



1. Jhandu Kumar & Seema Rani Set National Records At Khelo India Para Games

Jhandu Kumar and Seema Rani created history by setting national records at the Khelo India Para Games. Jhandu Kumar showcased exceptional strength in para powerlifting, breaking previous records in his category. Seema Rani excelled in para athletics, setting a new national benchmark in the discus throw event. Their performances highlighted India's growing dominance in para sports and inspired young athletes. The Khelo India Para Games continue to provide a vital platform for para-athletes to showcase their talent and achieve excellence.


