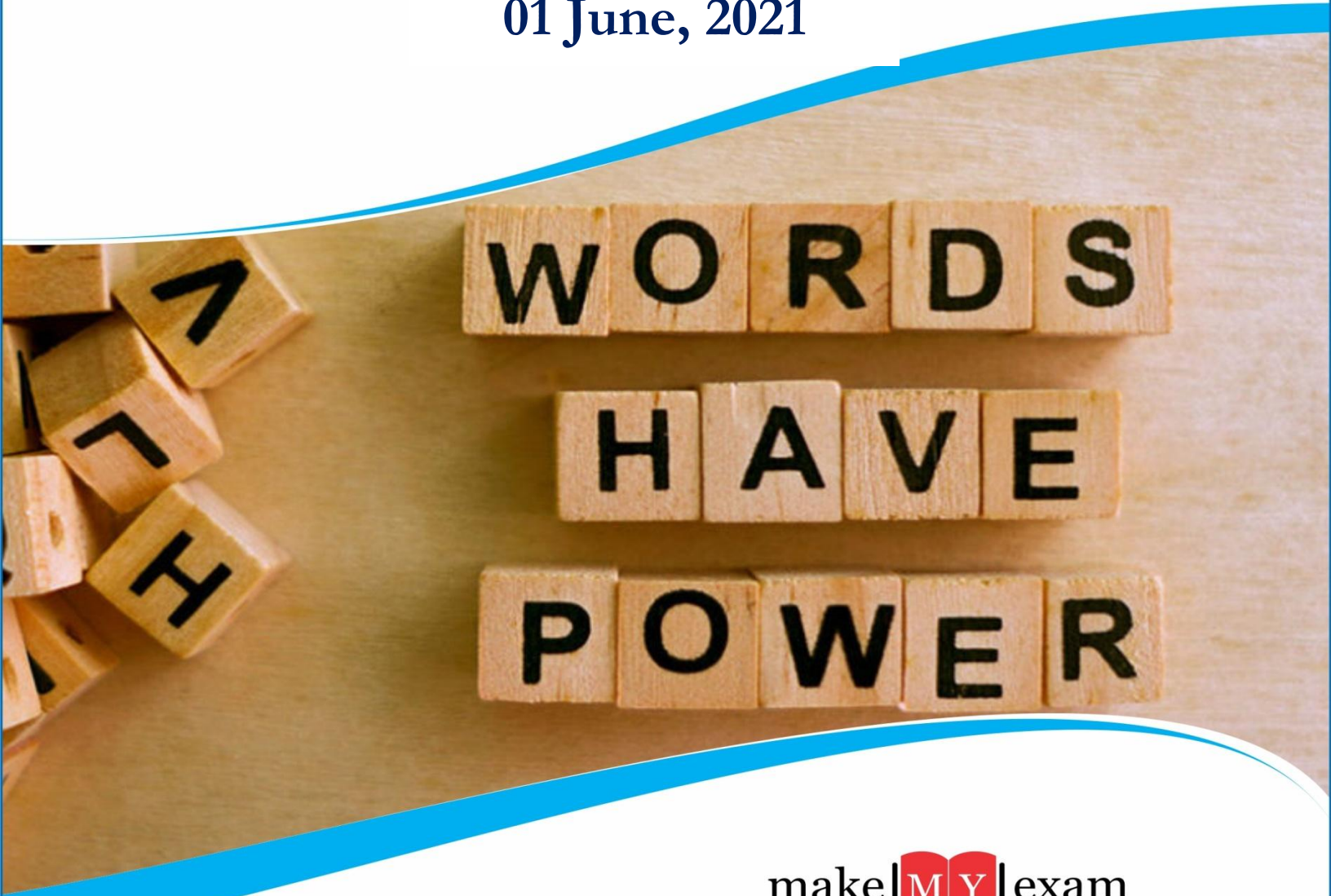

1.Vicinity (noun) - आस-पास

Pronunciation: vi·suh·nuh·tee

Meaning: The area around a particular place

Synonyms: locality, surrounding area, proximity, neighbourhood, vicinage

Antonyms: remoteness, distance, farness

Usage: There is no hospital in the immediate vicinity.

2.Spectacular (adj) - बहुतशानदार

Pronunciation: spek·ta·kyoo·luh

Meaning: very impressive

Synonyms: striking, splendid, sensational, extravagant, flamboyant

Antonyms: mediocre, ordinary, austere, plain, severe

Usage: The special effects were quite spectacular.

3.Relegate (verb) - बाहरनिकालदेना

Pronunciation: reh·lu·geit

Meaning: to give somebody a lower or less important position, rank etc, than before

Synonyms: downgrade, demote, lower, banish, deport, displace

Antonyms: promote, raise, push, encourage, accept, admit, receive

Usage: She was then relegated to the role of assistant.

4.Pithiest (adj) - सारपूर्ण

Pronunciation: pith·ee·uhst

Meaning: (of language or style) terse and vigorously expressive

Synonyms: concise, compact, crisp, laconic, abrupt, blunt

Antonyms: wordy, pleonastic, redundant, repetitious

Usage: He is often pithiest when describing his literary opposites.

5.Filigree (noun) - ज़रदोजीकाकाम

Pronunciation: fi·luh·gree

Meaning: ornamental work of fine wire formed into delicate tracery.

Synonyms: wirework, fretwork, lattice, adornment, embossment

Antonyms: blemish, defacement, disfigurement, scar

Usage: Silver filigree works are made out of the goldsmith`s tools.

6.Feat (noun) - करतब, साहसिक कार्य

Pronunciation: feet

Meaning: an achievement that requires great courage, skill, or strength

Synonyms: accomplishment, attainment, achievement, coup, success, triumph

Antonyms: defeat, failure, forfeit, loss, cessation

Usage: The tunnel is a brilliant feat of engineering.

7.Indemnification (noun) - हर्जाना

Pronunciation: uhn·dem·nuh·fuh·kei·shn

Meaning: compensation for harm or loss

Synonyms: redress, damages, reparation, remuneration, settlement

Antonyms: debt, disadvantage, dissatisfaction, handicap, hindrance

Usage: If they fail to reach a consensus, the indemnification shall be paid in one lump sum.

8.Epitome (noun) - प्रतीक

Pronunciation: uh·p·tuh·mee

Meaning: a person or thing that is perfect example of a particular quality or type

Synonyms: embodiment, personification, paragon, abstract, breviary, brief, capsule

Antonyms: amplification, enlargement, expansion, addendum, supplement

Usage: She looked the epitome of elegance and good taste.

9.Insipid (adj) - फीका

Pronunciation: uhn·si·puhd

Meaning: lacking vigour or interest

Synonyms: dead, flat, flavorless, savorless, tasteless, unsavory

Antonyms: flavorful, flavorsome, tasty, interesting, imaginative

Usage: The food was rather insipid and needed ginger up.

10.Scramble (noun) - संघर्ष

Pronunciation: skram·bl

Meaning: rushing about hastily in an undignified way

Synonyms: clamber, climb, scrabble, swarm, embroil, entangle

Antonyms: classify, codify, methodize, systematize, arrange, array

Usage: In our code we scramble letters,so words are unrecognizable.



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
