning: to manage to escape from or to avoid meeting somebody/something. Synonyms: avoid, dodge, elude Antonyms: confront, seek, accept Sentence:Friends helped him to <u>evade</u> my woes.

3.ENORMOUSLY (ADVERB): अत्यंत

Pronunciation:uh·naw·muhs·lee
Meaning: extremely or very much.
Synonyms: Extremely, Exceedingly, very
Antonyms: Moderately, little, just
Sentence:Quality of life varies <u>enormously</u> from one place to another.

4.VEHEMENCE (NOUN): उत्साह

Pronunciation:vee·uh·muhns
Meaning: great forcefulness or intensity of feeling or expression.
Synonyms: Force, Ardor, passion
Antonyms: Apathy, mildness, delicacy
Sentence:There was a lot of <u>vehemence</u> in his reaction.

5.EXPEDITIOUS (ADJECTIVE): शीघ्र

Pronunciation:ek·spuh·di·shuhs **Menaing:** done with speed and efficiency. **Synonyms:** Swift, Quick, fast **Antonyms:** Slow, tardy, lazy



Sentence: The investigation was supposed to be <u>expeditious</u>.

6.PROMPT (VERB): तत्पर

Pronunciation:prawmt
Menaing: immediate; done without delay.
Synonyms: Make, Move, cause
Antonyms: Discourage, limit, check
Sentence:Curiosity prompted him to look inside.

7.REAP (NOUN): काटना

Pronunciation:reepMeaning: to cut and collect a crop (corn, wheat, etc.)Synonyms: Obtain, Get, earnAntonyms: Lose, waste, spendSentence:The company is reaping the benefits.

8.POST (PREPOSITION): डाक

Pronunciation:poset Meaning: the system or organization for collecting and dealing with letters, packages, etc. Synonyms:job, duty, brief Antonyms:unemployment, avocation, joblessness Sentence:American poetry post the 1950s hasn't had the same impact.

9. DASTARDLY (ADJECTIVE): डरपोक

Pronunciation:daa·stuhd·lee
Meaning: wicked and cruel.
Synonyms: evil, iniquitous, wicked
Antonyms: noble, brave, gallant
Sentence:We all know the pirates and their <u>dastardly</u> deeds.

10. EARMARK (VERB): दाग़ना

Pronunciation:eeuh⋅maak
Meaning: to choose somebody/something to do something in the future.
Synonyms: Reserve, Appropriate
Antonyms: ignore, neglect, misuse
Sentence: The cash had been <u>earmarked</u> for a big expansion of the programme.
