

1. DISPASSIONATE (ADJECTIVE): अभावुक

Pronunciation: duhs·pa·shuhn·uht

Meaning: unemotional.

Synonyms: non-emotional, unsentimental

Antonyms: emotional

Sentence: She dealt with life's disasters in a calm, dispassionate way.

2. OUTLANDISH (ADJECTIVE): विचित्र

Pronunciation: awt·lan·duhsh

Meaning: weird.

Synonyms: queer, offbeat

Antonyms: ordinary

Sentence: They were three wise, outlandish kings.

3. UNSETTLED (ADJECTIVE): अशांत

Pronunciation: uhn·seh·tld

Meaning: restless.

Synonyms: restive, fidgety

Antonyms: settled

Sentence: She felt edgy and unsettled.

4. COMPLIANCE (NOUN): अनुपालन

Pronunciation: kuhm·plai·uhns

Meaning: acquiescence.

Synonyms: agreement, assent

Antonyms: defiance

Sentence: The compliance with government views shown by the commission.

5. SCANDALIZE (VERB): अपमानित करना

Pronunciation: skan·duh·laiz

Meaning: shock.

Synonyms: appall, outrage

Antonyms: impress

Sentence: Their lack of manners scandalized their hosts.

6. GENEROSITY (VERB): प्रचुरता

Pronunciation: juh·nuh·raw·si·tee

Meaning: abundance.

Synonyms: amplitude, richness

Antonyms: dearth

Sentence: Diners certainly cannot complain about the generosity of portions.

7. INDIGENOUS (NOUN): स्वदेशी

Pronunciation: in·dee·juh·nuhs

Meaning: native.

Synonyms: aboriginal, local

Antonyms: expatriate

Sentence: The most indigenous inhabitants were the American Indians.

8. DEARTH (NOUN): दुर्लभता

Pronunciation: duhth

Meaning: lack.

Synonyms: scarcity, shortage

Antonyms: abundance

Sentence: There was a dearth of evidence.

9. RESUMPTION (NOUN): पुनरारंभ

Pronunciation: ruh·zuhmp·shn

Meaning: restart.

Synonyms: restarting, reopening

Antonyms: suspension

Sentence: The resumption of peace talks is expected soon.

10. LATENT (ADJECTIVE): निष्क्रिय

Pronunciation: lay·tnt

Meaning: dormant.

Synonyms: quiescent, inactive

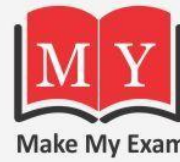
Antonyms: manifest
