




# DAILY VOCAB DOSE

## 1. DEMARCATE (verb) : हदबंदी करना

Pronunciation: dee·maa·kayt

**Meaning:** set the boundaries or limits of. **Synonyms:** bound, circumscribe, limit **Antonyms:** attach, combine, connect.

**Sentence:** A bright yellow line demarcated the county on the road map.

# 2. RAPTUROUS (adj.) : उत्साहपूर्ण

**Pronunciation:** rap·chuh·ruhs

**Meaning:** characterized by, feeling, or expressing great pleasure or enthusiasm.

Synonyms: ecstatic, joyful, joyous

Antonyms: depressed, unhappy, woebegone

**Sentence:** She was greeted with <u>rapturous</u> applause.

#### 3. MOBOCRACY (noun) : भीइतंत्र

Pronunciation: mä-'bä-krə-sē

Meaning: rule or domination by the masses.

**Synonyms:** anarchy, disarray, discord **Antonyms:** arrangement, calm, harmony.

**Sentence:** The court will never permit <u>mobocracy</u> to overwhelm the law of the land.

#### 4. DICTUM (noun): उक्ति

**Pronunciation:** dik·tm

**Meaning:** a formal pronouncement from an authoritative source.

Synonyms: pronouncement, proclamation, direction

Antonyms: judgment in rem, affirmation, judgment in personam.

Sentence: He followed the famous American dictum, 'Don't get mad, get even'.

#### 5. DEMITTING (verb) : छोड़ना

**Pronunciation:** duh·mit·uhng

**Meaning:** resign from (an office or position). **Synonyms:** abjuring, denying, disavowing

Antonyms: claiming, confiscating

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**Sentence:** Arguments within his congregation led to his demitting his post.

#### 6. WHIM (noun): अचानक इच्छा या परिवर्तन

**Pronunciation:** vim

Meaning: a sudden desire or change of mind, especially one that is unusual or

unexplained.

**Synonyms:** impulse, urge, notion

**Antonyms:** actuality, certainty, dislike.

**Sentence:** We booked the holiday on a <u>whim</u>.

### 7. UNENVIABLE (adj.) : अवांछनीय

**Pronunciation:** uhn·en·vee·uh·bl

**Meaning:** difficult, undesirable, or unpleasant. **Synonyms:** disagreeable, unpleasant, undesirable

Antonyms: attractive, desirable, enviable

**Sentence:** She had the unenviable task of making the first few phone calls.

#### 8. MISCARRY (verb) : असफल होना

Pronunciation: muhs·ka·ree

Meaning: (of something planned) fail to attain an intended or expected outcome.

**Synonyms:** go wrong, go awry, go amiss **Antonyms:** prevail, succeed, prosper

**Sentence:** I think my letter must have <u>miscarried</u>.

## 9. SPARSER (adj.) : विरल

Pronunciation: spaas·uh

Meaning: thinly dispersed or scattered. Synonyms: scanty, scant, scattered Antonyms: abundant, ample, bountiful

Sentence: Anaemia, caused by iron deficiency, also makes hair sparser.

## 10. LITTERED (verb) : कूड़े से ढांपना

Pronunciation: li-tuhd

Meaning: make (a place) untidy with rubbish or a large number of objects left lying about.


Synonyms: make untidy, mess up, disarranged

Antonyms: neat, neatened, ordered

**Sentence:** Is there any wonder that you can never find anything in your <u>littered</u> desk?

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
