1. Feroz Shah Kotla to be renamed as Arun Jaitley Stadium

- Feroz Shah Kotla Stadium in Delhi will be renamed as Arun Jaitley Stadium in the memory of former DDCA President. The decision was announced by the DDCA (Delhi and District Cricket Association) on August 27, 2019.
- ♣ Speaking on the same, current DDCA president Rajat Sharma said, "What can be better to have it named after the man who got it rebuilt under his presidentship.
- ♣ It was Arun Jaitley's support and encouragement that players like Virat Kohli, Virender Sehwag, Gautam Gambhir, Ashish Nehra, Rishabh Pant and many others could make India proud."

2. Lieu Governor launches QR Code Scheme on Himmat Plus app

- Lieutenant Governor Anil Baijal launched a QR Code Scheme on the Himmat Plus app which can be used by cab or auto-rickshaw passengers to verify the identity of the driver and raise an alarm.
- Around 3,000 taxis and auto-rickshaws plying outside airports, railway stations and metro stations in the city have been registered under this scheme of the Delhi Police Transport Range and can be verified by scanning the QR code of the card pasted on the back of the headrest of the driver's seat.
- if driver is not registered, the user receives the pop-up notification on the application. In this case, the passenger can call the control room or press the SOS button from the application. On the occasion of the launch, Baijal distributed QR Codes to some of the auto and taxi drivers

- Himmat Plus is a mobile app launched by the Delhi Police to ensure the safety of women.
- This added feature is to ensure that only genuine and verified drivers ferry passenger to their destinations from airports and railway and metro stations.

3. World Vision India and IFMR LEAD released India child well being index

- ♣ World Vision India and IFMR LEAD released a report on the India child well-being index 2019 on 27 August.
- ♣ In the Index states like Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Himachal Pradesh, and Puducherry topped the charts. States like Meghalaya, Jharkhand and Madhya Pradesh ranked bottom in the index. The centre is fully committed to secure the rights and well-being of children.

4. Government sets up 5-member GoM for Jammu and Kashmir, Ladakh

- ♣ The Union Government has constituted a 5-member Group of Ministers (GoM) to look into issues concerning the Union Territories of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh.
- → The GoM will look into the development, economic and social issues of the two UTs and suggest ways to improve the situation. The two UTs will come into existence on October 31
- → The GoM will comprise Union Ministers Ravi Shankar Prasad, Jitendra Singh, Thawar Chand Gehlot, Narendra Singh Tomar and Dharmendra Pradhan.

5. Assam's National Register of Citizens List released

- ♣ State coordinator of the National Register of Citizens, Prateek Hajela has released the most awaited Assam's final National Register of Citizens list. The list has been made accessible online and at all NRC seva kendras in the state.
- ♣ The process of NRC Update was started in the state of Assam as per order of the Supreme Court of India in 2013. The NRC took five years and Rs 1,220 crore before getting published.
- From the 3.29 crore applicants, a total of 3.11 crore people have been found eligible for inclusion in final NRC list. 19.06 lakh people have been excluded from the final NRC list. Those excluded from the final NRC list will have 120 days to approach the Foreigners' Tribunals. If a person is dissatisfied with the tribunal's decision, he/she can appeal against it.

7. Jio tops telecom market with 31.7 percent revenue share, Airtel second

- ♣ Reliance Jio has topped the telecom market with a 31.7 percent market share in the second quarter of 2019. Bharti Airtel has regained its second spot, leaving behind Vodafone Idea, the revenue of which plunged substantially.
- → Jio achieved the feat merely three years after its launch. Jio reported a modest 15 basis points (bps) sequential growth in the June quarter to reach an RMS of 31.7 percent.



♣ Airtel gained 277 bps in the same quarter for a 30 percent revenue market share. Airtel bounced back from its heavy fall in the previous quarter due to one-time bad debt write-offs linked to interconnect usage charges from operators.

The Indore Municipal Corporation has implemented the Jal Shakti Abhiyan on a priority basis & for this, an App has also been launched, in which citizens can apply for water harvesting system.
- ♣ The installation of water harvesting system capsules is being given free of cost under CSR(Corporate social responsibility) for homes to discharge roof rainwater into the ground during the rainy season. The homeowners are required to pay the amount of wages and material.

- ♣ In a bid to make the city cleaner& greener, the Union Minister of Home Affairs, Amit Shah has flagged off the first fleet of eco-friendly e-buses(electric buses) in Ahmedabad, Gujarat, which will be operated on major junctions in the city.
- He also inaugurated the India's 1st automated battery charging & changing station for ebuses in the city. Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation (AMC) will operate the electric buses on a regular basis. In the 1st phase, a total of 50 buses will be rolled out, of which 18 e-buses will have swappable battery technology facility, while other 32 e-buses having fast charging facility will become operational.
- 4 Amit Shah also culminates the Mission Million Trees project, which was organized by the AMC at the Science City on World Environment Day (5 June 2019). Under this mission, AMC has enabled planting of one million saplings since the launch of the initiative.

17. India will overtake China as the largest importer of coking coal by 2025

- 4 According to the report of Fitch Solutions Macro Research, India will overtake China as the largest importer of coking coal by 2025. It has been estimated that India's coking coal consumption will grow at an annual average rate of 5.4% between 2019 and 2028, driven by an equally robust expansion in steel production.
- Lipid China will remain dominant in terms of overall market share. But India will become increasingly important in terms of seaborne demand. India is the largest importer of Australian coking coal. It saw a 25.8% year-on-year (YoY) increase in coking coal imports from Australia in the second quarter of 2019.
- China is the second largest importer of Australian coking coal. It decreased imports by 8.8% YoY in the second quarter of 2019. China will continue to account for roughly two-thirds of global coking coal production and consumption over the coming years.

18. Bihar bans 12 pan masala brands containing magnesium carbonate

- ♣ The Nitish Kumar government in Bihar has banned 12 pan masala brands containing magnesium carbonate. The manufacture, storage, distribution, transportation or sale of pan masala containing magnesium carbonate is banned in Bihar, the state government said.
- 4 The food and safety department of the state issued the order to raise the health concerns in Bihar. Earlier, the food and safety department had examined few pan masala brands and found that it contains magnesium carbonate which could cause heart disease.

19. West Bengal passed anti lynching Bill

- 4 The West Bengal State Assembly passed West Bengal (Prevention of Lynching) Bill, 2019. The Bill aims to prevent and punish mob assaults and lynching. The state government mentioned that the Bill was passed as the Centre has failed to take the initiative. The Bill was passed by a voice vote. The Bill aims to prevent the spreading of hatred or incidents of mob lynching.
- ♣ The State describes lynching as social malice. The State also urged the Centre and other State governments to bring similar legislation.
- 4 The bill was passed after several cases in which the people were beaten to death over rumors of cattle smuggling and child theft. This offense will carry the punishment of a jail term for three years to life imprisonment. In case of assault leading to injury, the penalty includes a fine of a minimum of Rs.1 lakh to a maximum of Rs.3 lakh.
- ♣ The Bill defined terms such as lynching and mob. The Bill said that the West Bengal Lynching Compensation Scheme may be framed under this Act.

1. PK Sinha is appointed as OSD in Prime Minister Office

- Former cabinet Secretary PK Sinha has been appointed as the Officer on Special Duty (OSD) in Prime Minister's Office (PMO). He will replace Nripendra Misra who is the Principal Secretary of PMO. Sinha's place will be taken by Rajiv Gauba who was appointed as Cabinet Secretary.
- ▶ Nripendra Misra 1967-batch retired IAS officer. He has relieved his position as a senior government official. Misra was the first senior-level appointment created by Prime Minister Narendra Modi in 2014. He is an outstanding officer who has an excellent grasp of public policy associate degreed administration. Misra had retired as TRAI chairman.
- ♣ Pradeep Kumar Sinha is the 1977 batch IAS officer of Uttar Pradesh cadre. He is the 31st cabinet Secretary of India. Before this appointment, he served as the Power Secretary of India.

2. Govt accepts the resignation of SBI's MD Anshula Kant, following her appointment as MD and CFO of the World Bank

- → The Central Government has accepted the resignation of Anshula Kant, Managing Director (MD) of State Bank of India(SBI). This comes after her appointment as the MD and Chief Financial Officer(CFO) of World Bank Group.
- 4 Anshula is from Jamshedpur, Jharkhand. She is a graduate in Economic Honours from Lady Shri Ram College for Women and a Post-Graduate in Economics from Delhi School of Economics. She has more than 35 years of expertise in finance, banking will be responsible for financial and risk management of the World Bank Group. She will also have to work closely with the World Bank CEO on the mobilization of the International Development Association (IDA) of WB and other financial resources.

Banking

1. India's GDP growth slows to 5% in Q1 FY20

- The Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation notified that the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) of India registered a growth of 5% in April to June quarter of 2019-20 from 8% of 2018-19 quarter. It is the lowest in 7 years due to a sharp dip in the manufacturing sector and agriculture output.
- ♣ The previous lowest GDP was recorded at 4.9% in April to June 2012-13. The manufacturing sector grew by 0.6% as compared to a growth of 12.1% in Q1 2018-19. Agriculture, forestry and fishing' sector grew by 2% as compared to growth of 5.1% in Q1 2018-19.



4 Mining and quarrying sector grew by 2.7% as compared to a growth of 0.4% in Q1 2018-19. Electricity, gas, water supply and other utility services sector grew by 8.6% as compared to growth of 6.7% in Q1 2018-19. The passenger vehicle industry suffered its worst performance in 19 years in July 2019. It declined at 31% in sales and it was the 9th consecutive month of declining sales, underscoring a sharp decline in demand.

2. Nirmala Sitharaman Announces Consolidation of 27 Govt Banks Into 12, Assures No Job Cuts or Disruption in Economy

- 4 Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman announced a series of mergers involving 10 state-owned banks as the government moves to strengthen a sector struggling under a mountain of debt and ensure stronger balance sheets to boost lending and revive economic growth.
- → The biggest merger is that of Punjab National Bank, Oriental Bank of Commerce and United Bank. The three banks together will merge to form India's second-largest bank after the State Bank of India (SBI), with business worth Rs 17.95 lakh crore and 11,437 branches nationwide.
- ♣ Sitharaman also announced the merger of Canara Bank and Syndicate Bank; Union Bank of India, Andhra Bank, and Corporation Bank; and Indian Bank and Allahabad Bank.

- ♣ The species belongs to the genus Mesovelia ranging from 1.5 mm to 4.5 mm equipped with hydrophobic setae (bristles) on their legs and are pale green in colour with silverwhite wings and black veins.
- This combination of hydrophobic setae and water surface tension prevents the insects from sinking. There are currently 12 species of genus Mesovelia found in the country.


5. Socialist leader and former Palghar MLA Navnitbhai Shah passes away


