1. National Museum hosted "Historical Gastronomica - The Indus Dining Experience" exhibition.

- The National Museum in New Delhi is hosting a unique exhibition on India's ancient food history called "Historical Gastronomica The Indus Dining Experience.
- The Indus Dining Experience till the 25th of this month that goes back to over 5000 years ago.
- The exhibition demonstrates the evolution of food habits, food processing techniques and related architecture of the Harappans.
- Recreation of food of the Indus-Saraswati Civilization by National Award-winning Chef Sabyasachi Gorai is one of the main attractions of this exhibition which is the first of its kind in the country. The event gives every visitor a rare opportunity to delve into a pre-historic culinary era.
- The exhibition will last till Tuesday.

2. Tamil Nadu Assembly passes bill to declare Cauvery Delta Region a Protected Special Agriculture Zone.

- The Tamil Nadu Assembly has passed a bill declaring the Cauvery Delta Region a Protected Special Agriculture Zone. The bill provides for banning certain new industries in the region. They include hydrocarbon exploration, smeltering of copper, zinc and aluminium, iron ore processing, tanneries and ship breaking.
- However, the bill also says any ongoing projects would not be disturbed. Infrastructure development projects like
 port development, laying of pipelines, road, telecommunication lines, power and water supply facilities will not be
 banned.
- The whole districts of Thanjavur, Tiruvarur and Nagapattinam and five blocks each of Cuddalore and Pudukkottai districts are brought under the ambit of the bill.

3. Govt approves constitution of 22nd Law Commission.

- Government has formally announced the constitution of the 22nd Law Commission.
- The law panel advises the government on complex legal issues and has a term of three years. With the president giving his nod for the creation of the Law Commission, the government will now appoint a chairperson to head the panel and other members.
- The chairperson usually is a retired Supreme Court judge or a retired chief justice of a high court. Union Cabinet had last week given its nod to reconstitute the panel.

4. Government amended provisions of Arms Act, 1959 and Arms Rules, 2016.

Government has amended provisions of the Arms Act, 1959 and Arms Rules, 2016 to increase the number of
firearms that can be kept by shooters and enhanced quantity of ammunition fixed for practice for the year. The
Home Ministry said, shooting is an important Olympic sport in India and Indian shooters have excelled in
international competitions.







- The Ministry has made provisions to provide adequate firearms and ammunition to the shooters for their practice. As per the new rules, now international medalists and renowned shooters are allowed to keep additional weapons up to a total of twelve under the exempted category, which earlier was seven.
- Through the amendments it has also been clarified that no license is required for Indian citizens for acquisitions, possession of small arms falling under the category of curio.

5. Andhra Pradesh CM launched 'Jagananna Vasthi Deevena' scheme to provide financial assistance to students.

- Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Y S Jagan Mohan Reddy launched yet another scheme named after himself, called 'Jagananna Vasthi Deevena'. Under this a financial assistance of Rs 2,300 crore would be provided to students pursuing various post-intermediate courses to meet hostel and mess expenses.
- In all 11,87,904 students pursuing ITI, polytechnic, under-graduate and postgraduate education would benefit from the scheme. The total Rs 2,300 crore would be distributed to students in two installments, in February and July every year, and credited directly into the bank accounts of the students' mothers.
- While ITI students would get Rs 10,000 each, polytechnic students would get Rs 15,000 and under-graduates and post-graduates Rs 20,000 each.

- The term of office of 55 members of the Rajya Sabha elected from 17 States is due to expire on their retirement in April, 2020. Counting will be held in the evening of 26th March an hour after the conclusion of polls.
- The Rajya Sabha is the upper house of the Parliament of India. It currently has a maximum membership of 245.

8. MP becomes first state to launch unified vehicle registration card.

- Madhya Pradesh has become the first state in the country to introduce the unified registration card and the second state to launch the unified driving license after Uttar Pradesh. Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH) had issued the guidelines to bring uniformity in driving licenses and vehicle registration cards across the country in March last year.
- The new cards will have more exhaustive information printed on both sides of the cards. The unified smart cards
 for driving license and vehicle registration will each have a QR code that will help in verifying authenticity of the
 data printed on the cards.
- The unified driving license card will also have information about the ability of the driver to drive in hilly and dangerous areas and an emergency contact number.

1. Sweden starts testing world's first central bank digital currency.

- Sweden's Riksbank had begun testing an e-krona, taking the country a step closer to the creation of the world's first central bank digital currency (CBDC).
- If the e-krona eventually comes into circulation it will be used to simulate everyday banking activities, such as payments, deposits and withdrawals from a digital wallet such as a mobile phone app.In January, the central banks of Britain, the euro zone, Japan, Sweden and Switzerland joined forces to assess the case for issuing CBDCs. CBDCs are traditional money, but in digital form, issued and governed by a country's central bank.

- The Sri Lankan government has decided not to sign the \$480 million Millennium Challenge Corporation (MCC) agreement with the US, taking into consideration the recommendations of a Committee that found some of its features threaten national security and welfare of the island nation.
- The four-member Committee headed by Professor Lalithasiri Gunaruwan, which submitted its interim report to President Gotabaya Rajapaksa last week, said there were clauses and conditions in the agreement that would







• negatively affect national goals and objectives, sovereignty, and national security, and were inconsistent with the legal framework and Constitution.

1.NABARD sanctioned over Rs 400 cr to boost infrastructure in J&K.

- National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) has sanctioned an amount of over 400 crore rupees to the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir during the current financial year for giving boost to the infrastructure in the rural areas.
- An amount of 143.66 crore rupees has been sanctioned for implementation of 38 water supply schemes. The sanctioned includes augmentation of 27 existing water supply schemes and construction of 11 new water supply schemes.
- These water supply schemes are aimed at providing safe and potable drinking water to rural households. The schemes will benefit over 3.5 lakh people across 86 villages in 17 districts.
- An amount of 47.11 crore rupees has been sanctioned towards improving the Animal and Sheep Husbandry sectors.
- A road length of 291 kms will be constructed benefiting 9.15 lakh people in 19 districts of UT of J&K. The construction of roads and bridges would provide all weather improved connectivity to 461 remote villages.

2. RBI's released new moto 'cash is king, but digital is divine'.

- With 'cash is king, but digital is divine' moto, the Reserve Bank on said its endeavour will be to make digital payments a divine experience for the users.
- RBI has observed over Rs 3.5 lakh crore reduction in the notes in circulation (NIC) post demonetisation.
- NIC increased at an average rate of 14 per cent between October 2014 and October 2016.
- Assuming the same growth rate, NIC would have been Rs 26,04,953 crore in October 2019.
- NIC, however, was Rs 22,31,090 crore, indicating that digitalisation and reduction in cash usage helped reduce NIC by over Rs 3.5 lakh crore.

3. DPIIT notified 100% Foreign Direct Investment in Insurance Intermediaries.

6. SEBI's chairman Ajay Tyagi gets six-month extension.

- Chairman of Securities & Exchange Board of India (SEBI)Ajay Tyagi gets a 6 month extension from the government, whose tenure of 3 years (from 2017) to end on February 29, 2020. He is an Indian Administrative Officer (IAS) of the Himachal Pradesh Cadre.
- His chairmanship of SEBI is been extended according to Sub-Section (1)(a) and Sub-Section (4) of Section 4 of the SEBI Act, 1992 (15 of 1992), read with Rule 3 of the SEBI (Terms and Conditions of Service of Chairman and Members) Rules, 1992.
- His predecessor UK Sinha was also given multiple extensions & remained chairman for 6 years (2011-2017), even though his appointment period is for 3 years.
- The post as SEBI's Chairman has always been given to bureaucrats, especially IAS officers, except on one occasion when former LIC chairman GN Bajpai became the chairman in 2002.
- The candidates for regulatory top post will be shortlisted by the Financial Sector Regulatory Appointments Search Committee (FSRASC) & headed by the Cabinet Secretary.

7. ISRO to launch GISAT 1 New Age Satellite on 5th march to monitor the Indian sub continent.

- The Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) is to launch GISAT 1 (Geo-Imaging Satellite) in order to watch Indian sub-continent continuously.
- The satellite is to be launched by the ISRO on March 5, 2020. The satellite is to be carried by GSLV-F10 rocket. The satellite weighs 2,275 kg and is to be placed in Geosynchronous orbit.



GISAT is a Geo-Information Satellite. The satellite is to do a full rotation of the earth and come to the same point every 2 hours. The satellite is capable of performing rapid surveillance and fast imaging. The ISRO has designed the satellite in such a way that if needed the satellite can observe a point for a longer duration.

- The sixth offshore patrol vessel 'Yard 45006 VAJRA' to enhance coastal security was formally launched at Chennai .The vessel, built by Larsen and Toubro under the Centre's 'Make in India' campaign, would be used for day and night patrolling.
- According to Coast Guard, the 'Yard 45006' is the sixth in the series of seven offshore patrol vessel projects. The vessel is 98 metres long and 15 metres wide with a gross tonnage of 2,100 tonne.
- It is equipped with two diesel driven engines and can reach a maximum speed of 26 knots.
- The ship would be fitted with CRN-91 and 12.7 mm guns and an integral twin engine helicopter enhancing its operational, surveillance, search and rescue capability. The vessel would be utilised for day and night surveillance along with anti-terrorist, anti-smuggling operations in the exclusive economic zone.


