Odisha CM Mohan Charan Majhi Introduces the CM Kisan Yojana

Odisha CM Mohan Charan Majhi launched the CM Kisan Yojana by releasing the first instalment of 925 crore to support nearly 46 lakh farmers. The inauguration, held at Gangadhar Meher University in Sambalpur, coincided with the major agricultural festival, Nuakhai. Each small and marginal farmer received 2,000 as the first installment via Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT), with a second installment set for Akshaya Tritiya.

Foot Notes:

- A total of 45,57,733 farmers, including landless ones, will receive 4,000 annually in two installments, while landless farmers
 - will get 12,500 in three installments.
- The funds are intended for purchasing agricultural equipment, seeds, fertilizers, and pesticides.
- The CM also launched the Krushak Odisha Unified Portal to provide information on state government support for farmers.
- Prior to the event, the CM took part in the sacred 'Nabanna' ceremony at Samaleswari Temple in Sambalpur.

SEBI updated margin trading framework for additional collateral

Cash Collateral as Maintenance Margin: Cash collateral used for margin trading can now be considered as part of the maintenance margin. If a broker uses cash collateral from a client to fulfill settlement obligations with the clearing corporation, this collateral can be counted as maintenance margin.

Foot Notes:

- Applicability: Applies to securities received from the clearing corporation (CC) against cash collateral, which are pledged as funded stocks to the trading member.
- Effective Date: New rules start on October 1, 2024.

India is expected to keep its status as the fastest-growing major economy in emerging markets.

India Launches Malpe and Mulki Anti-Submarine Warfare Ships

The launch occurred at Cochin Shipyard Ltd (CSL) in Kochi. These are the fourth and fifth ships in a series of eight Anti-Submarine Warfare (ASW) Shallow Water Crafts (SWC). This development advances India's goal of increased self-reliance in defense equipment manufacturing.

Details of the Launch

- Vice Admiral V Srinivas, Southern Naval Command's commander, attended the event.
- Equipped with underwater sensors for submarine detection, they are designed for shallow coastal anti-submarine operations.
- They can reach speeds of 25 knots and travel up to 1,800 nautical miles before refueling.
- Over 80% of materials and technology used in their construction are sourced from India, supporting the 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat' initiative and boosting domestic defense production.

ISRO to Launch 1st Base Module of Bharatiya Antariksh Station by 2028



- The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) plans to launch the first base module of the Bharatiya Antariksh Station (BAS),
- India's first space station, by 2028. The BAS will consist of 5 modules. The entire station, weighing about 52 tonnes, is expected to be

fully assembled in space by 2035.

Foot Note:

- ISRO is developing a new-generation rocket named Soorya to launch heavier modules.
- The Soorya rocket will have twice the capability of the current heaviest rocket, LVM Mk-3.
- The LVM3 rocket can place up to 4-tonne class satellites into Geosynchronous Transfer Orbits (GTO) and 10 tonnes into Low

Earth Orbit (LEO).

growing strength in women's boxing worldwide.

Jannik Sinner won the Men's Singles title at the US Open 2024



Jannik Sinner won his second Grand Slam title of 2024 when he defeated Taylor Fritz in the US Open final, shattering American hopes of a first male champion at the majors in 21 years. World number one Sinner, who won his maiden Slam at the Australian Open in January, became the first Italian man to triumph in New York with a 6-3, 6-4, 7-5 victory.

 - This victory also helped Purcell and Thompson recover from their earlier Wimbledon final loss.

Algerian President Abdelmadjid Tebboune has been re-elected for a second term with 95% of the vote, according to the country's electoral authority, ANIE. The official results indicate that Tebboune received 94.65% of the vote, while his opponents, Abdelaali Hassani Cherif and



Youcef Aouchiche, garnered 3% and 2% respectively. Voter turnout was reported at 48%, with more than 24 million Algerians registered to vote.
