




# DAILY VOCAB DOSE

#### 1.LATENT (adj): अव्यक्त

Pronunciation: la tent

Meaning: (of a quality or state) existing but not yet developed or manifest; hidden or

concealed.

**Synonyms:** dormant, quiescent, inactive **Antonyms:** manifest, obvious, active

**Sentence:** There is a lot of <u>latent</u> talent in the school.

# 2.OODLES (noun) : अधिक संख्या

Pronunciation: oo.dlz

Meaning: a very great number or amount of something.

Synonyms: abundance, mass, boatload

Antonyms: pinch, bit, little

**Sentence:** They've got <u>oodles</u> of money.

#### 3.LISTLESS (adj.) : सुस्त

**Pronunciation:** list·luhs

Meaning: (of a person or their manner) lacking energy or enthusiasm.

**Synonyms:** lethargic, enervated, lackadaisical **Antonyms:** energetic, enthusiastic, motivated

**Sentence:** When I had the flu, I felt listless and worn out.

#### 4.SUFFUSES (verb) : फैलाना

**Pronunciation:** suh·fyooz·uhz

Meaning: gradually spread through or over.

Synonyms: permeate, spread over, spread throughout

**Antonyms:** empty, deprive, remove.

**Sentence:** The living room is <u>suffused</u> with warm sunlight.

## 5.PROTEAN (adj.): परिवर्तनशील

**Pronunciation:** proh·tee·uhn

Meaning: tending or being able to change frequently or easily.

Synonyms: ever-changing, variable, changeable

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Antonyms: immutable, consistent, constant

**Sentence:** It is difficult to comprehend the whole of this <u>protean</u> subject.

## 6.CONCOMITANT (adj.): सहगामी

Pronunciation: kuhng·kaw·muh·tnt

**Meaning:** naturally accompanying or associated. **Synonyms:** attendant, accompanying, associated

**Antonyms:** unrelated

**Sentence:** Disease is all too often one of the <u>concomitants</u> of poverty.

#### 7.NIHILISM (noun) : शून्यवाद

**Pronunciation:** nai·uh·li·zm

Meaning: the rejection of all religious and moral principles, in the belief that life is

meaningless.

Synonyms: disbelief, rejection, repudiation

**Antonyms:** belief, faith, approval

**Sentence:** The implicit <u>nihilism</u> and aggression are global.

# 8.AGILITY (noun) : च्स्ती

Pronunciation: uh · jil · uh · tee

**Meaning:** ability to move quickly and easily. **Synonyms:** deftness, dexterity, nimbleness **Antonyms:** inability, incapability, incapacity

Sentence: I admired his considerable mental agility.

# 9.PLAINTIVE (adj.) : दर्दनाक

Pronunciation: playn·tuhv

**Meaning:** sounding sad and mournful. **Synonyms:** mournful, sad, wistful

Antonyms: delighted, exulting, glorying

Sentence: "What about me?" came a plaintive voice.

#### 10.HOLLERING (verb) : चिल्लाना

Pronunciation: haw·luh·ruhng

**Meaning:** (of a person) give a loud shout or cry.


Synonyms: shout, yell, cry

Antonyms: mumbling, murmuring, whispering

Sentence: Hollering at me isn't going to find us a parking place.
