Here some exceptional English words from the newspaper 'The Hindu' are given with their synonyms/antonyms and usage. Hopefully, this will help you improve your vocabulary.

1. EXACTING (adjective) – कठोर, सख्त, कठिन, कड़ा

Pronunciation: ig-zak-ting / eg-zak-ting

Meaning: making great demands on one's skill, attention, or other resources

Synonyms: demanding, hard, tough, stringent, testing, challenging

Antonym: easy

Usage: It was exacting work and required all his patience.

2. PSEUDO (adjective, noun) – नक़ली, झूठा

Pronunciation: syoo-do

Meaning: not genuine; a pretentious or insincere person

Synonyms: bogus, sham, phoney, imitation, artificial, mock, fake, feigned, pretended, false, faux, spurious

Antonym: genuine

Usage:

Her care for the poor is completely pseudo. (adjective)

Anthony needs the opinion of a real scientist, not a pseudo. (noun)

3. ENNUI (noun) – ग्लानि, विरक्ति, क्लांति

Pronunciation: on-wee

Meaning: a feeling of no interest and dissatisfaction arising from a lack of occupation or excitement

Synonyms: boredom, tedium, lethargy, lassitude, languor

Antonyms: animation, contentment

Usage: Since losing his job, he has often experienced a profound sense of ennui.

4. DASTARDLY (adjective) — दुष्ट और क्रूर

Pronunciation: das-tud-li **Meaning**: wicked and cruel

Synonyms: evil, iniquitous, heinous, villainous, diabolical, diabolic

Antonyms: noble, praiseworthy

Usage: He described the killing as a dastardly act.

5. MAR (verb) – बिगाड़ना, क्षति पहुँचाना

Pronunciation: maa

Meaning: weaken or damage the quality or appearance of something

Synonyms: spoil, ruin, impair, disfigure, flaw, blemish

Antonyms: improve, enhance

Usage: The report was marred by a large number of errors

6. ENNOBLE (verb) – पदवृद्धि करना, प्रतिष्ठा बढ़ाना

Pronunciation: in-o-b(u)l / en-o-b(u)l

Meaning: give (someone) a noble rank or title; lend greater dignity or nobility of character to someone

Synonyms: nobilitate, dignify, honour

Antonym: demean

Usage:

I was glad when this gentleman was ennobled.

Sports can also ennoble our minds by bringing us close to nature and close to the essence of life.

7. VINDICTIVE (adjective) – प्रतिशोधी, प्रतिकाराशील, प्रतिहिंसात्मक

Pronunciation: vin-dik-tiv

Meaning: having or showing a strong or unreasoning desire for revenge

Synonyms: vengeful, revengeful, avenging, unforgiving, grudge-bearing, resentful

Antonym: forgiving

Usage: After the divorce Joan's ex-husband became increasingly vindictive.

8. LEERY (adjective) – सावधान, चौकन्ना

Pronunciation: li-uri

Meaning: not trusting someone/something and usually avoiding him/her/it (if possible)

Synonyms: wary, cautious, careful, guarded, chary, suspicious, distrustful

Antonyms: heedless, trustful

Usage: Landlords are often <u>leery</u> of renting to large families.

9. FLEECY (adjective) – लोमश

Pronunciation: flee-si

Meaning: made of or lined with a soft, warm fabric; white and fluffy-looking

Synonyms: fluffy, woolly, downy, fuzzy, feathery, furry

Antonym: coarse

Usage:

He liked to wear his <u>fleecy</u> tracksuit next to bare skin.

Fleecy clouds spread over the blue sky.

10. LATITUDE (noun) – ਫੀਕ

Pronunciation: lati-tyood

Meaning: scope for freedom of action or thought

Synonyms: freedom, scope, leeway, elbow room, breathing space

Antonyms: constraint, restriction

Usage: Journalists have considerable latitude in criticizing public figures.


