1. STANCE (noun) – मुद्रा; दृष्टिकोण

Pronunciation: stans / staans

Meaning: the way in which someone stands, especially when deliberately adopted (as in cricket, golf, and other sports); a

person's posture; the attitude of a person or organization towards something

Synonyms: posture, pose, attitude, bearing; attitude, stand, point of view, viewpoint, opinion, outlook, standpoint **Usage**:

- She changed her stance, resting all her weight on one leg.
- What is your stance on environmental issues?

2. PEANUTS (noun) – अपर्याप्त धन

Pronunciation: pee-nuts

Meaning: a very small or inadequate sum of money

Synonyms: next to nothing, very little, chicken feed, chump change

Usage: The hotel workers get paid peanuts.

3. OUTSIZE (adjective) — असाधारण रूप से बड़ा

Pronunciation: aut-saiz **Meaning**: exceptionally large

Synonyms: huge, oversized, enormous, gigantic

Usage: This is an amazing outsize bed.

4. HUM AND HAW (verb) - हिचकिचाना; अनिर्णायक

Pronunciation: hum and haw **Meaning**: hesitate; be indecisive **Synonyms**: dither, vacillate **Antonym**: be decisive

Usage: I was humming and hawing over buying dresses.

5. RAPTURE (noun) – अत्यन्त हर्ष

Pronunciation: rap-chuh

Meaning: a feeling of intense pleasure or joy

Synonyms: ecstasy, bliss, euphoria, elation, exaltation

Antonyms: boredom, indifference

Usage: The prime minister's supporters greeted her speech with <u>rapture</u>.

6. REPOSE (noun) - विश्राम; समवृत्ति

Pronunciation: ri-po-z

Meaning: a state of rest, sleep, or tranquility; the state of being calm and composed

Synonyms: rest, relaxation, inactivity, stillness, idleness; composure, calmness, serenity, equanimity

Antonyms: work, activity, stress, strain; agitation

Usage:

• The first rays of morning sun disturbed their repose.

• His lectures caused him deep repose or inner peace.

7. GORGE (noun; verb) – एक संकीर्ण घाटी; बहुत खाना

Pronunciation: go-j

Meaning: a narrow valley between hills or mountains, typically with steep rocky walls and a stream running through it; eat a

large amount greedily; fill oneself with food

Synonyms: ravine, canyon, gully, pass, defile, couloir; stuff, cram, fill, glut, satiate, sate

Antonym: nibble

Usage:

A deep gorge separates the two halves of the city. (noun)

I could spend each day gorging on chocolate. (verb)

8. CORUSCATING (adjective) – चमकती

Pronunciation: korus-kei-ting **Meaning**: flashing; sparkling

Synonyms: shining, bright, brilliant, gleaming, glittering

Antonyms: dull, matte

Usage: She bought a coruscating ring.

9. DANDY (noun) – आडंबरप्रिय; बांका

Pronunciation: dandi

Meaning: a man unduly concerned with looking stylish and fashionable

Synonyms: fop, beau, rake

Usage: Design of his suit gave him the look of a <u>dandy</u>.

10. DANK (adjective) – ਜਸ और ਠਂਤਾ

Pronunciation: dank

Meaning: unpleasantly damp and cold

Synonyms: damp, musty, chilly, clammy, wet, moist, unaired

Antonym: dry

Usage: After the flooding, our house was so dank that we moved into a hotel for a few weeks.


