India's Ladakh records World's highest snow leopard population

India's Ladakh region has achieved a remarkable feat by recording the world's highest population of snow leopards. This discovery highlights the region's rich biodiversity and its importance in global wildlife conservation. The survey was conducted using scientific methods, including camera traps and field assessments. Ladakh's harsh climate and rugged terrain provide a perfect natural habitat for these elusive big cats. Conservation efforts by the Indian government and local communities have played a key role in this success.

- Snow Leopard Density: Ladakh has the world's highest recorded density of snow leopards, with approximately 477 animals, accounting for nearly 68% of India's estimated 709 snow leopards.
- Habitat and Distribution: Snow leopards in Ladakh occupy an extensive area of 47,572 square kilometers, with Hemis National Park recording the world's highest snow leopard density of about 2.07 individuals per 100 square kilometers.
- Conservation Factors: The region's success in conservation is attributed to cultural values, good governance, and a healthy prey population, showcasing decades of community-defended protection and a shift from hunting to conservation.
- Coexistence with Humans: Over 60% of Ladakh's snow leopards coexist in landscapes shared with humans, emphasizing the need for inclusive conservation planning, especially in the face of development and climate pressure.

India Ranks Among Top Six Patent Filers in 6G Technology

India has emerged as a significant player in the global race for 6G technology, now ranking among the top six countries in 6G patent filings. This advancement is part of the government's proactive approach under the 'Bharat 6G Vision', aiming to position India at the forefront of 6G design, development, and deployment by 2030. The Department of Telecommunications (DoT) has been instrumental in this progress, funding next-generation testbeds and evaluating numerous proposals to accelerate 6G research. India's goal is to contribute 10% of global 6G patents and one-sixth of the global standards in the next three years. This strategic push is supported by collaborations between the government, academia, and industry leaders, fostering a robust innovation ecosystem.

- Ranking and Potential Impact: India is now among the top six nations globally in 6G patent filings, with the potential to add \$1 trillion to the economy by 2035. This ranking positions India alongside major global players like the US, China, Japan, South Korea, and the European Union.
- Government Support and Funding: The government has funded over 111 research projects with 300 crore to support innovation in 6G technology. Initiatives like "Bharat



- 6G Vision" and "Bharat 6G Alliance" aim to drive technological innovation and collaboration.
- Research and Development: India is focusing on key areas like spectrum efficiency, AI integration, and quantum communication to develop 6G technology. The country has also established research centers and partnerships with global universities and tech companies.
- Patent Filings and Global Standards: India could secure 10% of all 6G patents globally and contribute one-sixth to global standards within the next three years. The Department of Telecommunications has launched a patent and IPR support framework to encourage inventors and organizations to file patents.

Anurag Bhushan appointed as next Ambassador of India to the Kingdom of Sweden

The Ministry of External Affairs announced the appointment of Anurag Bhushan as the next Ambassador of India to the Kingdom of Sweden . A 1995-batch Indian Foreign Service officer, Bhushan currently serves as Additional Secretary in the Ministry. He is expected to assume his new role in Sweden shortly. This appointment underscores the strengthening of India-Sweden relations, which are characterized by shared values, robust business and investment ties, and collaborative efforts in research and development.

- Current Position: Bhushan currently serves as Additional Secretary in the MEA and is expected to take up his new role in Stockholm shortly after diplomatic formalities.

Bhutan launched the World's first National-level Cryptocurrency Tourism Payment System

Bhutan has made history by launching the world's first national-level cryptocurrency tourism payment system. This innovative move aims to modernize the country's tourism sector by offering digital and seamless payment options for international visitors. Tourists can now use cryptocurrency to pay for services such as hotels, travel bookings, and local experiences. The initiative is part of Bhutan's broader vision to integrate advanced financial technologies while maintaining sustainable tourism practices. By adopting blockchain-based payments, the country



enhances transparency, security, and efficiency in transactions. This bold step positions Bhutan as a global pioneer in combining fintech and tourism on a national scale.

- Partnership: Bhutan has partnered with Binance Pay and DK Bank to roll out this innovative payment system, allowing tourists to use digital currencies for various services during their stay.
- Cryptocurrency Support: The system supports over 100 cryptocurrencies, including BNB, BTC, and USDC, and enables real-time transactions using dynamic or static QR codes through the Binance app.
- Benefits for Locals: This initiative empowers local businesses, including small-scale artisans and vendors in remote areas, to accept cryptocurrency payments with just a smartphone and a QR code, promoting financial inclusion.
- Tourism Experience: The payment system simplifies travel logistics by reducing transaction fees and currency exchange challenges, allowing tourists to enjoy a cashless and card-free experience in Bhutan.

World's first commercial scale e-methanol plant opens in Denmark

Denmark has inaugurated the world's first commercial-scale e-methanol plant in Kasso, marking a significant advancement in green fuel technology. Developed by European Energy in collaboration with Japan's Mitsui & Co., the €150 million facility is powered by the adjacent 304 MW Kasso Solar Park and utilizes captured biogenic CO₂ to produce up to 42,000 tonnes of e-methanol annually . Major companies like Maersk, LEGO and Novo Nordisk have committed to using this green methanol to reduce their carbon footprints in shipping and manufacturing. The plant's excess heat will provide district heating for approximately 3,300 local households, enhancing its environmental benefits .

- Production Capacity: The facility has the capacity to produce up to 42,000 tonnes of emethanol annually, which will be used as a low-carbon fuel for shipping and as a raw material in the chemical industry.
- Renewable Energy Source: The plant uses renewable energy from a nearby 304 MW solar park to power its electrolysis process, which splits water into hydrogen and oxygen. The hydrogen is then combined with biogenic CO2 to produce e-methanol.
- Off-Takers: The e-methanol will be supplied to companies such as A.P. Moller-Maersk for use as a fuel, and LEGO Group and Novo Nordisk for use in producing lower-carbon plastics.
- Environmental Benefits: The plant will not only produce green fuel but also provide district heating for around 3,300 local households, showcasing a practical and scalable solution for decarbonizing industries



Sussan Ley has made history by becoming the first woman to lead Australia's Liberal Party and serve as Leader of the Opposition. Elected on May 13, 2025, following Peter Dutton's electoral defeat, Ley narrowly defeated Angus Taylor in a 29–25 leadership ballot . Born in Kentville, Nova Scotia, to Indian immigrant parents, Anand has had a distinguished career as a law professor and politician. She previously served as Canada's Minister of National Defence, where she played a key role in addressing military misconduct and supporting Ukraine during the Russian invasion. Anand took her oath of office on the Bhagavad Gita, reflecting her cultural and religious heritage. Anand's leadership is expected to influence Canada's approach to international affairs, including its relations with India and the United States.

- Background: Anand is a lawyer, academic, and politician. She holds four degrees, including a Bachelor of Arts in political studies from Queen's University and a Bachelor of Laws from Dalhousie University.
- Minister of National Defence: She played a central role in Canada's efforts to provide military aid to Ukraine during the 2022 Russian invasion.
- Minister of Public Services and Procurement: Anand oversaw Canada's procurement of vaccines and personal protective equipment during the COVID-19 pandemic.

UP Partners with World Bank to Launch UP AGREES & AI Pragya Initiatives

The Uttar Pradesh government has partnered with the World Bank to launch two major initiatives: UP AGREES and AI Pragya. UP AGREES (Uttar Pradesh Agriculture Resilience and Enhancement Scheme) aims to improve agricultural productivity and sustainability in the state. The initiative focuses on climate-resilient farming practices and better resource management to support farmers. AI Pragya is designed to enhance digital learning and promote the use of artificial intelligence in education and governance. Together, these initiatives mark a significant step toward technological advancement and rural development in Uttar Pradesh.

Foot notes:

- World Bank Funding: The World Bank has approved a loan of 2,737 crore over six years for the UP AGREES program, with the state government contributing 1,166 crore. The loan has a repayment period of 35 years at an interest rate of 1.23%.
- AI Pragya Initiative: The AI Pragya initiative aims to upskill 10 lakh youth in Artificial Intelligence, machine learning, data analytics, and cybersecurity, in collaboration with tech giants like Microsoft, Intel, Amazon, and Google, to boost employment and support digital transformation.
- Economic Goal: These initiatives align with Uttar Pradesh's goal of becoming a \$1 trillion economy by driving agricultural innovation, digital skill development, and entrepreneurship.
- Implementation: The programs will be implemented in multiple districts, including Basti, Maharajganj, Ballia, Ghazipur, Varanasi, and Jhansi, with a focus on promoting climateresilient practices, digital technologies, and market linkages for farmers.

Indore Becomes the India's First Beggar- Free City

Indore has been officially declared India's first beggar-free city following a comprehensive rehabilitation campaign launched in February 2024. The initiative successfully identified and rehabilitated approximately 5,000 individuals engaged in begging, providing them with employment opportunities and enrolling their children in schools. The success of this campaign



not only enhances Indore's reputation for cleanliness but also demonstrates the impact of coordinated social welfare efforts in addressing urban challenges.

Foot notes:

- Achievement: Indore has been declared India's first beggar-free city after a year-long campaign that began in February 2024, rehabilitating approximately 5,000 beggars.
- Rehabilitation Process: The campaign categorized beggars into three groups: habitual beggars (60%), those begging due to financial difficulties or disabilities (20%), and those forced into begging (20%), providing tailored support for each group.
- Community Involvement: The initiative involved community engagement, especially with communities like the Nath and Nut Samaj, who often resist rehabilitation. Training and support were provided directly within these communities to build trust.
- Government and Institutional Support: The campaign received extensive support from government bodies, including the Union Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment and the World Bank, which praised Indore's initiative as a model for other cities.
- Sustainability Measures: To maintain the city's beggar-free status, begging and giving alms are banned, with penalties for violations. Citizens are incentivized to report instances of begging with a reward of Rs 1,000, and many have already claimed this reward.

Public Sector Banks post record 1.78 Lakh Crore Profit in FY25

Public sector banks (PSBs) in India have reported a record cumulative net profit of 1.78 lakh crore for the fiscal year 2024–25, marking a 26% increase from 1.41 lakh crore in FY24. This growth reflects the sector's continued recovery from previous financial challenges, attributed to comprehensive reforms and strategic government support. The State Bank of India (SBI), as the largest lender, contributed over 40% of the total profit, with a standalone net profit of 70,901 crore, up 16% from the previous year. Among other notable performers, Punjab National Bank reported a 102% rise in net profit to 16,630 crore, while Punjab & Sind Bank saw a 71% increase to 1,016 crore. All 12 PSBs posted profits, underscoring the sector's robust performance and the effectiveness of ongoing financial reforms.

- Record Profit: Public Sector Banks achieved a cumulative net profit of 1.78 lakh crore in FY25, marking a 26% increase from 1.41 lakh crore in FY24.
- SBI's Contribution: State Bank of India dominated the sector, contributing over 40% of the total earnings with a net profit of 70,901 crore, up 16% from 61,077 crore in FY24.
- Top Performers: Punjab National Bank reported the highest net profit growth of 102% to 16,630 crore, followed by Punjab & Sind Bank with a 71% rise to 1,016 crore.
- Growth Across Banks: All 12 public sector banks reported a rise in profit, with Central Bank of India, UCO Bank, and Bank of India posting growth rates of 48.4%, 47.8%, and 45.9%, respectively.




Turnaround Story: This record profit marks a significant turnaround from FY18 when PSBs collectively reported losses of 85,390 crore, attributed to the government's 4R strategy of recognizing NPAs, resolution and recovery, recapitalization, and reforms

LIC hikes stake in Bank Of India to 8.38

Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC) has increased its stake in Bank of India (BoI) to 8.38% as of May 9, 2025, up from 6.35% in September 2021. This acquisition of an additional 2.026% stake over nearly four years reflects LIC's continued confidence in BoI's performance and growth prospects. Following the announcement, BoI shares rose by 2.27%, closing at 112.55 on the Bombay Stock Exchange on May 13, 2025. The bank recently reported an 82.5% year-on-year increase in profit after tax for the March quarter, reaching 2,626 crore, alongside a 2.1% rise in net interest income to 6,063 crore. LIC's strategic investment underscores its role as a key institutional investor in India's public sector banking landscape.

- Stake Increase: Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC) has increased its stake in Bank of India (BoI) to 8.38% as of May 9, 2025.
- Additional Stake Purchase: LIC acquired an additional 2.026% stake in BoI between September 2, 2021, and May 9, 2025, raising its holding from 6.35% to 8.38%.

Deepika, Parth Win Bronze as India Bags 7 Medals at Archery World Cup

At the 2025 Archery World Cup Stage 2 in Shanghai, Indian archers Deepika Kumari and Parth Salunkhe each secured bronze medals in the individual recurve events. Deepika triumphed over South Korea's Kang Chae-young with a 7-3 victory, marking her 12th individual World Cup medal and India's first in women's recurve this year. Parth clinched his maiden World Cup medal by defeating France's Baptiste Addis 6-4, showcasing composure in a tightly contested



match. These achievements contributed to India's impressive total of seven medals at the event, comprising two golds, one silver, and four bronzes. The medal haul highlights the strength and depth of India's archery talent on the global stage.

Foot notes:

- Deepika Kumari's Bronze Medal: Deepika won her 12th Individual World Cup medal by defeating Korea's Kang Chaeyoung 7-3 in the bronze medal match of the women's recurve category.
- Parth Salunkhe's Maiden Medal: Parth Salunkhe claimed his first World Cup medal, a bronze, by beating France's Baptiste Addis 6-4 in the men's recurve category.
- India's Medal Tally: India concluded the 2025 Shanghai World Cup with 7 medals 2 gold, 1 silver, and 4 bronze medals.
- Other Indian Medalists: The gold medals were won by Madhura Dhamangaonkar in women's individual compound and the men's compound team comprising Ojas Deotale, Abhishek Verma, and Rishabh Yadav.

Nirupama Devi Finishes 4th at Asian Weightlifting Championships

Nirupama Devi delivered an impressive performance at the Asian Weightlifting Championships, finishing in fourth place. Competing against elite athletes from across the continent, she showcased remarkable strength and determination. Although she narrowly missed out on a medal, her consistent lifts kept her among the top contenders. This result highlights her growing potential on the international stage. Her performance is a proud moment for Indian weightlifting and a promising sign for future competitions.

Foot notes:

- Final Ranking: She finished 4th in the competition, narrowly missing the bronze medal.
- Lift Details: Devi successfully lifted 91kg in snatch and 115kg in clean and jerk, totaling 206kg. However, she failed to lift 120kg and 125kg in the clean and jerk section, which cost her the bronze medal.
- Medal Winners: The gold medal was won by China's Li Shuang with a total lift of 239kg (105kg + 134kg), while the silver medal went to Elreen Ann Ando of the Philippines with a total lift of 232kg (102kg + 130kg). Mun Min-hee of South Korea took the bronze medal with a total lift of 214kg (94kg + 120kg).
- Indian Team Performance: India sent a two-member team to the championships, with Dilbag Singh set to compete in the men's 96kg event on Tuesday.

Kynan and Sabeera win Bronze in Mixed Trap Event at Shotgun World Cup

Olympian Kynan Chenai and Sabeera Haris clinched a bronze medal for India in the trap mixed team event at the ISSF Shotgun World Cup 2025 held in Nicosia, Cyprus. The Indian duo edged out Turkey's Tolga Tuncer and Pelin Kaya with a narrow 34-33 victory in the bronze-medal match at the Cyprus Olympic Shooting Range. In the qualification round, they secured fourth place among 34 teams, amassing a combined score of 142—Sabeera contributing 72 and Kynan



70. This bronze marks India's first medal at the tournament, with China taking gold and Poland securing silver in the event. The second Indian pair, Shardul Vihan and Kirti Gupta, finished 17th with a score of 137. Kynan and Sabeera's podium finish underscores India's growing prowess in international shooting competitions.

Foot notes:

- Bronze Medal Win: Kynan Chenai and Sabeera Haris secured the bronze medal by defeating Turkey's Tolga Tuncer and Rumeysa Pelin Kaya with a score of 34-33 in the bronze playoff match.

Virat Kohli announces Retirement from Test Cricket

Indian cricket legend Virat Kohli has announced his retirement from Test cricket, concluding a remarkable 14-year career in the longest format of the game. The 36-year-old made the announcement on May 12, 2025, just days after fellow cricketer Rohit Sharma also stepped away from Test cricket. Kohli's Test career boasts 123 matches, during which he amassed 9,230 runs at an average of 46.85, including 30 centuries and 31 fifties. He served as India's Test captain from 2014 to 2022, leading the team to 40 victories in 68 matches, making him the most successful Indian Test captain and placing him fourth globally for most Test wins as captain .Kohli's retirement marks the end of an era for Indian cricket, as he follows closely on the heels of Rohit Sharma's departure from the format.

- Career Statistics: Kohli played 113 Test matches, scoring 9,230 runs at an average of 48.67, including 30 centuries and 31 fifties. His highest score was an unbeaten 254 against South Africa in Pune.
- Captaincy Legacy: As Test captain, Kohli led India in 68 matches, winning 40 the most by any Indian captain. Under his leadership, India reached two consecutive ICC World Test Championship finals and climbed to the No. 1 Test ranking.
- Following Rohit Sharma's Footsteps: Kohli's retirement comes just a week after fellow senior player Rohit Sharma announced his retirement from Test cricket, both informing the BCCI of their decisions before the upcoming Test series against England.

• Future Plans: Although Kohli has retired from Test cricket and previously from T20 cricket after India's T20 World Cup triumph, he is expected to continue playing ODIs, where he has amassed a record-breaking 51 centuries.

India won Women's ODI Tri-Series

India clinched the 2025 Women's Tri-Nation ODI Series title with a commanding 97-run victory over Sri Lanka in the final held at the R. Premadasa Stadium in Colombo. Vice-captain Smriti Mandhana led the charge with a brilliant 116 off 101 balls, marking her 11th ODI century and propelling India to a formidable total of 342/7. The Indian bowling attack, spearheaded by Sneh Rana and Amanjot Kaur, dismantled the Sri Lankan batting lineup, sharing seven wickets between them. Rana's exceptional performance throughout the tournament, claiming 15 wickets in five matches, earned her the 'Player of the Series' accolade. This tri-series, featuring India, Sri Lanka, and South Africa, served as a crucial preparation ahead of the upcoming Women's Cricket World Cup.

- Final Match Result: India Women defeated Sri Lanka Women by 97 runs in the final match held on May 11, 2025, at Colombo.

Gautam Gambhir Set to Become Head Coach of Indian Test Team

Gautam Gambhir has been appointed as the head coach of the Indian men's cricket team, succeeding Rahul Dravid in July 2024. The Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI)



confirmed his appointment, entrusting him with the responsibility of leading the team across all formats. Gambhir, a former opener and key member of India's 2007 T20 World Cup and 2011 ODI World Cup-winning squads, brings a wealth of experience to the role. His coaching tenure began with a significant achievement, guiding India to victory in the 2025 ICC Champions Trophy, marking the team's first ICC title since 2013.

ICC Boosts Test Cricket with Doubling of WTC Final Prize Pool

The International Cricket Council (ICC) has announced a significant increase in the prize money for the 2025 World Test Championship (WTC) Final, aiming to bolster the prestige of Test cricket. The total prize pool now stands at a record \$5.76 million, more than double that of previous editions. The winning team will receive \$3.6 million, a 125% increase from the \$1.6 million awarded to Australia in 2023, while the runners-up will earn \$2.16 million, up from \$800,000 in the previous edition. This substantial financial boost underscores the ICC's commitment to revitalizing interest in the longest format of the game.

Foot notes:

• Record Prize Money: The ICC has announced a record-breaking prize money of \$3.6 million for the winner of the World Test Championship (WTC) Final 2023-25, which is more than double the amount awarded in previous editions.



- Winners and Runners-up: The winners of the WTC Final, to be played between South Africa and Australia at Lord's starting June 11, 2025, will take home \$3.6 million, while the runners-up will earn over \$2.1 million.
- Comparison to Previous Editions: The prize money for the winners has been doubled from \$1.6 million, which was awarded to New Zealand in 2021 and Australia in 2023. The runners-up prize money has also increased significantly from \$800,000.
- ICC's Commitment: The increase in prize money reflects the ICC's efforts to prioritize Test cricket and build on the momentum of the first three cycles of the nine-team competition.

C-DOT, CSIR-NPL partner to boost quantum, classical communication tech

The Centre for Development of Telematics (C-DOT) and the Physical Research Laboratory (PRL) have achieved a significant milestone by integrating C-DOT's indigenous fiber-based Quantum Key Distribution (QKD) system with PRL's Free Space QKD system. This collaboration has resulted in the establishment of an end-to-end quantum communication link that utilizes both fiber and free space as transport mediums. The demonstration of this integrated system was presented to Prof. Ajay Sood, Principal Scientific Adviser to the Government of India, and Dr. Neeraj Mittal, Secretary of the Department of Telecommunications, during the 2nd International Quantum Communication Conclave held at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi.

- Key Areas: The partnership will focus on joint R&D in areas like Quantum Key Distribution (QKD), single-photon sources and detectors, Electromagnetically Induced Transparency (EIT)-based quantum systems, and FPGA-based control electronics.

India & Chile Sign TOR for Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement Negotiations



India and Chile have taken a significant step to enhance their bilateral trade relations by signing the Terms of Reference (ToR) for a Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA) on May 8, 2025. This agreement aims to build upon the existing Preferential Trade Agreement (PTA) between the two nations, which was initially signed in 2006 and expanded in 2016. The CEPA is set to encompass a broader range of sectors, including digital services, investment promotion, cooperation among micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs), and critical minerals.

Since 2021, the newspaper has operated in exile after its offices were raided, assets seized, and its general manager, Juan Lorenzo Holmann, imprisoned by the Ortega regime. UNESCO Director-General Audrey Azoulay expressed regret over Nicaragua's decision, reaffirming the agency's commitment to press freedom and the importance of supporting courageous journalism worldwide.

- Award Recipient: La Prensa, a Nicaraguan newspaper founded in 1926, has been awarded the UNESCO/Guillermo Cano World Press Freedom Prize 2025 for its courageous efforts to report the truth despite severe repression.

Margot Friedlander Renowned Witness to Nazi Persecution passed away

Margot Friedländer, a renowned Holocaust survivor and educator, passed away on May 9, 2025, in Berlin at the age of 103. Born Anni Margot Bendheim in 1921, she survived the Theresienstadt concentration camp after losing her mother and brother to Auschwitz. Following the war, she emigrated to the United States, where she lived for over six decades with her husband, Adolf Friedländer, another Holocaust survivor. In 2010, at the age of 88, she returned to Berlin and dedicated her life to Holocaust education, speaking to German youth about her experiences and advocating against antisemitism and racism. Her memoir, Try to Make Your Life, published in 2008, encapsulated her mother's final words and her journey of survival and resilience.



- Life Story: Born in 1921, Friedlander experienced the horrors of the Nazi regime firsthand. She was deported to the Theresienstadt concentration camp in 1943 but managed to escape and went into hiding.
- Advocate for Awareness: After the war, Friedlander dedicated her life to sharing her experiences and raising awareness about the atrocities committed during the Holocaust. She gave talks and interviews, ensuring that future generations would learn from history.
- Public Recognition: Friedlander's story gained significant public attention, especially after a book and documentary featured her life. She became a symbol of resilience and a voice for Holocaust remembrance.
- Legacy: Margot Friedlander's passing marks the loss of a significant historical witness. Her legacy lives on through her story, which continues to educate and remind people of the importance of combating hatred and intolerance.

Padma Shri scientist Subbanna Ayyappan passed away

Dr. Subbanna Ayyappan, a distinguished aquaculture scientist and Padma Shri awardee, was found deceased in the Cauvery River near Srirangapatna, Karnataka, on May 10, 2025. At 70, he was the first non-crop scientist to lead the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), serving as its Director-General from 2010 to 2016. Ayyappan was instrumental in India's Blue Revolution, significantly enhancing fish production through scientific aquaculture practices. Preliminary investigations suggest the possibility of suicide, though authorities have not ruled out other causes, and a post-mortem examination is underway.

In Montevideo, thousands gathered to honor his legacy, with a funeral procession that included his widow, Lucía



Topolansky, and President Orsi, who draped the national flag over his coffin . The government declared three days of national mourning, and his body was cremated and interred near his farmhouse in Rincón del Cerro, as per his wishes .

- Life of Simplicity: Mujica was known for living a simple life, donating a significant portion of his salary, and traveling without escorts or privileges. He resided on his farm in Rincón del Cerro, where he passed away.
- Progressive Policies: As President from 2010 to 2015, Mujica championed historic reforms, including:Same-sex Marriage Legalization,Abortion Decriminalization, Cannabis Regulation.
- International Recognition: He maintained a nuanced relationship with Cuba, initially supporting its revolutionary ideals but later adopting a more critical stance.
- Legacy: He is remembered for his personal ethics, integrity, and commitment to social justice, inspiring many in Uruguay and across Latin America.


