

1.PROPAGANDA (noun): प्रचार करना

Pronunciation: praw.puh.gan.duh

Meaning: information, especially of a biased or misleading nature, used to promote a political cause or point of view

Synonym: Disinformation, Advertising, promotion

Antonym: Truth, Reality, fact

Sentence: The government's propaganda machine was in full swing during the election period.

2.CALIPH (noun): खलीफा

Pronunciation: kay.luhf

Meaning: a spiritual leader of Islam, claiming succession from Muhammad

Synonym: Leader, Ruler

Antonym: Follower, Subordinate

Sentence: The caliph ruled his domain with a blend of political savvy and religious authority.

3.SYMPATHISER (noun): सहानुभूति रखने वालों

Pronunciation: sim.puh.thy.zuh

Meaning: a person who agrees with or supports a sentiment or opinion

Synonym: Supporter, Advocate, backer

Antonym: Opponent, Adversary, foe

Sentence: The sympathisers of the cause gathered to protest peacefully in the city square.

4.UNLEASH (verb): खोलना

Pronunciation: uhn.leesh

Meaning: to suddenly let a strong force, emotion, etc. be felt or have an effect

Synonym: Release, Let loose, free

Antonym: Restrain, Contain, hold

Sentence: The new policy could unleash economic forces that would rejuvenate the stagnant sector.

5.INFIDELS (noun): नास्तिक

Pronunciation: in.fuh.dl

Meaning: people who do not believe in a particular religion, especially Islam

Synonym: Nonbelievers, Heathens

Antonym: Believers, Faithful

Sentence: The extremists targeted what they called infidels in their propaganda.

6.EBB (verb): घटना

Pronunciation: ebb

Meaning: (of a tide or emotion) to move away from the land; recede

Synonym: Recede, Wane, go out

Antonym: Flow, Surge, growth

Sentence: As the flood waters began to ebb, the residents returned to assess the damage to their homes.

7. DERADICALIZATION (noun): कट्टरवाद

Pronunciation: Deradicalisation

Meaning: the process of causing a person with extreme views to adopt more moderate positions on political or social issues

Synonym: Moderation, Reform, left

Antonym: Radicalisation, Extremism, right

Sentence: Effective deradicalisation programs are essential in countering terrorism and promoting social cohesion.

8.MARRED (verb): बिगाड़ना

Pronunciation: maad

Meaning: impair the appearance of; disfigure

Synonym: Spoil, Damage, ruin

Antonym: Beautify, Enhance, entire

Sentence: The sculpture was marred by vandals overnight.

9.EXTRADITE (verb): अपराधी देना

Pronunciation: ek.struh.dite

Meaning: hand over (a person accused or convicted of a crime) to the jurisdiction of the foreign state in which the crime was committed

Synonym: Deport, Hand over, expel

Antonym: Harbor, Protect, return

Sentence: The government decided to extradite the fugitive to face charges in the United States.

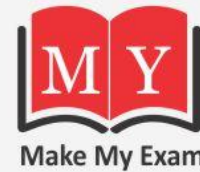
10.INTRACTABLE (adjective): असह्य**Pronunciation:**uhn.trak.tuh.bl**Meaning:** hard to control or deal with**Synonym:** Unmanageable, Stubborn ,difficult**Antonym:** Manageable, Compliant ,docile**Sentence:** The negotiations were stalled due to intractable differences between the two parties.
